1. Purpose of report:

To consider a relevant representation that has been made in respect of an application for a Premises Licence which seeks to permit the Sale of Alcohol (for consumption both on and off the premises) to operate from 10:00am until 10:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

Premises to remain open to the public from 06:00am until 10:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

2. Recommendation:

To consider the representation that has been made and to determine the application.

3. Brief Summary of Report:

An application for a Premises Licence was received on 18th April 2017 in respect of Bannatyne Health Club, 3 Brunswick Arcade, Brindley Place, Birmingham, B1 2JF.

A representation has been received from other persons.

4. Compliance Issues:

4.1 Consistency with relevant Council Policies, Plans or Strategies:

The report complies with the City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Council's Corporate Plan to improve the standard of all licensed persons, premises and vehicles in the City.

5. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

Bannatyne Fitness Limited applied on 18th April 2017 for the grant of a Premises Licence for Bannatyne Health Club, 3 Brunswick Arcade, Brindley Place, Birmingham, B1 2JF.

A representation has been received from other persons, which is attached at Appendix 1.

The application is attached at Appendix 2.

Site Location Plans at Appendix 3.

It should be noted that there is a special policy in force for the Broad Street area. The effect of a special policy is to create a rebuttable presumption that applications for new licences or material variations to existing licences will normally be refused unless it can be shown that the premises concerned will not add to the cumulative impact on the licensing objectives being experienced.

The Council will expect the applicant to demonstrate the steps it will take to promote the licensing objectives. Where relevant representations are made, the Council will consider the application on its individual merits and decide whether to apply the special policy.

When carrying out its licensing functions, a licensing authority must have regard to Birmingham City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Guidance issued by the Secretary of State under s182 of the Licensing Act 2003. The Licensing Authority is also required to take such steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, which are:-

- a. The prevention of crime and disorder;
- b. Public safety;
- c. The prevention of public nuisance; and
- d. The protection of children from harm.

Re:- Application reference 101377 Bannatyne Fitness Limited,

We are the managing agents for the development of residential flats at Symphony Court and have been instructed by the directors of Symphony Court Management Limited which owns the development to object to this application on their behalf, and on behalf of the owners of the flats in the development.

The application is for a new licence to sell alcohol both and off the premises on every day, including Sundays, between 10.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.

It is difficult to see any justification for yet another outlet for the sale of alcohol in an area of Birmingham which is already very well provided with bars and public houses in close proximity to the premises in respect of which the application is being made.

It is impossible to justify a members' club selling alcohol for consumption off the premises. That would in effect be turning it into an off licence which must surely be incompatible with the concept of a fitness club.

Consumption of alcohol on the premises as proposed would be to make the club a recreational meeting place rather than a health club.

Any additional outlet for the sale of alcohol to the public generally increases the risk of rowdy behaviour near to residential property.

For these reasons the directors request that the application be refused.
