


Children looked after rate, per 10,000 children aged under 18

Percentage of 2 year old children benefitting from funded early education






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







Average Attainment 8 score per pupil






Average Attainment 8 score per pupil at end of Key Stage 4 for pupils with SEN Support






Average Progress 8 score per pupil







Infant Mortality rate per 1,000 live births




Inpatient admission rate for mental health disorders per 100,000 pop'n aged 0-17 years






Under 18 conception Rates per 1,000 girls (15-17)
