Dear Paul,

I have spoken to the applicant Andy Heath and he agrees with the conditions 1 to 5 below to being attached to the premises license

1. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure notices shall be displayed near the entrance/exit advising customers who wish to smoke outside that they should do so with respect for the nearby residents and keep noise levels to a minimum.
2. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall be responsible for ensuring that patrons wishing to utilise the outside area do so quietly and that noise from patrons is kept to a minimum.

3. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall be responsible for ensuring that patrons smoking outside do not create a nuisance to neighbours at and if necessary restrict the number of people utilising the smoking areas at any one time. In any case there will be no more than 5 customers smoking in the outside area at any time.
4. All external doors and windows to be closed during regulated entertainment except for access and egress.
5. Customers will not be allowed to take drinks outside the premises.
