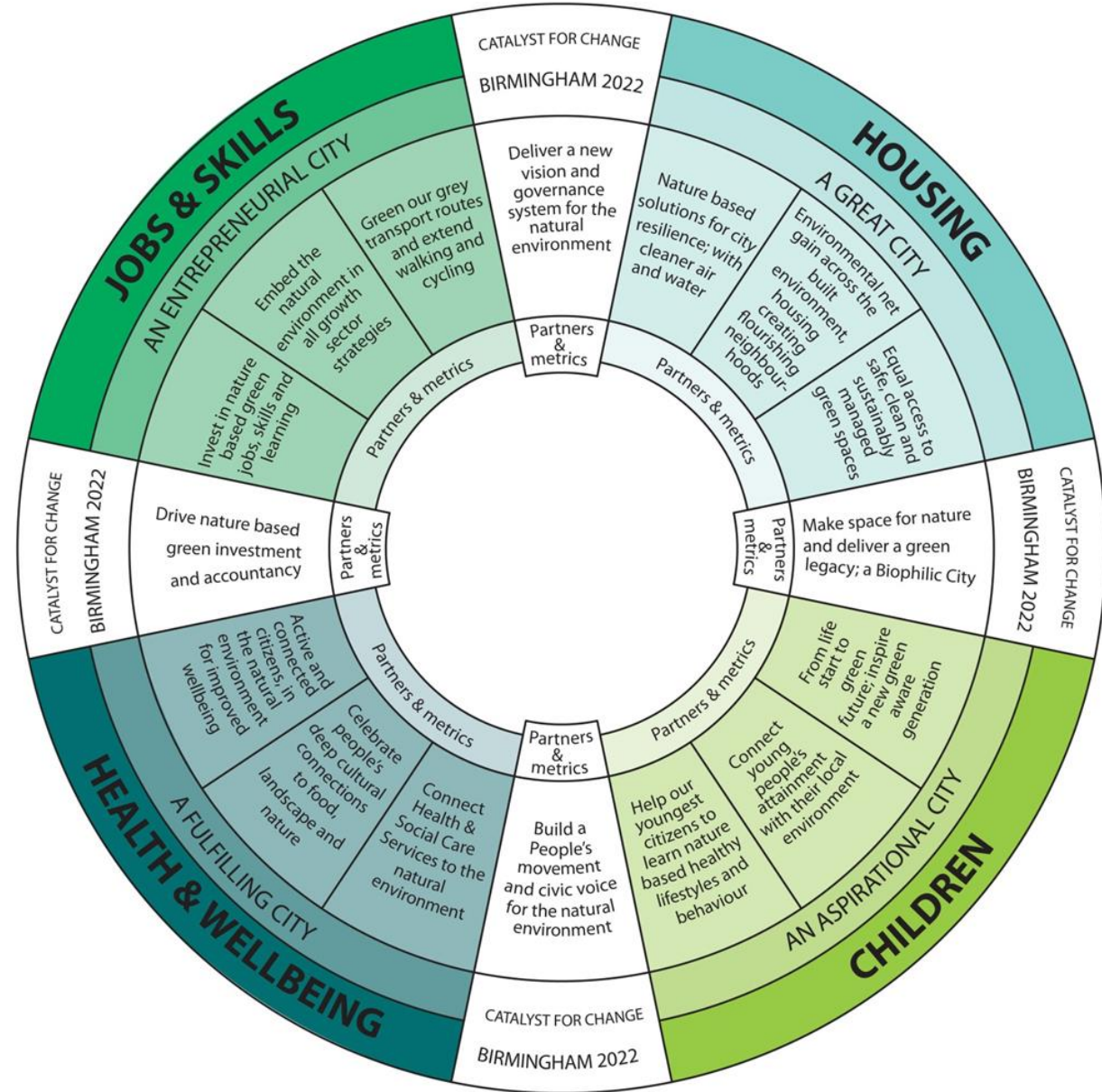

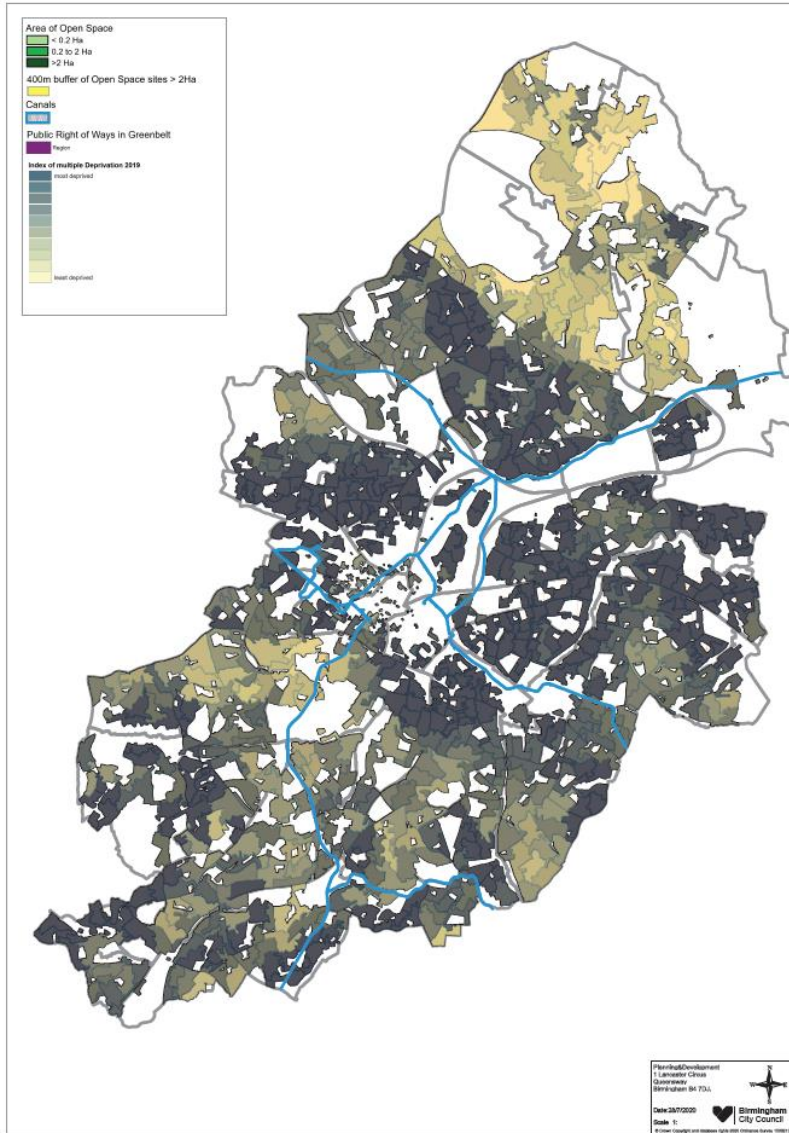
NATURALLY BIRMINGHAM'S VISION

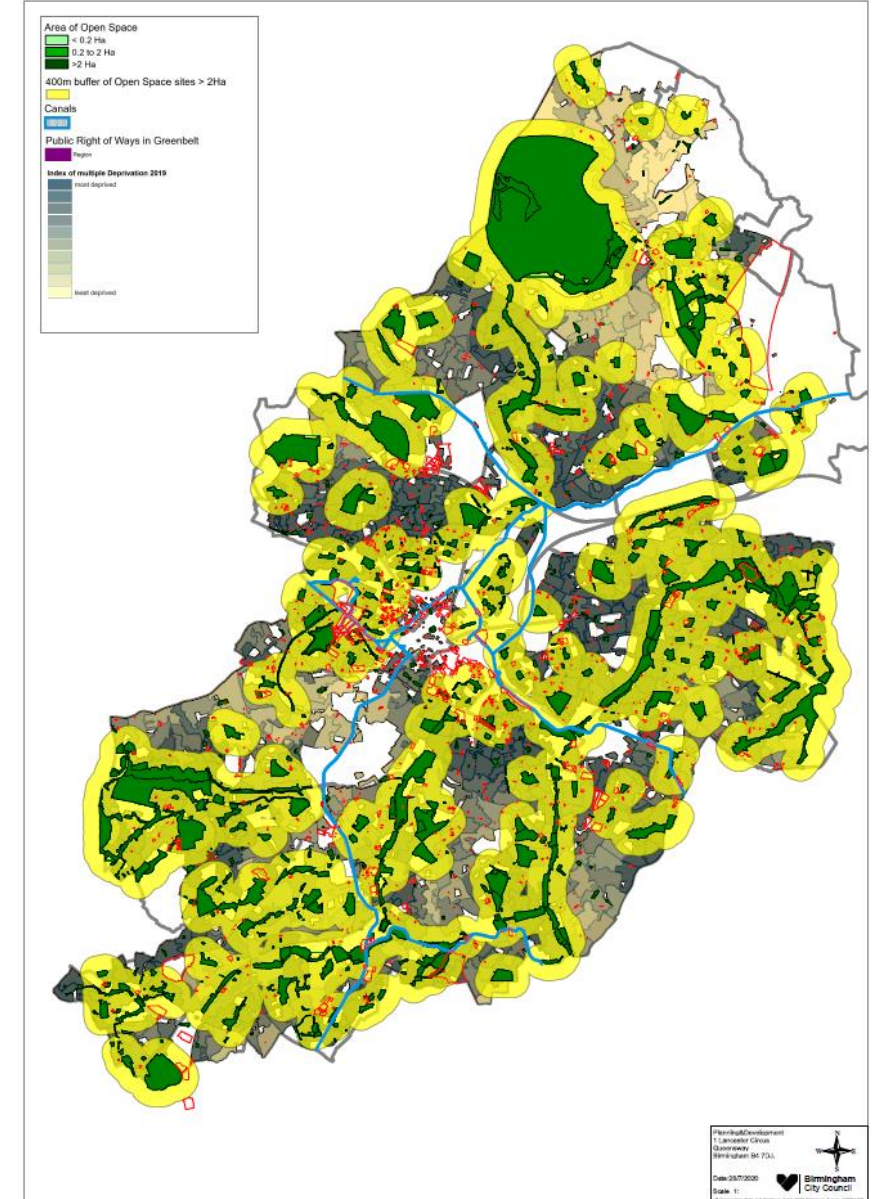

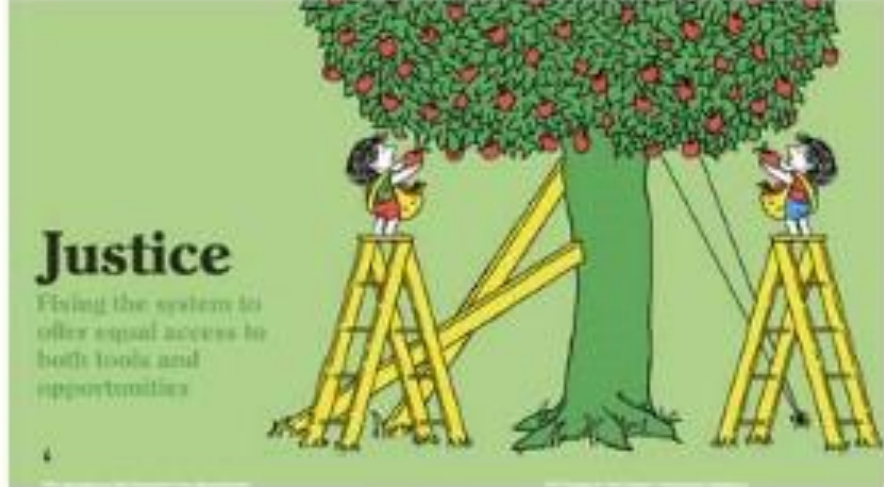
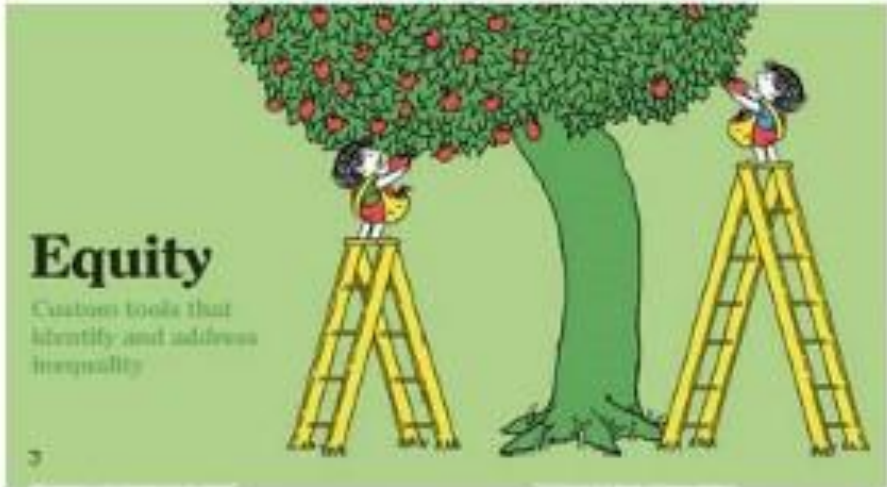
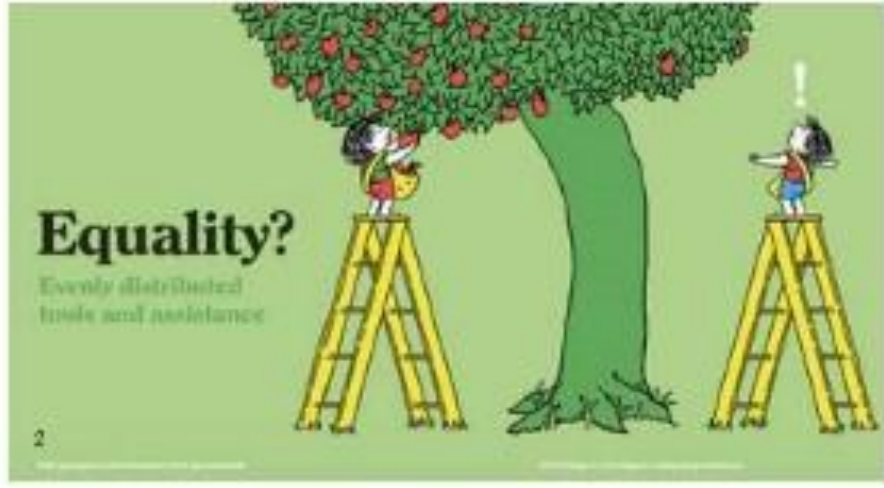
- **HOUSING PILOT:**
