# COVID-19 Vaccination Overview 22/02/2022









### **COVID-19 Vaccine Roll Out**

- Vaccines and treatments will form the "first line of defence" going forward.
- Those aged over 75 years and the most vulnerable will be offered a 4th jab.
- From 1 April, the current guidance on voluntary COVID-status certification in domestic settings will be removed. The recommended use of NHS Covid Pass in certain venues will no longer be required.
- All adults and children aged 5-17 years are eligible for a vaccine.
  - ➤ All those aged 12 and over are eligible for two full doses.
  - Children aged 5 to 11-year-old are now being offered two low dose vaccine, at least 12 weeks apart.
- Booster jabs are available to everyone aged 16+, and some children aged 12 to 15 in at-risk groups.




## **COVID-19 Vaccine Roll Out**

- Booster jabs are available for everyone aged 16+, and some children aged 12 to 15 if they have a condition that puts them at high risk of getting seriously ill from COVID-19, or they live with someone who is immune-compromised. The jab can be offered after 3 months of their second dose.
- The Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) has approved the use of Novavax (5th COVID-19 vaccine) as a first and second dose in adults. The vaccine offers up to 89% protection against COVID-19 illness.
- Figures from the <u>GOV.UK</u> website indicate that 91.4% of the English population aged 12 years and over have had their 1st vaccine dose, 84.8% their 2nd dose, and 65.5% their booster dose. This compares to 68.3%, 61.7% and 40.6% in Birmingham.



## Birmingham COVID-19 Vaccination: 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> and Booster Doses by Date



- 1<sup>st</sup> dose uptake began in late 2020 and showed strong initial growth before slowing in April 2021. Current uptake is 67.6%.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> dose vaccination began in April 2021, with uptake at the earlier stages slightly more gradual than the 1<sup>st</sup> dose. Both are now showing low but consistent week-on-week increase. Current uptake is 61.9%.
- Booster uptake began in September 2021, and was initially slower than either 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> doses, with a notable exception during a national push in December. Current uptake is 41.2%.



### **Uptake by Date of COVID-19 Vaccination**



Uptake of 1st dose has slowed since the end of June, whilst uptake of 2nd dose slowed in mid-August. According to GOV.UK figures, the current rate of uptake for the 1st, 2nd and booster doses in Birmingham residents aged 12 years and over (68.3%, 61.7%, 40.6%) is significantly lower than the rates for West Midlands (80.4%, 75.0%, 57.3%) and England (91.4%, 84.8%, 65.5%).



## Uptake in Birmingham Residents -1st, 2nd and Booster Doses

- Uptake of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and booster doses remain consistently lower amongst under-50s compared to over-50s.
- Identified vulnerable groups including over-65s, clinically extremely vulnerable and COVID at-risk cohorts show good uptake of 1st and 2nd doses, with booster uptake between 50% and 65%.
- Booster uptake in NHS and social care workers is lower compared to the uptake of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses.









The largest concentration of unvaccinated individuals appear to be concentrated in the Edgbaston area, which has a large student population.

- The 18-29 years age group in this LSOA area of Edgbaston account for 63% of the estimated resident population, compared to 21% in Birmingham
- This LSOA area has the largest eligible population (7.5k) for vaccination in Birmingham. Within this population, around 50% are fully vaccinated, and a 38% have had their boosters, with gradual growth being seen.
- However, according to two surveys undertaken by the University of Birmingham, around 95% of students said they have been fully vaccinated.
- The 10 LSAOs with the largest numbers of unvaccinated are in Edgbaston, Bournbrook & Selly Park, Ladywood, Handsworth, Newtown, Aston and Alum Rock.

### **Ongoing Local Actions to Improve Vaccine Uptake**

#### The NHS in collaboration with the council continues to expand access to the vaccination programme:

- Targeted social media messages have been promoting the vaccine and its benefits, including information about walk-in locations across Birmingham. For example, one of the commissioned providers CommPlus delivered some of their community engagement on their Facebook page promoting the BSL videos on 'vaccine awareness for 12-15-year-olds'.
- "JabCab" campaign in partnership with the NHS and TOA Taxis offers free taxis targeted at residents with mobility issues. Taxis will take residents to their nearest vaccination centre.
- **Community Vaccine Champions** programme funded by the Department for Levelling Up Housing and Communities. Design and planned roll-out targeting the 10 wards with the lowest vaccine uptakes.
- Disseminate relevant information via our existing established networks commissioned engagement providers, COVID Community Champions and faith groups.
- **Deployment of multi-cultural street teams** carrying out face-to-face engagement in six lowest uptake wards, along with Sutton Walmley/Minworth, New Street Station and the Bull Ring.
- COVID-19 guidance resources toolkit around vaccine information and testing produced for commission providers to disseminate to their networks.
- Future work with council housing department, NHS, and community pharmacist on "action days" to target low uptake areas.
