Air Quality Approach

- The Avanti Sustainable Development Strategy incorporates Air Quality
- Pollution management is incorporated in our Environmental Management System (ISO 14001 and 50001)
- We have displayed Taxi engine idling posters at all of our stations
- We support the UK Rail Air Quality Strategic
 Framework and work with RSSB on a number of air
 quality initiatives
- We are looking at installing diffusion tubes at all of our stations to monitor air quality



Don't be fuming

Turn off your engine.

It's an offence to keep your engine running unnecessarily whilst stationary and you could be fined.

Road Traffic Regulations 2002: The law states it is an offence to idle your engine unnecessarily when stationary. If you fail to turn your engine off after a request, you may be issued with a fixed penalty notice of £20.





Current Initiatives at BHM



The Voyager auto engine shutdown process was revised in July 2019. When the master key is removed the engine stop times are:

- After 4 mins (previously 8 mins) one engine stops
- After 5 mins (previously 10 mins) two further engines stop
- An Operation Notice was sent out to all Drivers when the auto engine shutdown process was revised.
- Train Drivers are briefed on train idling during their safety briefs and through their driver assessments.
- If any idling incident is raised by Network Rail platform staff the Driver Management Team investigate.





Future Initiatives

The current plan is to replace all of the Avanti Voyager Fleet by the end of 2022, to be replaced by:

- 13 new five-carriage bi-mode trains (807's)
- 10 new seven-carriage electric trains (805's)

Once the new trains are rolled out all Avanti trains running through Birmingham New Street Station will be powered by electricity either through the overhead or via battery; without any diesel engine exhaust emissions.
