LICENSING HEARING: 9TH JULY 2018

PROPOSED ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR ADDITION TO PREMISES LICENCE

Following receipt of the representation of Paul Samms of the Environmental Protection Unit, communication with regard to promotion of the licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance has been undertaken and the following set of conditions are proposed to be added to the Licence.

1. (a) The Licensee shall write to reputable taxi companies in the area to ensure that they instruct their taxi drivers when picking up and dropping off customers from the licensed premises that noise from these vehicles does not cause a nuisance to local residents.
(b) Customers who require a taxi from the site shall be encouraged by staff to use taxi companies in receipt of correspondence set out at a) from the licensee.
(c) Notices shall be displayed within the licensed premises for customers to view giving details of taxi companies to be used.
2. Bottles shall only be emptied into external waste bins between 8am and 10pm Monday to Friday and 10am and 10pm on Saturday and Sunday.
3. Screens will only be used in the external areas initially from:
 - (a) 19th June 2018 – 17th July 2018.
 - (b) prior written permission of Environmental Health
4. The use of the garden servery shall cease at 9:30pm.
5. Notices shall be displayed near the garden servery advising customers of the servery closing times.
6. The beer garden will be cleared of all patrons by 10pm each night. Staff will ensure that patrons are escorted inside the building.
7. The beer garden may be used by patrons after 10pm to smoke but will not be allowed to take drinks into the beer garden. The DPS shall be responsible for ensuring

that patrons wishing to utilise the outside areas do so quietly and that noise from patrons moving to and from the external areas is kept to a minimum. The DPS shall be responsible for ensuring that the area does not create a nuisance to neighbours and if necessary restrict the number of people utilising the areas at any one time. In addition, if necessary the DPS will increase the number of staff to control customers.
