Availability of suitable appointment times will form part of the accessibility criteria and be reviewed as part of the tender requirements. The service specification will outline in detail the requirements for the service to comply with the Equality Act 2010 and the Public Sector Equality Duty and ensure that all staff are trained and competent in equality and diversity issues.
