About Your Project

1. Please describe the project you are asking for grant funding to undertake.

Please refer to the guidance notes for information about what sort of projects will be given priority.

As part of our work with Living Streets, Sustrans and Healthy Schools, we are encouraging more pupils to cycle and scoot to school – especially younger pupils. This is to decrease the amount of traffic around school and also to promote healthy lifestyle choices. However, we do not have anywhere to store bikes or scooters for our Infant children. We believe more children would scoot or cycle if we did. The rationale for this is we have a cycle shelter in Key Stage Two and this is well used every day. Parents, pupils and staff have expressed the need for a bike shelter in KS1.

2. What you will spend the grant funding on?

This will be for the purchase and installation of a bike shelter in our Infant playground.

3. What benefits do you expect to result from the project?

We expect to see less traffic around school, specifically Wootton Road, where Cofton is situated; this is just a small cul-de-sac with a lot of daily traffic (air pollution which is bad for pupils, parents and the local community). We also expect to see pupils making healthier lifestyle choices by cycling or scooting to school. We are part of the Big Pedal (Sustrans) and Walk to School (Living Streets) initiatives so we will be able to accurately measure progress as daily journeys will be logged by pupils (February – July 2019).

4. What positive legacy will the project have on the school or wider community and what will happen when the grant funding stops?

The bike shelter will still be in place so pupils will still be able to store bikes and scooters there, which will encourage them to travel to school by bike or scooter.

5. How does this project connect with your Modeshift STARS Travel Plan?

Please note funding is only available to schools who have committed to developing school travel plans through the on-line Modeshift STARS programme; or schools who will commit to registering on Modeshift STARS and achieving bronze level within 12 months (from date of award of grant).

We are registered with modeshift STARS and are committed to reducing traffic around our school. The shelter will help reduce the number of cars on Wootton Road.
