Description of Priority and Delivery Arrangements

Birmingham North Local Community Safety Partnership:

Birmingham North Local Community Safety Partnership (NLCSP) is chaired by Supt Brandon Langley WMP and supported by Pam Powis (Safer Neighbourhood Partnership Manager, BCC). Membership consists of representatives from BCC District Services, BCC Housing, BCC Environmental Services, BCC Youth Service and Youth Offending Team, Adult Social Care, BCC Children Services, BCC Community Safety, Birmingham Social Housing Partnership, BSMHFT, Public Health, WM Probation Services, West Midlands Police, West Midlands Fire Service, Cross city CCG, Education, 3rd Sector agencies - Aquarius, CRI, YMCA, Compass Support, Kingstanding Regeneration Trust (KRT), Witton Lodge Community Association, Pioneer Group, Ashram, BSWA, and Urban Devotion.

The priorities for 2016/17 for Birmingham North LCSP are as follows:

- Young People
- Domestic Abuse
- Violence – (this will be divided – DV will be owned by the Domestic Abuse Group. Youth Violence will be owned by Youth Group and the neighbourhood priorities will be owned by WMP who will create partnership groups.)
- Building Neighbourhoods (this is with a particular focus on theme of "Safer, Stronger, Sustainable Neighbourhoods" and a mechanism to oversee and monitor cross cutting issues within each of the North's Neighbourhood Tasking Groups Eg – road safety, burglary, environmental and Anti-Social Behaviour. This group will also be the partnership lead for the 8 Place Manager's neighbourhood profiles.)
- Vulnerable People (this will be delivered by two groups 1) LCSP Vulnerable Adults Group, and the Hub Integration Partnership (HIP) which will focus on families and children)
- Night Time Economy and Business Crime (this will be delivered through the Purple Flag working group and in close partnership with the Erdington and Sutton Coldfield BID's)

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These priorities were decided via a partnership event held on 22 January 2016 and are pending a sign off at the Erdington and Sutton Goldfield District

Commitments.

Delivery:

Each of the priorities will sit within a partnership sub group which will meet depending on the need. Where a sub group is needed each will own a delivery plan which will include a brief of the purpose of the group, details of outcomes and an action tracker which ensure timescales and checks are in place. All groups will be monitored and supported by the North LCSP which will meet bi monthly.
