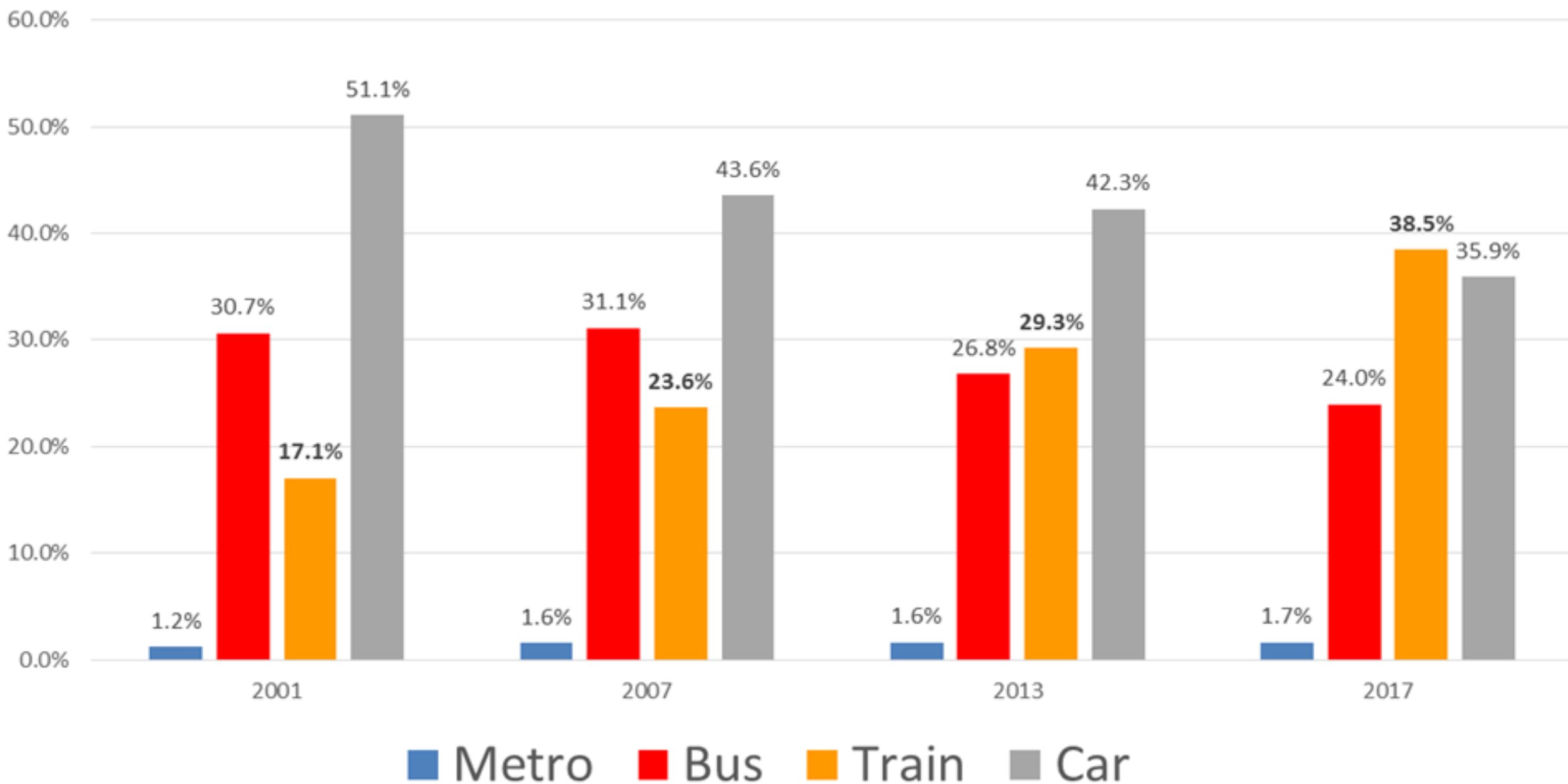

# Birmingham AM Peak Modal Share

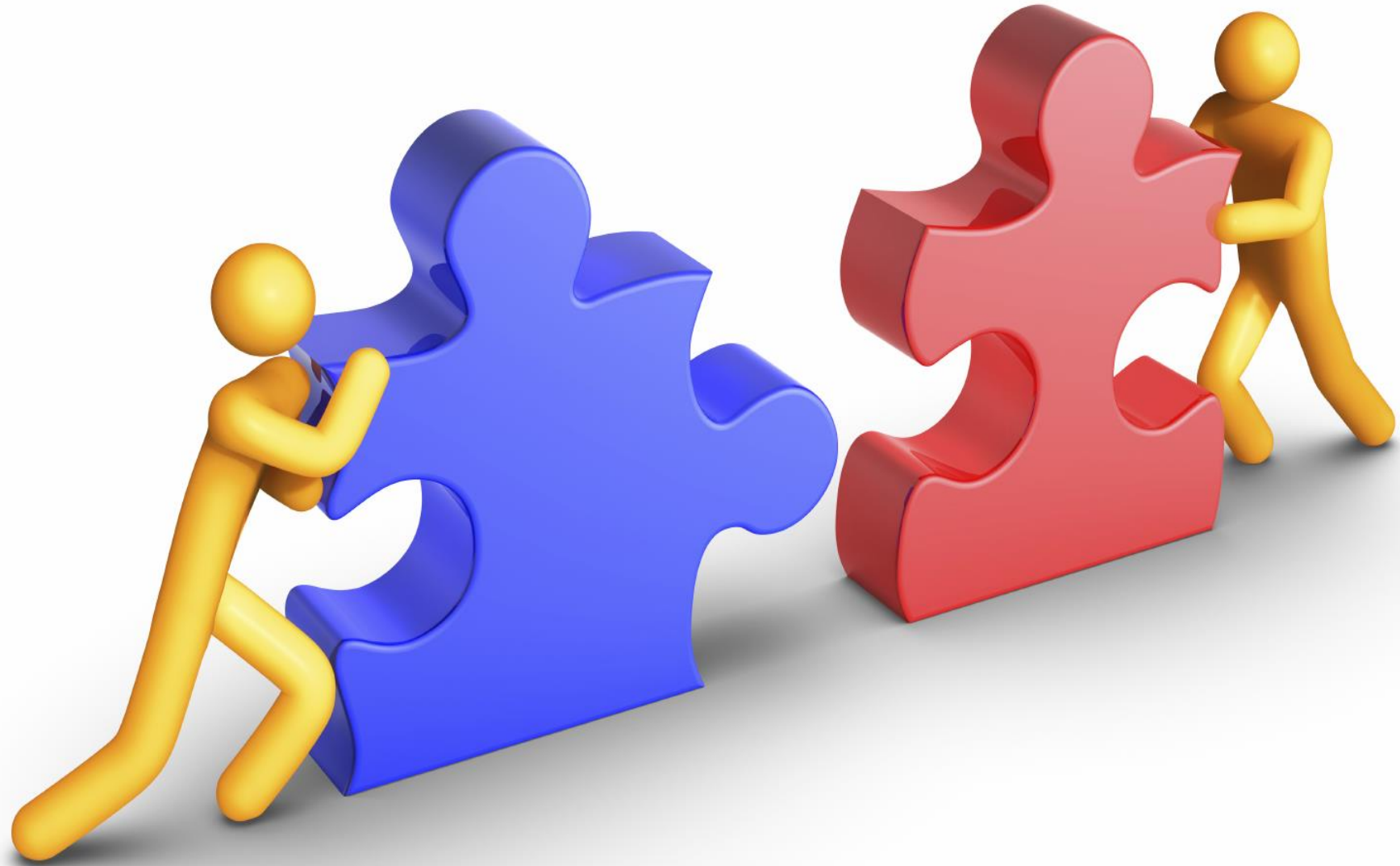




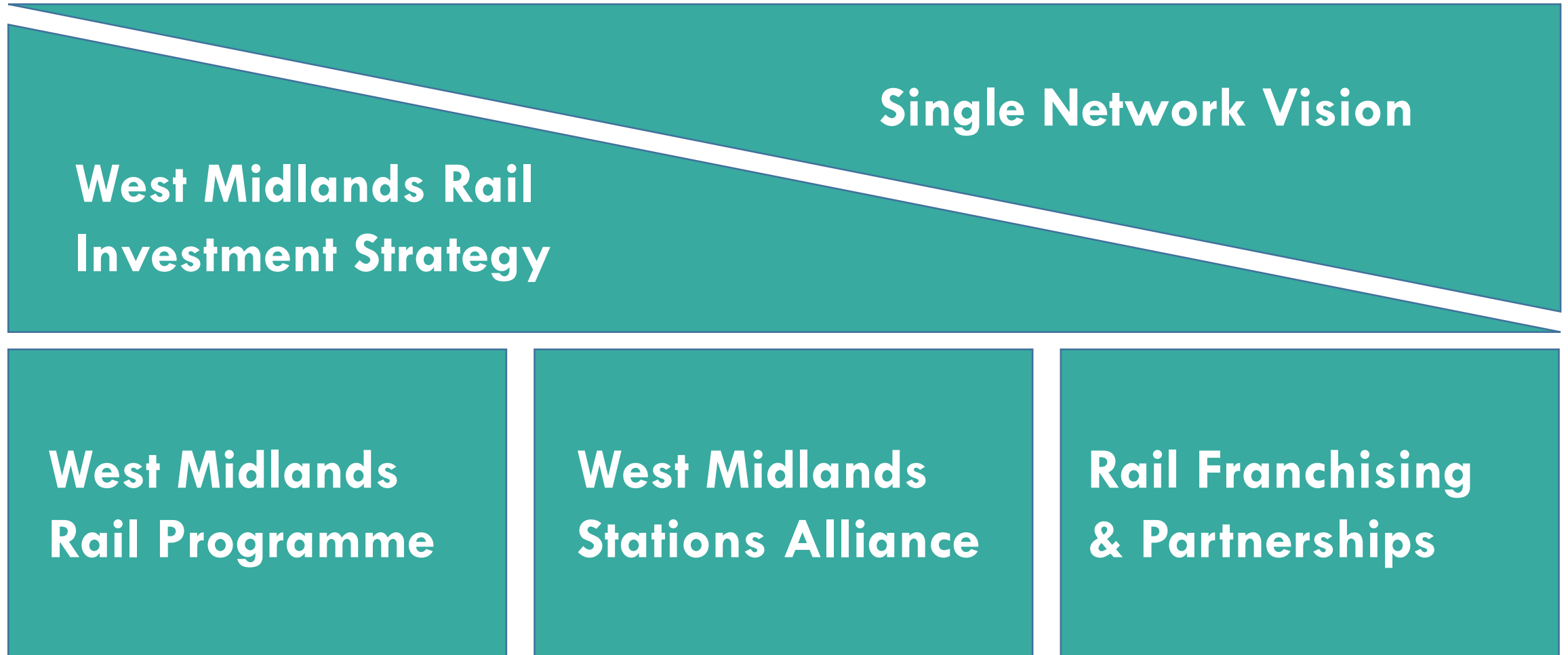

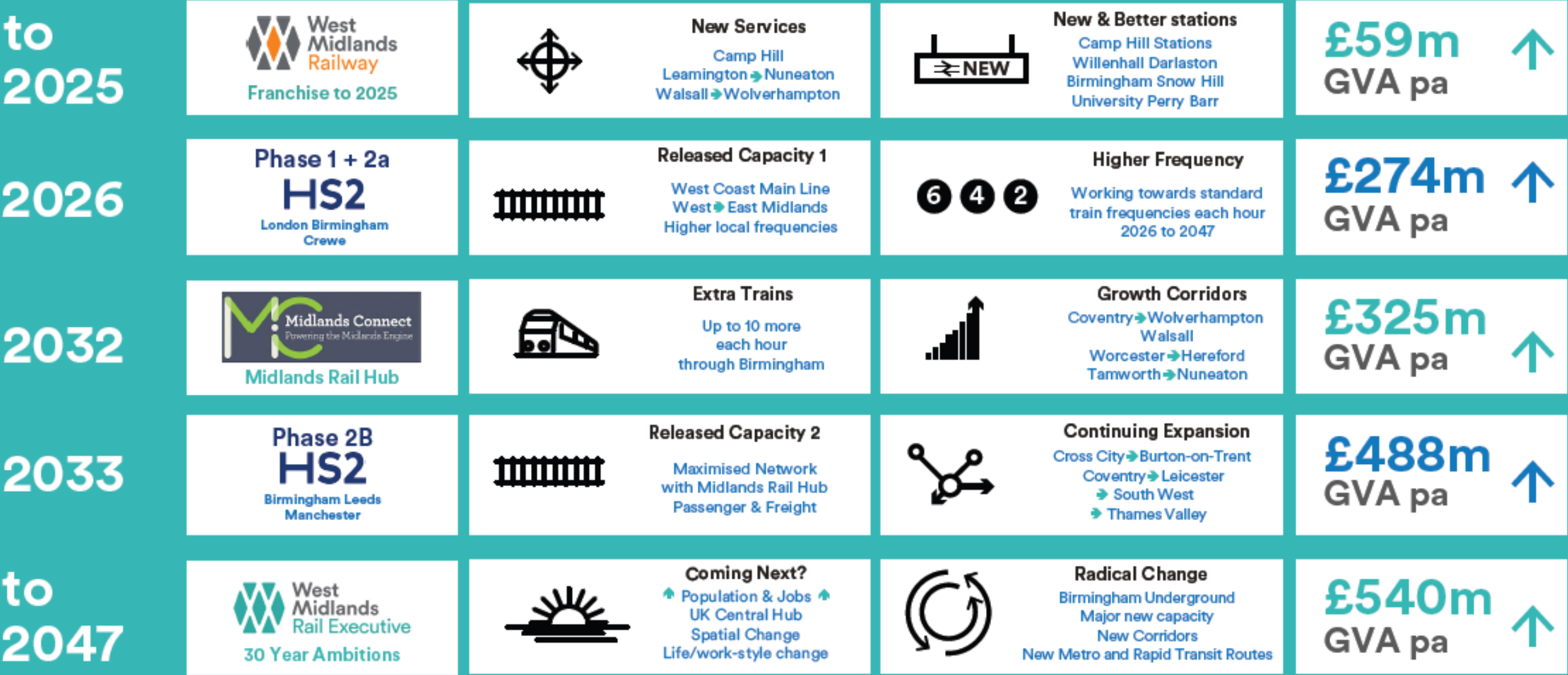
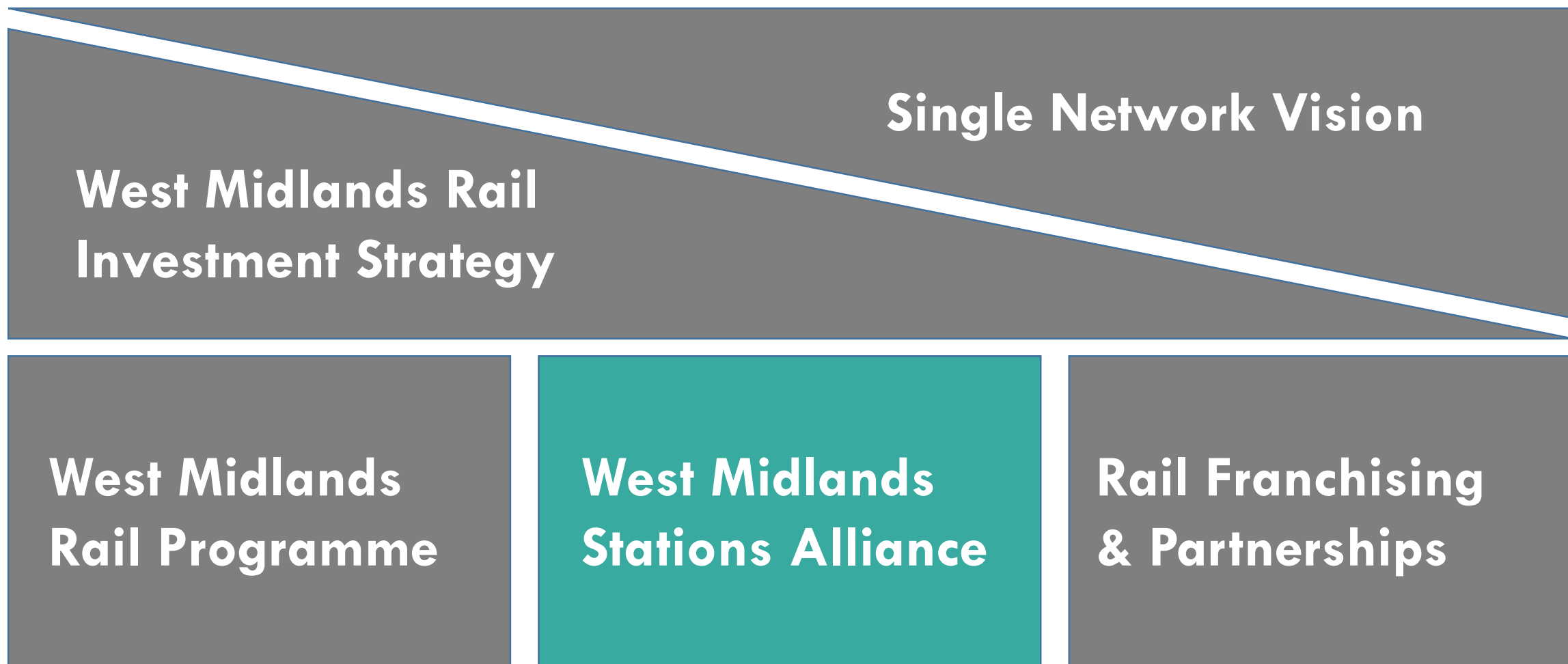


Figure 3 – West Midlands Rail Investment Strategy 2018-2047

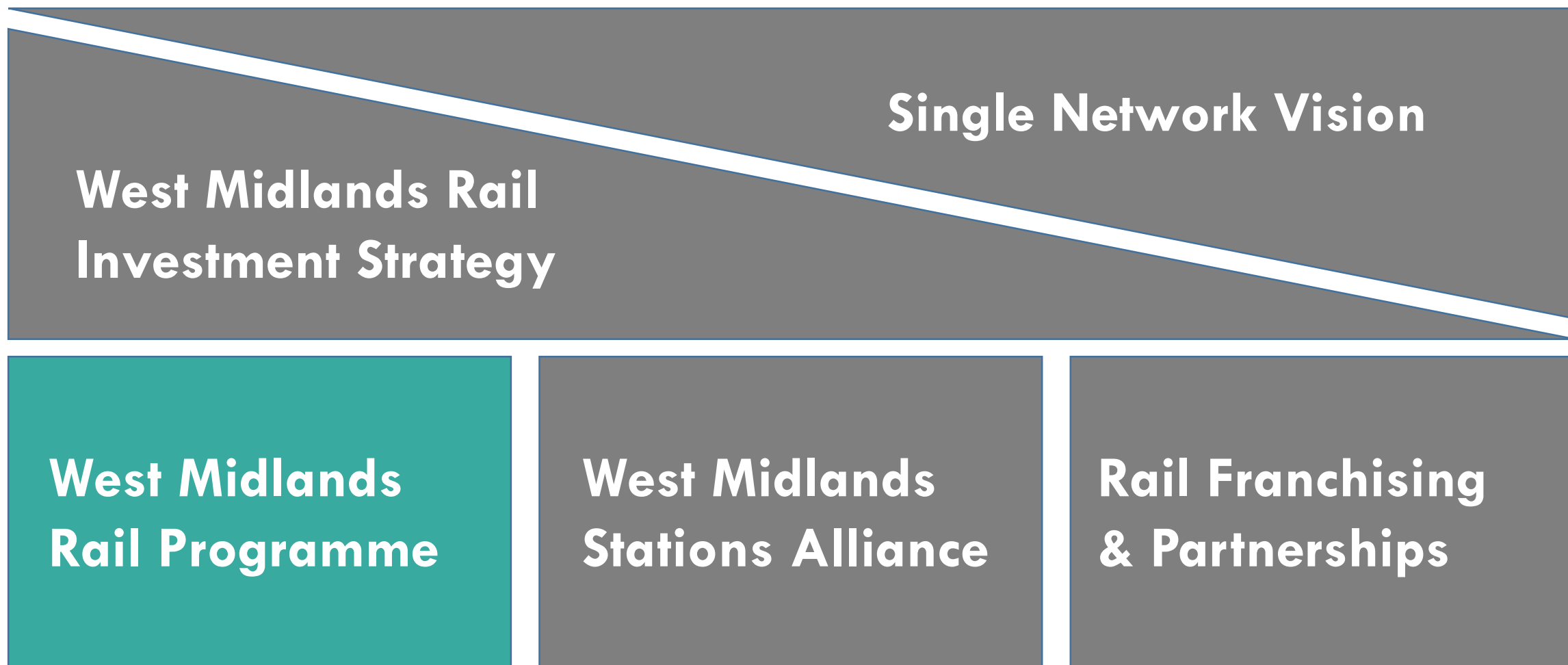

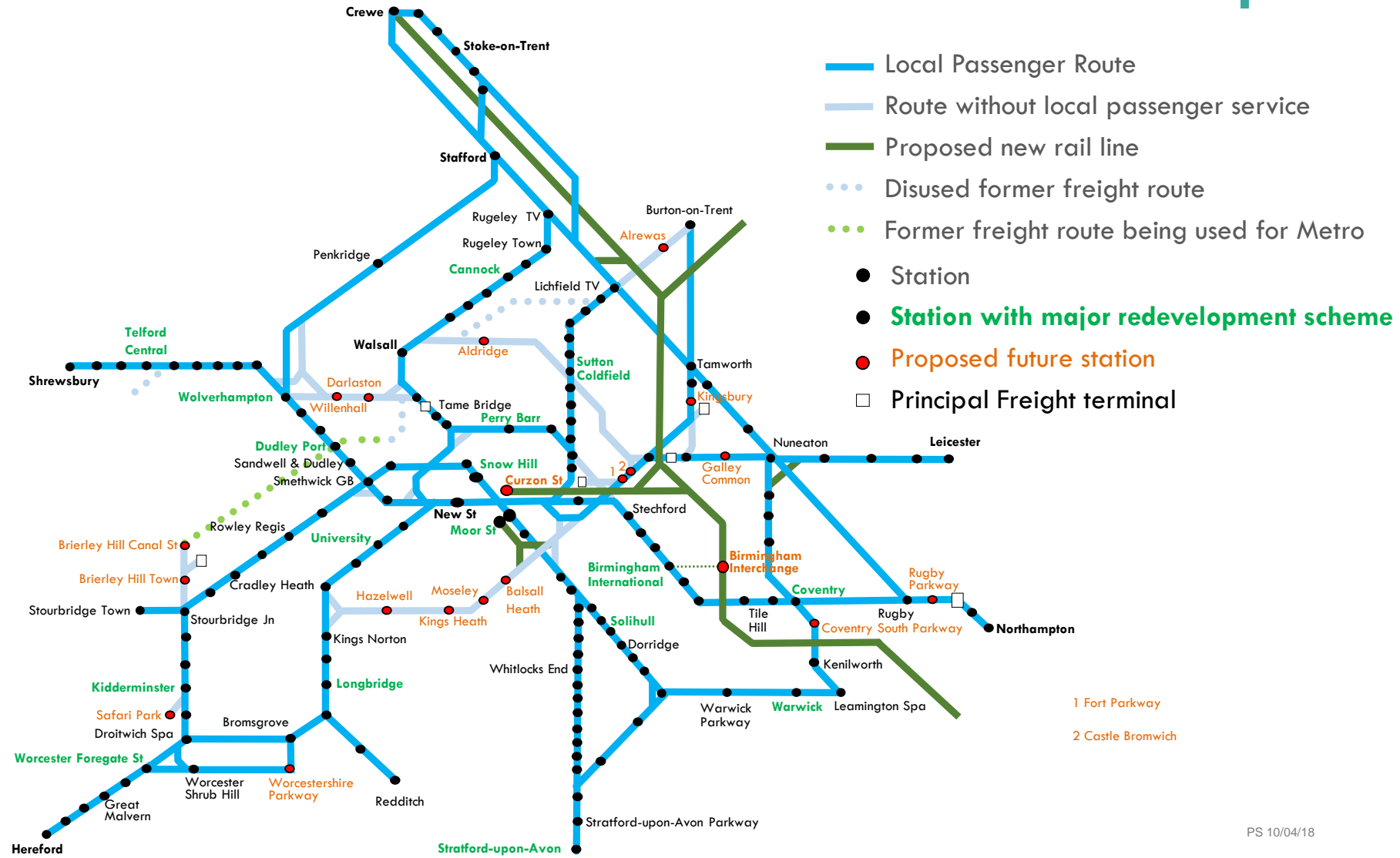

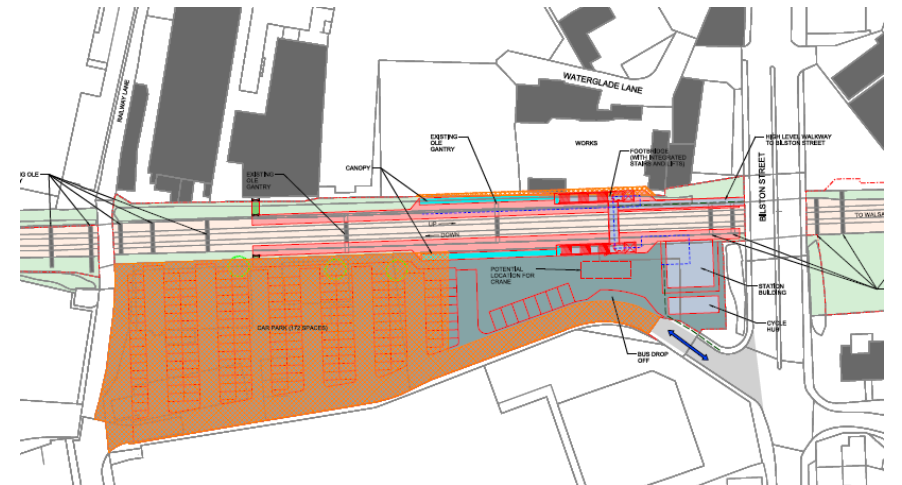

# New Stations – Package 2

- Camp Hill Line
  - New stations at Moseley, Kings Heath and Hazelwell
  - On a highly congested road corridor into Birmingham but an underutilised rail line
  - Significant commuting into Birmingham by car and bus currently which could transfer to rail.
  - No car parking provision
- Current programmes indicate delivery in 2021/22
- Active development work on train services to serve stations underway



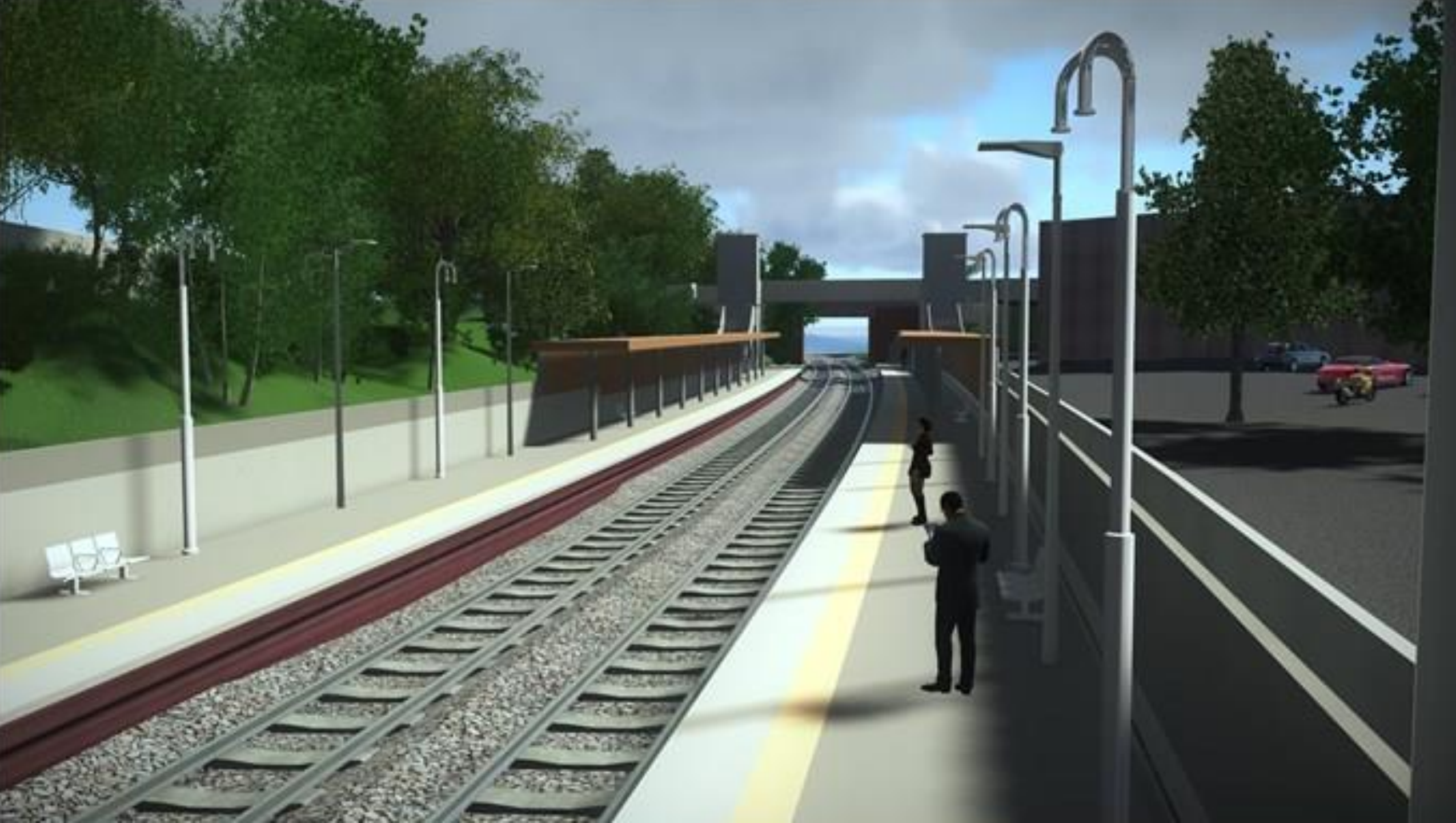










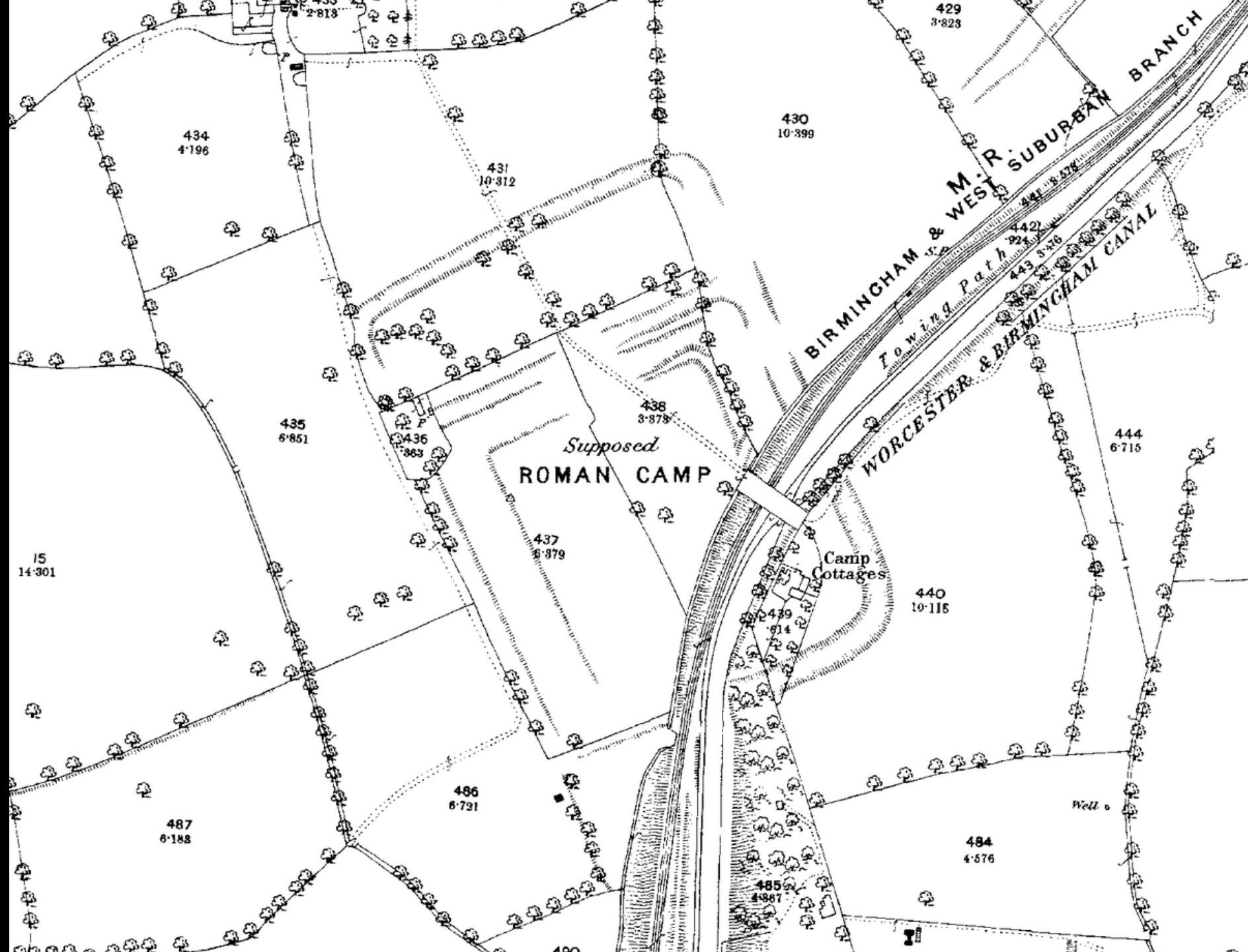




# University Station

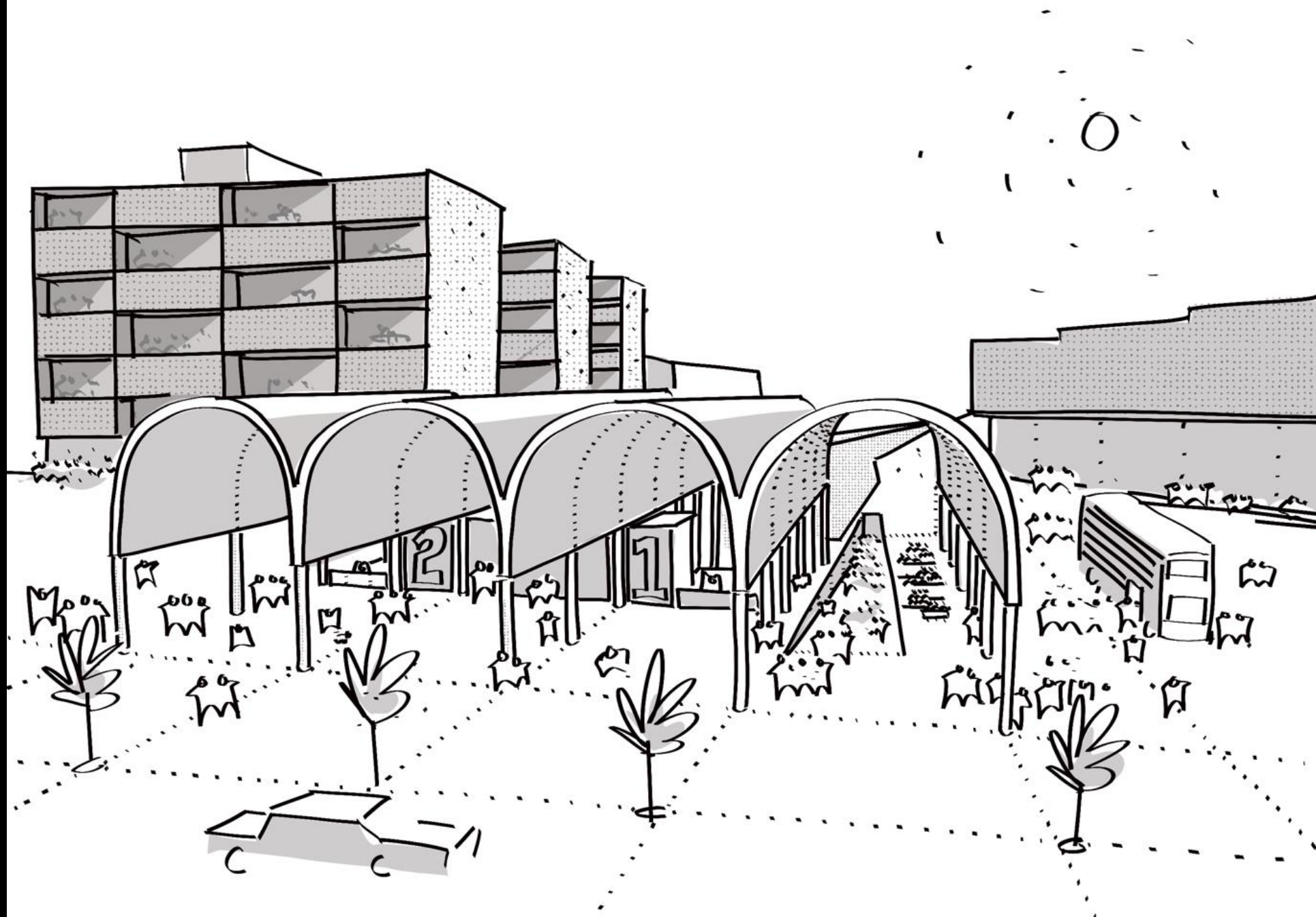

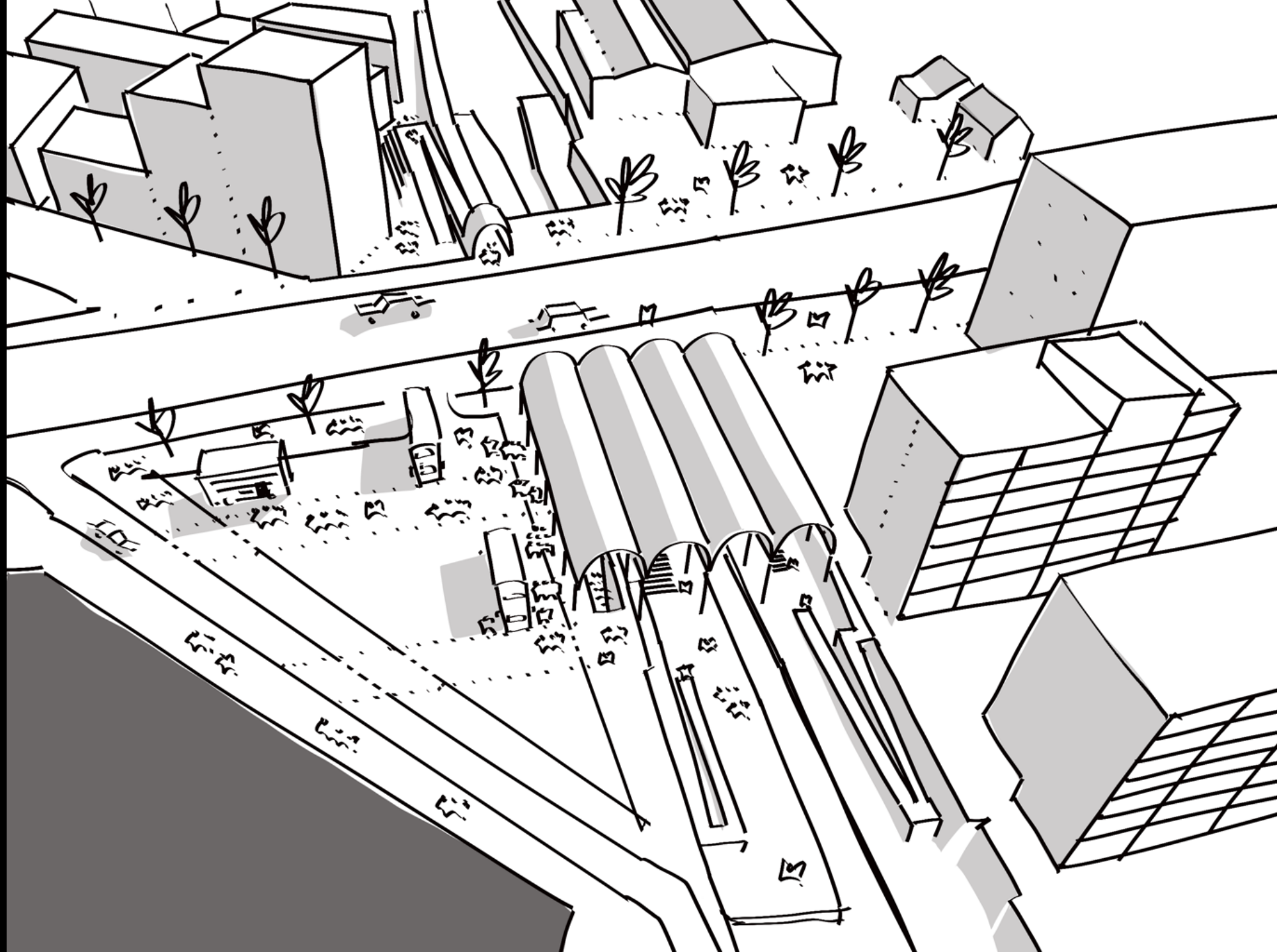

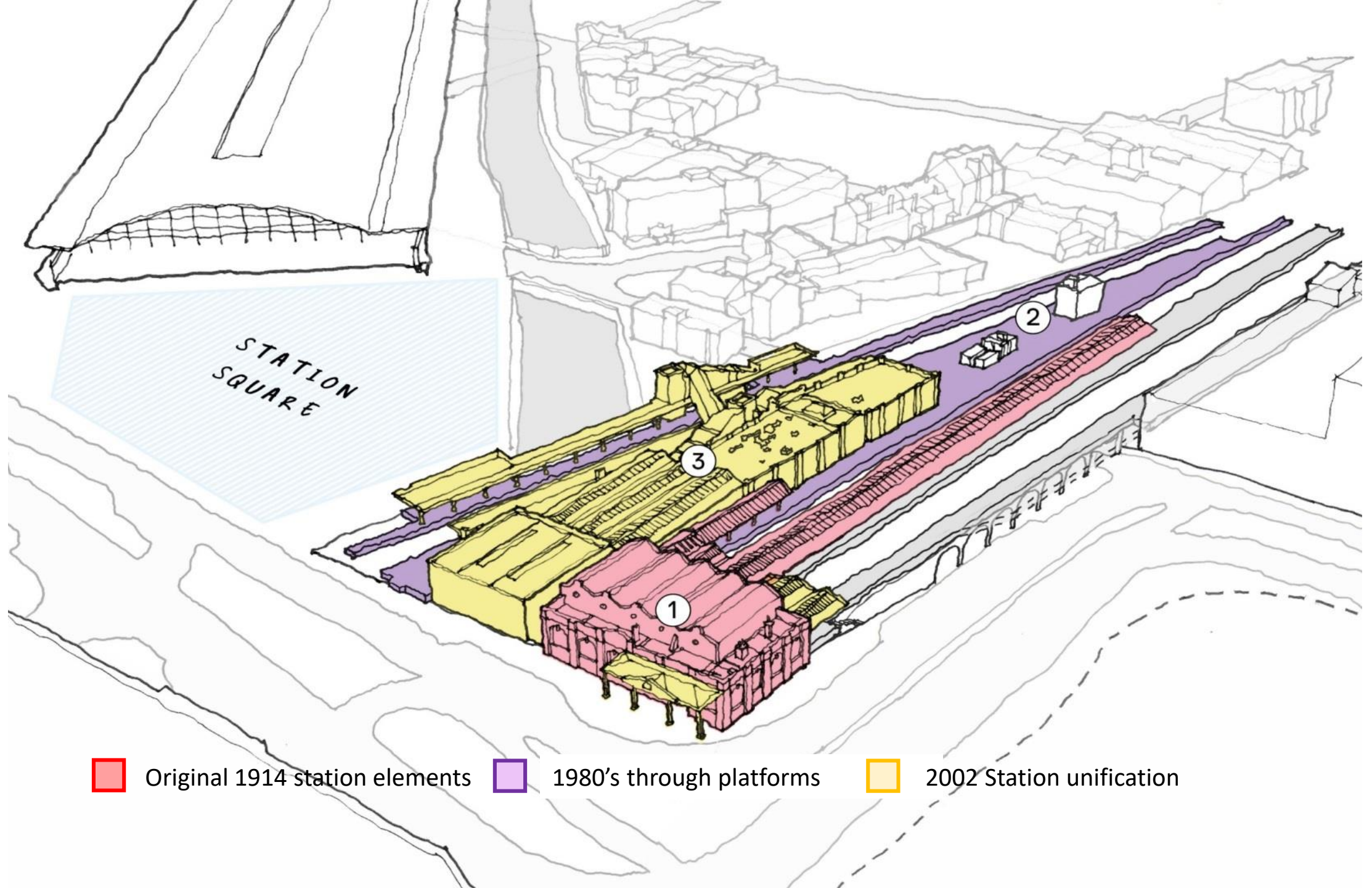


# Moor Street Station

- Development funds required



























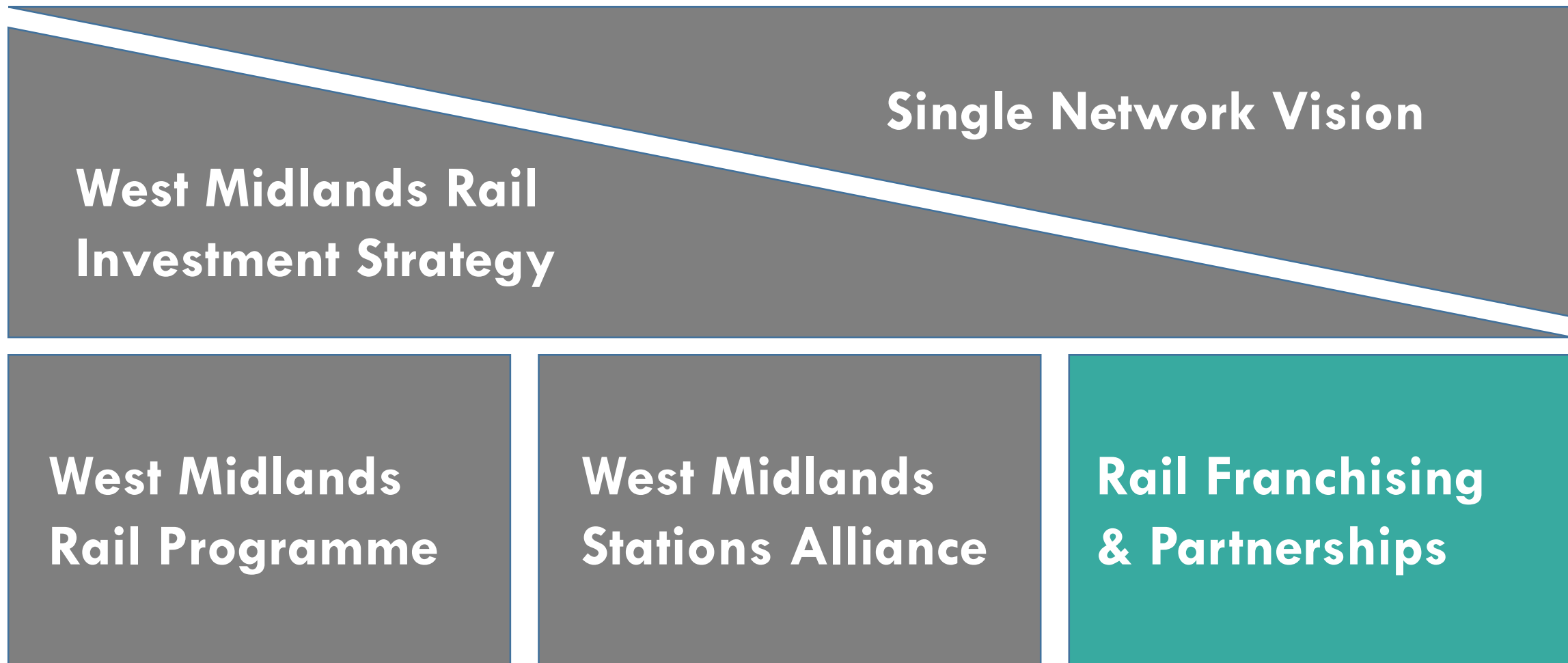
