

•The DfT Awarded Birmingham City Council funding for emergency transport measures - Tranche 2, on November 13th.

Upgrading Tranche 1 Projects –

Moseley and Stirchley Local Centres and Pop-up cycle lanes (Sutton, Bradford St, A45, A38, A47 and A457).

Additional Cycling and Walking Interventions -

➤ Pop-up cycle lanes incl. A47 spur to Walmley, A47 spur to Ward End and A38 spur to Moseley, local centres, city wide cycle parking and Big Birmingham Bikes.

•Places for People LTNs -


➤ Lozells, Kings Heath, Moseley, Bournville, Castle Vale, LTN Expansion, School streets & Quick wins







Undertake a high-level review of the current masterplan






SMITHFIELD TRANSPORTATION - FINAL CONCEPT DESIGN

- Central boulevard to connect to wider area with integrated public transport provision that will allow;
 - Metro to be brought into the area;
 - Accommodate Sprint and bus movements
- Accommodate changes to traffic movements on Digbeth High Street and wider development
- Cycling provision of a segregated cycleway linking to Bradford St
- Take into consideration Cells
