1. Purpose of report:

To consider relevant representations that have been made in respect of an application for a Premises Licence which seeks to permit the Sale of Alcohol (for consumption off the premises) to operate from 07:00am until 11:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

Premises to remain open to the public from 07:00am until 11:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

An application for a Premises Licence was received on 18th September 2018, in respect of Kani Mini Market, 27-29 Grove Lane, Handsworth, Birmingham, B21 9ES.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

(SEE ABOVE), THESE LOCK UP PREMISES, HAVE THEIR OWN INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CCTV. THE CCTV INSTALLED IS TO THE SPECIFICATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF WEST MIDLANDS POLICE. 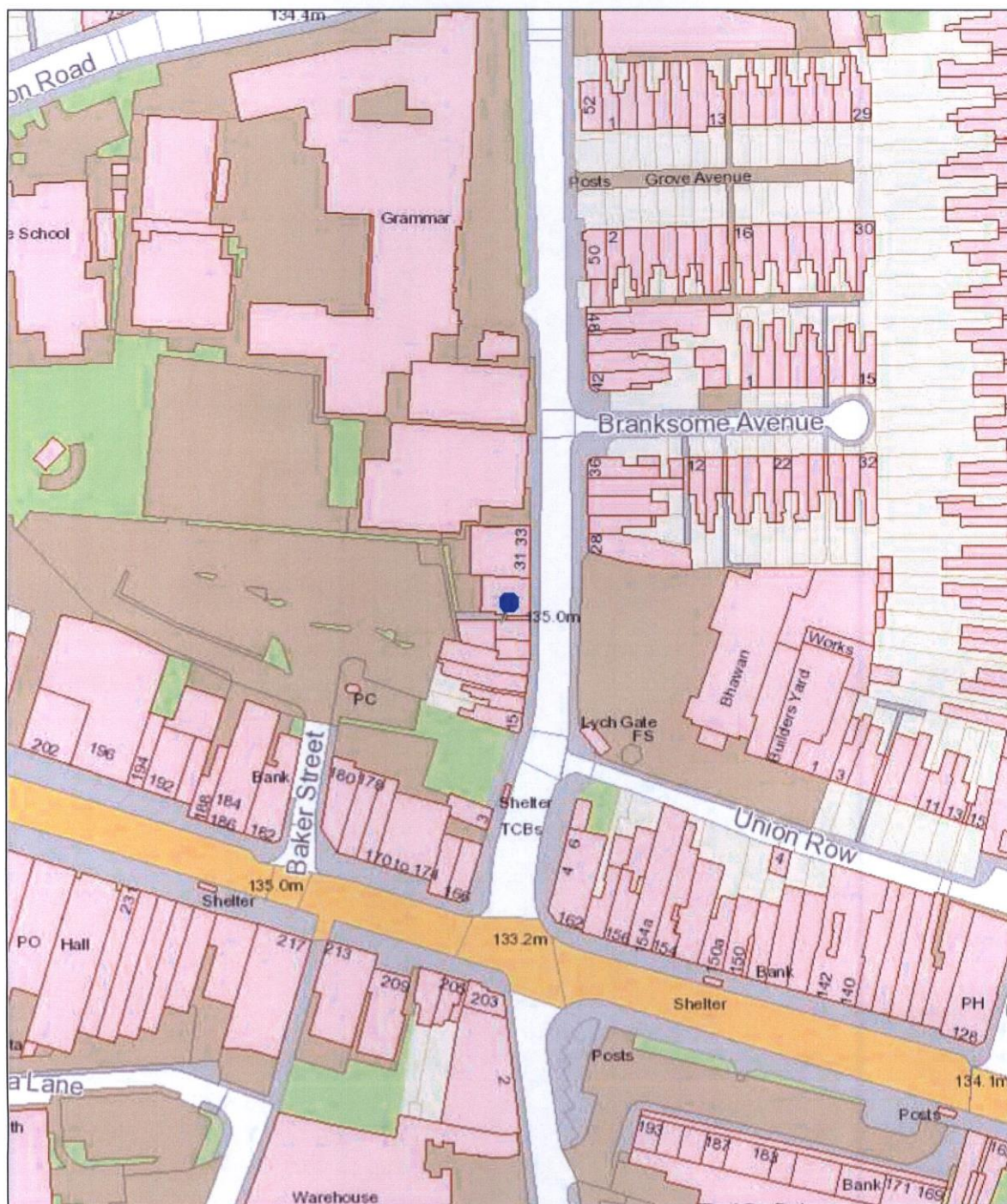
