Noted that the Council has made a demonstrable and meaningful response to the public consultation when defining these mitigation measures; iv.) Approved the submission of the Preferred Clean Air Zone Option Business Case to Government ahead of the 15 September 2018 deadline to satisfy the Ministerial Direction issued in December 2017; v.) Noted that a Procurement Strategy for the Clean Air Zone will be the subject of a later report; vi.) Noted that a further report will be presented to Cabinet to seek authority to implement the Clean Air Zone in accordance with the Council's Gateway and Related Financial Approval framework.
