# 1. Purpose of report:

Officers have delegated authority to grant Permits in respect of up to 4 Licensed Premises Gaming Machines, Category C & D in an Alcohol Licensed Premises. This application seeks to have permission to operate 5 Category C Gaming Machines.

### 2. Recommendation:

The Sub Committee is requested to consider an application to operate a total of 5 Gaming Machines on an Alcohol Licensed premises.

## 3. Brief Summary of Report:

An application for the variation of a Licensed Premises Gaming Machine Permit was received on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

## 4.1 Consistency with relevant Council Policies, Plans or Strategies:

The report complies with the City Council's Statement of Licensing Principles and the Council's Corporate Plan to improve the standard of all licensed persons, premises and vehicles in the City.

### 5. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

Star Pubs & Bars Limited submitted an application for the variation of a Licensed Premises Gaming Machine Permit on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2020 for the Raven, Hodge Hill Road, Stechford, Birmingham, B34 6DR.

The application, including supporting documents, is attached at Appendix 1.

Birmingham City Council Licensing Enforcement visited the premises and confirmed that they object to the application. Their confirmation is attached at Appendix 2.

The premises have the benefit of a current Gaming Machine Permit issued under the Gambling Act 2005, which permits 4 Category C machines. See attached Appendix 3.

Gaming Machine Categories by maximum stake and maximum prizes available, see attached Appendix 4.

Site Location Plans at Appendix 5.

Where an application for a licensed gaming machine permit is made, the licensing authority shall consider it having regard to the licensing objectives, any relevant guidance issued by the Commission under section 25 and such other matters as they think relevant.

### Dear Bhapinder

Thanks for your email and apologies for the late reply.

I can confirm that our client wishes to proceed with the application.

In order to assist the committee in determining our application please find attached the following:-

- Plan showing the location of the gaming machines, including the proposed location of the 5<sup>th</sup> machine 3 of
  the machines are clearly visible from the bar servery and whilst the other 2 machines are not clearly visible
  from the bar servery are all regularly monitored by staff members at regular intervals
- Responsible Gambling and Age Verification messages all existing gaming machines and the proposed 5<sup>th</sup>
  machine are digital and display No Under 18 signs in start-up mode and periodically throughout game play

The following should also be of interest to the committee:-

- The existing LPGMP was issued on 13 January 2009 and permits 4 Category C or D machines
- The premises operates as a community local offering a quality selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks along with a substantial food offering
- With it being a family friendly premises the only restrictions on children access is that under 16s must be
  accompanied by an adult at all times and they are not permitted in the area immediately adjacent to the bar
  servery meaning the areas where the gaming machines are located
- The Premises Licence Holder, Star Pubs & Bars Limited, is a subsidiary of Heineken UK and have held the Premises Licence since August 2015. Heineken take their responsibilities under the Gambling Act 2005 very seriously
- Procedures are in place for staff members who are trained upon commencement of their employment at
  the premises to check the age of those playing the machines if they appear underage and to only accept
  identification which contains a photograph from which the individual can be identified, states the
  individual's date of birth, is valid and is legible and has no visible signs of tampering or reproduction. Staff
  are aware that should they have any concerns of the age of the individual playing the gaming machine to
  notify the DPS or manager on duty immediately
- We are not aware of any issues with the premises from trading with the existing 4 gaming machines so submit there is no evidence that the addition of a 5<sup>th</sup> gaming machine will undermine the licensing objectives

The above measures which are already in place demonstrate how the 3 licensing objectives are currently being promoted and how this will continue with the addition of a 5<sup>th</sup> machine. In response to the objection from your Licensing Enforcement Officer, I disagree that there is insufficient floor space to accommodate a 5<sup>th</sup> machine given the attached location of the machines shows there is adequate space. Furthermore, I am unsure as to which licensing objective the second part of the officer's objection falls under regarding the 4 machines not being used at the time of their visit.

Thank you again for your assistance in this matter and please let me know once a committee hearing is scheduled.


