4. Details of association of the above premises with serious crime, serious disorder or both:

These premises are located in an industrial area of Digbeth, with residential housing a short distance away. It is a destination venue in that it puts events on to attract its clientele.

At approximately 03.11 hours on Saturday 12th May 2018 a 999 call was received stating that there had been a party and that someone had fired a gun and they are all fighting. The location given initially was an adjoining premise.

Officers from the firearm unit and general response officers attended, upon arrival they witnessed large numbers of people panicking and star bursting trying to get away and several vehicles making off at speed from the location, one of which was then involved in a collision.

Officers have then spoken to security or a person purporting to be a security operative and he stated that he had seen a gun being pointed at someone's head inside the club on the dance floor, and that then disorder took place inside the club.

Officers also spoke to the event organiser who also confirmed that disorder had happened inside the premises and that they had then been ejected but she had not seen any firearm.

Enquiries also revealed that the individuals believed to be involved in the disorder are known members of organised crime groups, and involved in the possession of firearms and other serious offences. The organiser of this event who is also believed to be a member of the management team has been linked to other events at other venues where members of organised crime groups have frequented and firearms have been discharged or produced.

Officers were told the DPS was a Jordan Patel and that only he had access to the CCTV system. He was contacted and provided officers with a memory stick with CCTV on it.

The CCTV does not show any disorder which contradicts the accounts given to officers from witnesses, security and management. Further CCTV work is being undertaken.

From accounts made to officers it is clear something significant happened that caused people to panic and star burst in an attempt to get away. Officers have recorded in the incident log that people were telling them that someone had pointed a gun at another person's head inside the club and that this had then lead to the disorder.


This is a very concerning incident for West Midlands Police, the production of a firearm is a serious offence and has been crimed as such, people at the venue were clearly concerned for their own safety. The fact that known members of organised crime groups have also been named as being involved in the disorder only goes to enhance the concerns of West Midlands Police further.

The history of these premises is also of concern, in November 2017 West Midlands Police applied for an expedited review against these premises following further incidents of disorder, which was resolved with a number of conditions, some of which have been breached in the opinion of West Midlands Police.

West Midlands Police consider this premises to be a serious threat to public safety through its association with serious crime and serious disorder and are seeking the immediate suspension of the premise licence.

I am a Superintendent in West Midlands Police.

I am giving this certificate because I am in the opinion that the procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case because the standard review procedures are thought to be inappropriate due to the seriousness of the crime and the disorder, and the serious management failings of the premises concerned.

The level and seriousness of the incident both in terms of the crimes being committed and the serious disorder warrant the use of this power. I have considered the use of the normal review procedure but I do not feel this would be appropriate in these circumstances due to the above reasons, and the fact that to maintain the licensing objective of preventing crime and disorder the normal review procedure would not be sufficient.


The matter has been crimed as Possession of a firearm with intent to cause fear and violence, which is deemed as a serious offence under the provisions of section 81 of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000.

A closure notice was not issued on either night mainly as officers were very busy dealing with the incidents and the numerous injured persons, and gathering as much evidence as possible, however the severity of the incidents is a matter that needs to be brought to the attention of the Licensing Committee immediately.

The recent history of these premises is also of concern in that West Midlands Police applied for another expedited review in November of 2017 following other incidents of serious disorder.

The concern of West Midlands Police is that if steps are not taken to consider the running of these premises they will continue to be used in the manner in which they were discovered on the weekend of 12th May 2018. I am conscious of the guidance on the use of "Expedited Reviews" and given the emphasis that is given to use of this power to tackle serious crime and disorder, my feelings that this process is deemed appropriate are further enforced.

I am the above named person currently a serving Police Officer within West Midlands Police. I am currently based in the Birmingham City Licensing department as a licensing officer. I have been a licensing officer for approximately 15 years always based in Birmingham City Centre.

This statement is in relation to a premises called Arthouse, which has a postal address of 54 Bissell Street, Birmingham.

In November 2017 West Midlands Police issued a certificate and application under section 53(a) of the licensing act, following serious disorder and/or serious offence at the premises. As a result of this application Birmingham City Council licensing committee imposed several conditions that had to be complied with to allow the premises to reopen.

These are detailed within the premise licence in full, but can be summarised in short as follows

- Jordan Patel to have no management control of the premises
- evidence to be shown that Jordan Patel has no directorship control on the premises
- DPS to be replaced with Steve Bailey within 7 days
- CCTV conditions to be amended
- notification of events to be detailed in a planner, 28 days in advance.

I am aware that West Midlands Police were told that Jordan Patel had been removed and replaced by Lucy Wilcox, who also took on directorship of the company according to companies house records.

The DPS was replaced to Steve Bailey, although the DPS was again changed in February and April of 2018. The current DPS is called Jacob Kerin, whom I have never met or had any communication with.

I have checked our Licensing database and on the 27th April we have saved a Venue Management Plan for

Arthouse. It was completed by a company called Tactical Licensing Consultants and details all events at Arthouse for May 2018. There are 10 dates listed in the plan, all but 2 of the events are classed as "Inhouse" with two events on the 6th May and 26th May being classed as external. There are no details of the 2 external events contained within the 7 page document.

There are a further two entries within our Licensing database, one for Junes events which was dated 8th May and then one for a special event due to take place on the 26th May and 2nd June for an event called SC Events.

At approximately 03.11 hours on Saturday 12th May 2018 West Midlands Police received an 999 call stating that a gun had been discharged and people were fleeing, initially the location was given as an adjoining premises.

Officers attended the scene from the firearms unit, who were wearing body worn cameras, this has been viewed by Ps Martin Williams and he documents what he saw in his statement.

In the statement from PS Martin Williams he gives the name of someone claiming to be security from Arthouse, I have looked at the security list provided by Arthouse after the incident and can confirm there is someone with that name on the list.

I have reviewed the command and control log for this incident, log 296 of the 12th May 2018. At 04.18.44 there is a WebOasis update, which indicates to me that someone has physically updated the log rather than use the radio to communicate in, and for someone else to type up the response.

At this entry time (Pg 5/13) it indicates that there were large numbers of people present at time of the ARV arrival. ARV is shortened code for Armed Response vehicle. It indicates large numbers fleeing the location with several being stopped, who confirmed that a person has been present with a firearm but there was no corroboration of the firearm being discharged.

There is then an entry at 04.53.43 again via WebOasis, in this entry the name of the premises is confirmed as Art House, the entry details that the DPS is Jordan Patel and gives a dob and a mobile number, and that the person present claimed to be the duty manager called Tenesha Stewart again with a dob. The log entry continues that Tenesha that there had been disorder on the dance floor and that 2 parties had been ejected by doorstaff, but she had no knowledge on any firearm being produced and does not know that parties involved. She confirms that there is CCTV however only Jordan can operate the system. The log indicates that attempts were made at that time to contact Jordan but it went straight to voicemail.

From a professional point of view looking at this point of the log entry, firstly it is clear to us that Jordan Patel still plays a vital role and managerial role within Art House. The entry on the log is very specific in its

detail around only Jordan being able to view the CCTV, and that officers are given his contact details. Neither the correct DPS or premise licence holder are notified to officers attending.

Tenesha Stewart is a person who has come to our attention before, although we knew she was working at the premises there is nothing legally West Midlands Police could do as her role was not one that required either a licence or permission. It is of public record to state that Tenesha Stewart has been involved in premises in Birmingham where firearms have been produced and discharged and that members of Organised Crime Groups have been know to frequent those premises.

The fact that the CCTV could not be accessed is also of concern especially as the conditions imposed after the last summary expedited review specifically states that the DPS or authorised member of staff in his absence should be able to view and download the cctv at the request of the Police. Tenesha Stewart who claimed to be the manager on duty was unable to do this and specifically informed officers that only Jordan Patel could do this.

At 09.44.22 (pg 7/13) officers note that they have made contact with Jordan Patel, the log indicates that he initially states he could not attend the premises to show officers the CCTV as he was on his way to his brothers wedding. At no time is there any mention of officers being given other peoples details as an alternative to contact to obtain the CCTV. It is only after officers indicate that a closure notice would be persued if the CCTV was not obtained did Jordan Patel agree to meet officers at 1500 hours at the location.

The demand on West Midlands Police that day was exceptional meaning officers were unable to attend exactly at 1500 hours. There is a call from Jordan patel times at 15.28.58, he is described as irate, and then indicates that the incident is not even anything to do with his venue.

Officers did attend although late and were handed a memory stick.

The CCTV has been viewed and does not show the incident which counters the first hand accounts of the witness, the security staff and the duty manager.

The CCTV has been viewed by a member of West Midlands Police Organised Crime and Gang unit. In this statement the officer does state that persons know to West Midlands Police as being members of organised Crime gangs are seen at the premises within the dancefloor.

Immediately after the incident I emailed the premise licence holder Lucy Wilcox (14th May) asking for the incident book and copy of doorstaff register.

On the 15th May I received a reply from Lucy Wilcox stating that one of her opertaions team have been dealing with the incident in her absence, and that they would be sent to me by Friday.

Later on the 15th I received an email from Jordan Patel, indicating that Lucy had asked him to send over the required information, which he was doing so as the paperwork was attached. The fact that Jordan was sending me this information was a surpriss considering that he should not have any managerial control at the premises.

The documentation sent to me, show 6 door supervisors, and then a blank incident report book. Again this counters what officers were told by the duty manager that something had happened on the dance floor and both parties had been ejected.

On the 17th May 2018 I contacted Lucy Wilcox again and asked for the details of the private party and form and indicated that extra CCTV would be required but I was just waiting details.

Lucy replied to me that day with the booking for the private party, but indicated as it was an internal event no risk assessment had been completed as it was not necessary. I was also given the details of the CCTV provider and told to go through them for the additional footage I required.

On the 21st May I responded to Lucy asking more questions around who made the birthday booking, where they known to management, how it was determined as in house. I also indicated that as the CCTV was thiers any additional footage would have to go through them, and requested additional CCTV footage.

On the 22nd May I received a response from Lucy, in relation to the event on the night, i was told that the event had been booked through Tenesha Stewart, the persons whose birthday it was for, was not known to the managment and that they had classed it as in house as they were using their own DJ and security, and someone had just phoned to see if they could use the club for his birthday.

In terms of CCTV, Lucy indicated that she would contact the engineers.

On the 25th May I received an email from Lucy with attachments, in the email she indicated that the engineer had been called back to the premises on the day of the incident as a result of power cut, and that one of the hard drives had burnt out and so the footage was deleted.

This was the first time any such problem with the CCTV had been mentioned. On examing the letter from the CCTV engineer dated the 25th May 2018, it showed that he had been called to the premises on the 12th May to download footage as requested. He does not indicate what time frames he was asked to provide for, he then states he was called back on the same day at 2200 hours, as they said they had had a power cut and the system was not functioning correctly. The letter also seems to indicate that they were having issues with the sockets which were hanging off the wall, and plugged into an extension lead and due to an incorrect shut down this had caused problems on Hard Drive 3 and 4. The letter indicates that to correct the

problem Hard Drive 3 and 4 would have to be reformatted which would result in the loss of the data. Also attached was the authorisation from the duty manager to reformat the system, this was signed by Tenesha Stewart.

There is no proof that there was a power cut that day, and it seems strange that hard drive 1 and 2 were unaffected. It is also concerning that having known that we were looking at a potential issue at the premises it was Tenesha Stewart - the manager that had initially told us that something had happened on the dance floor, had authorised the reformatting of the hard drive and not the DPS or the Premise licence holder.

The letter authorising the reformatting of the hard drives had been signed on the 12th May, however it was not until the 25th May were we informed there had been issues with the hard drives.

I have also emailed the CCTV provider asking for clarity on the hours he was asked to provide for but he has not come back to me with an reply.

On or around the 25th May I also had reason to speak to a promoter who had used the venue recently, concerned around issues with the booking process for Arthouse and the money they were taking from people and not refunding. The nature of these allegations has meant we have referred to the promoter to Action Fraud around possible criminal activity.

The contents of the statement provided to me are of concern but will be addressed privately (if granted) to the committee so as to not jeopardise any criminal investigation, however they show the level of involvement Jordan Patel has with the premises.

Overall, I have been aware of these premises for some time, although I have not been their main licensing officer. I have no doubt that a firearm was produced on the night in question, it is clear from the first had description and narrative of events that people saw a firearm. This is being covered up by the premises, they were aware we were looking at this incident, the CCTV handed to officers had already been burnt off before they got there and so officers had not verified the times or locations of the CCTV they had been given. When extra CCTV is requested we are then told that it had been reformatted and so the data had been lost, this had been done on the night after the incident and the reformatting authorised by a duty manager rather than the DPS or premise licence holder.

Tenesha Stewart as stated previously is a person known to West Midlands Police and the licensing authority, as it is on public record that she was involved in other premises where firearms had been produced/seen and or serious violence had taken place, involving members of organised crime gangs.

Jordan Patel is also a person I believe has influence, managerial control, influence on these premises and its operation, which contradicts the outcome of the last expedited summary review and the decision of the

licensing committee. His involvement is documented throughout this bundle.

It is also evident that the premises are being used by members of Organised Crime Gangs.

West Midlands Police believe that the only viable option is for the committee to revoke the premise licence and retain the interim steps of suspension pending any appeal against such a decision.

I am PS 2015 Martin Williams of the West Midlands Police based at Digbeth Police Station as a Neighbourhood Coordinator. Part of my role requires me to look at local intelligence and review its impact on our area and if necessary put policing plans in place to reduce any threat, risk or harm to our communities.

This statement is in relation to the viewing of an officers body worn video footage following a reported incident of a firearm being pointed at someone's head in Art House nightclub, 54-76 Bissell Street, Birmingham at approximately 0310 hours on Saturday 12th May 2018.

Following an initial call to the police on 999 making reference to the fact that 'there was a party and someone fired a gun and they are all fighting' a police incident log, number 296 of 12/5/2018, was created.

As this call was related to the possession of a firearm, officers from West Midlands Police Firearms department were despatched. One of the armed officers, PC 6135 Hughes, who initially attended this incident, recorded it on his body worn video camera. I have since viewed the footage off that camera via our secure video evidence system and can report the following.

PC Hughes arrived in Bissell Street which was full of people many of whom appeared to be in a state of panic. He spoke to a male at that location who later gave his name as Hal. He identified himself as security staff from Art House and gave a description of a male that had pointed a gun at another male within the nightclub. Hal can be heard saying "He had a gun" "He pulled the gun out" "He grabbed a guy around his

neck". Hal is then seen on the video to make a gun sign with his right hand to indicate it was pointed at the guy's neck. On more than one occasion Hal confirmed he was staff, he confirmed that he had seen a gun and confirmed that the incident took place within Art House. He can clearly be heard to say "inside the night club" when asked where it happened.

Hal stated that immediately after the offender pointed the gun he ran out of the nightclub and fled the scene. It was at this point that they got everyone out the club. He also confirmed that although he saw the gun, there was no discharge within the club.

I can see from incident log number 296 that 19 police resource attended this incident including 8 specialist firearms officers, 3 dog handlers and the Force Incident Manager and as such this was a large drain on police specialist resources at a very critical time in the early hours of Saturday morning.

I am Police Constable 5699 Hetherington of The West Midlands Police Force currently stationed at Bournville Lane Police Station on The Organised Crime Team.

On 12/05/2018 I was aware of a log that came into the Police in relation to someone firing a Gun at the Art House, Bissell Street, Highgate, Birmingham. Log 296 12/05/2018 Refers. The caller states that there have been gun shots and lots of people fighting and people running away from the club. It also mentions that a male by the name of [REDACTED] believed to be [REDACTED] was present at this location. [REDACTED] is known to the Police as being part of the B515 Gang in the Highgate area of Birmingham.

I was also aware that CCTV had been seized from the location and booked into Detained Property at Perry Barr Police Station DP No. 2182441/C.

On 22/05/2018 I viewed the CCTV from the Art House, to see if I could identify if [REDACTED] was present at the location on that evening. I viewed all the CCTV footage, at 02.55hrs on Camera 20 I identified [REDACTED] stood at the bar. He was with other males who I have been unable to identify. The CCTV footage that had been provided only covered the Dance floor and the area's around the dancefloor, the footage did not cover the Entrance/ Exit points.

I have had no further dealings with this incident.

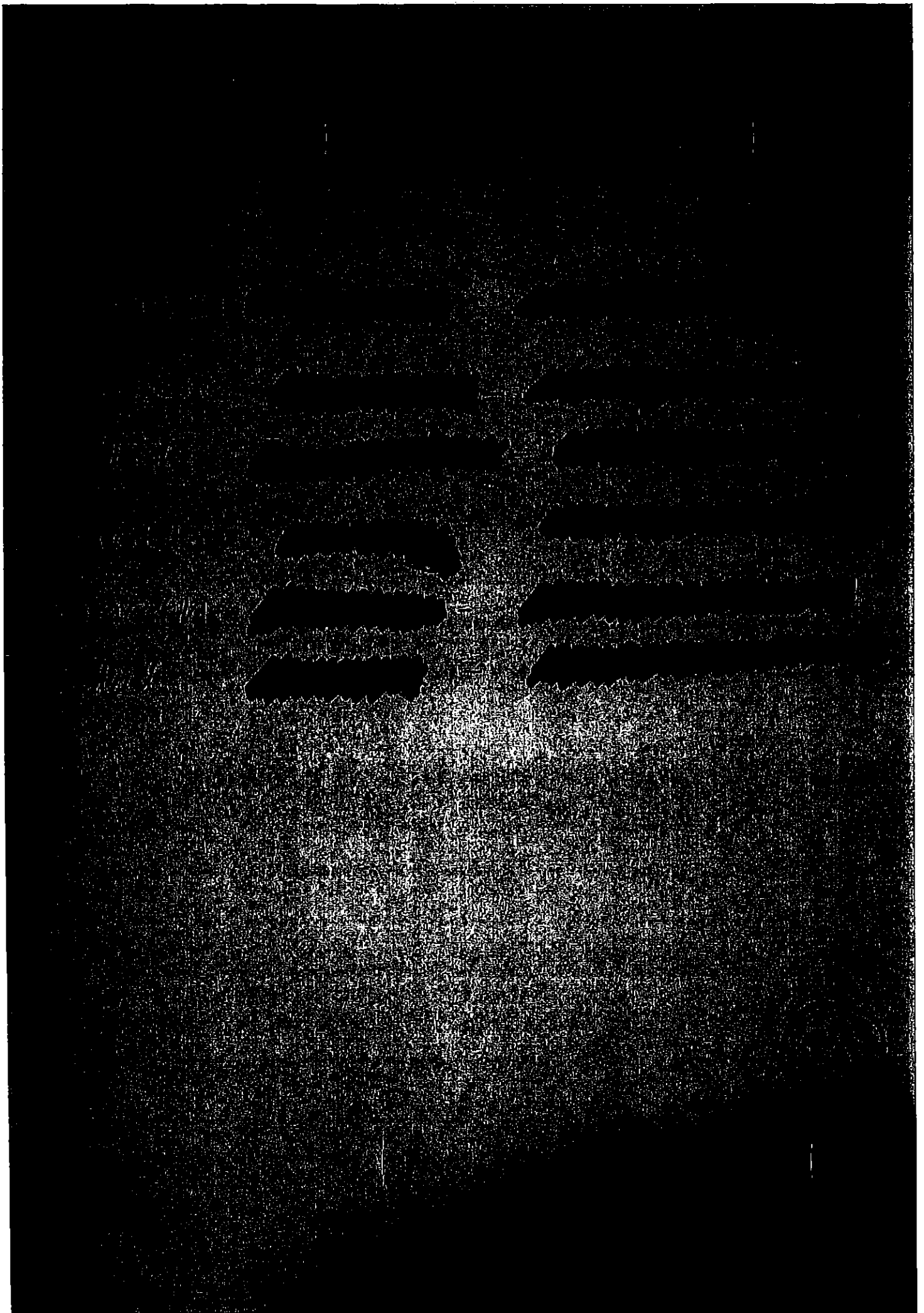

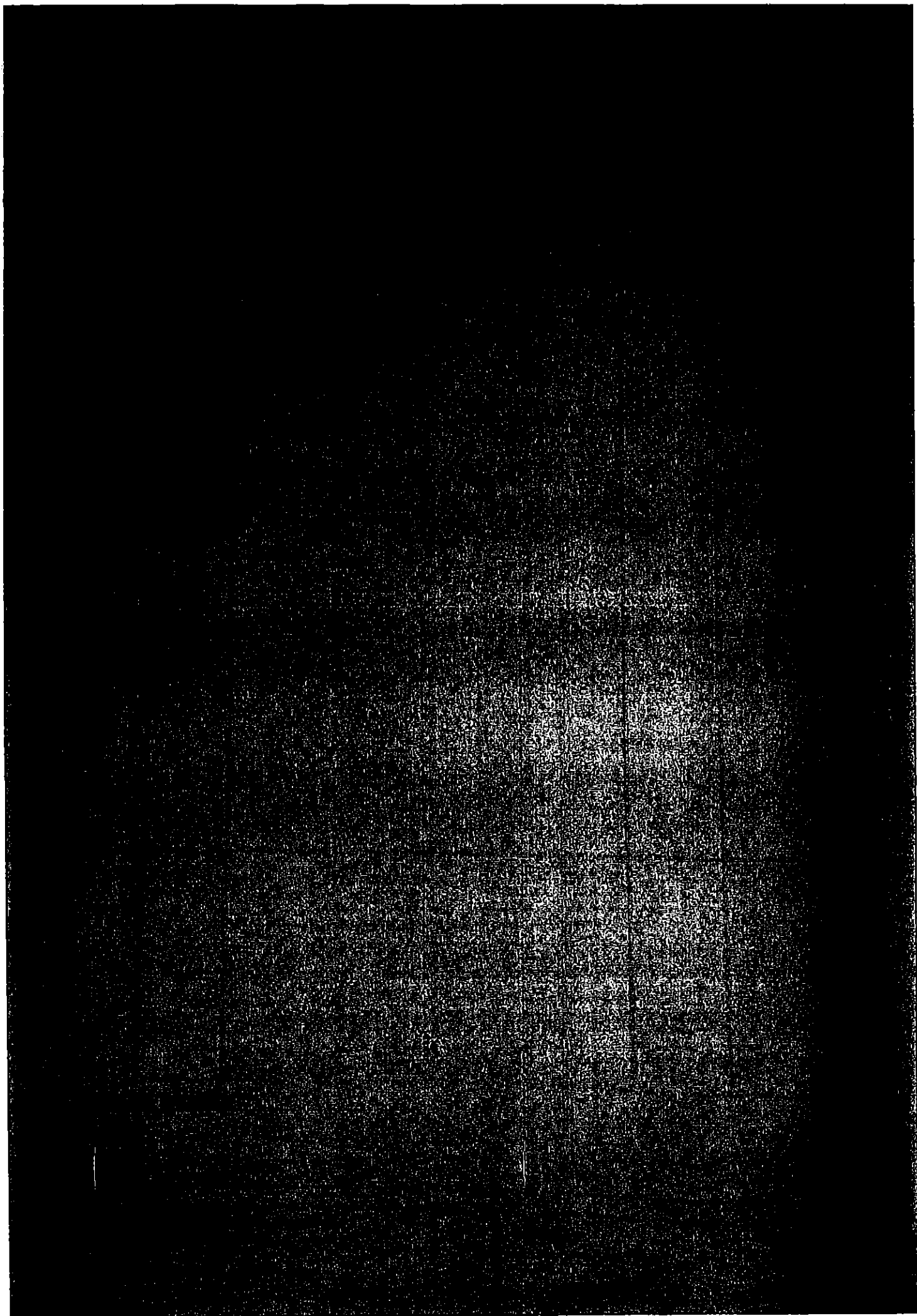

I am the above named person. I am giving this statement following a phone conversation I have had with Pc Abdool Rohomon from West Midlands Police licensing unit.

I am an event organiser, specialising in organising events normal live music events across the country, club events and after parties. I have been doing this since 2012 although my company has been running since 2017.

I was recommended a premises in Birmingham to hold an event called [REDACTED] the premises is called "Arthouse", I have never used it before but it was recommended to me so I thought I would use it to have my event. The event was happening on the 3rd March 2018, the event involved 5 artists that had been flown in from Zimbabwe, they had performed at a live music event the week before as this was to be the club element of the tour.

I was told to contact a Jordan Patel as he was the owner of the club, which I did. I would like say straight away that I was both told he was the owner and Jordan confirmed to me that he was the owner of the club. The two persons I communicated with at the premises were Jordan Patel and Tenesha Stewart.

I made enquiries to hire the venue with a VIP room, the initial payment was for £500 which is about normal for this type of hire. On the 23rd February 2018 I was asked to pay £1125 immediately for the security for the night. This I found very strange as this is not normal practice that I have experienced when organising at other venues, I was told by Jordan that if I didn't pay the money the event would be cancelled so I felt I had little choice, as I had 600 people coming to the event. The nature of the conversations and the instance on the money made me feel uneasy but as the event was fast approaching I went along with it.

Towards the end of February I was again contacted by Jordan Patel asking for £2500 for the VIP room. This really concerned me, as the initial hire package had included a VIP room, but I was told that the VIP room was being rented from the landlords and that they wanted payment so it had to be made. With the

event so close to happenng I again felt I had no choice and made the payment to an account that Jordan had given me, and I needed the VIP experience as part of the package.

As we got nearer the event there were the weathers warnings for snow being issued from the Met Office. I then got messages from Jordan stating that I could no longer have the VIP room, and that the money would then be returned by the end of the night. I asked for written confirmation of this, which Jordan sent in an email but said the money would be returned within 7 days.

After this email there started an exchange of numerous emails where Jordan started to change the day as to when I would get my refund and the reasons for it being delayed, they ranged from not having enough money to pay the refund, to credit card fraud to issues with World Pay.

I started to do my own due diligance into Arthouse and Jordan Patel, and found out that Jordan was no longer a director of the company as he had resigned.

I started to get phone calls from Jordan Patel and then Tenesha Stewart around the refund, it got to a point where I had to tell them both to stop calling as I was escalating the issues to my solicitor and a debt collection agency. To date, Arthouse have not responded to any communications or correspondence made by our solicitor.

It was when I was conducting my own checks at companies house that I discovered that Jordan Patel was no longer a director of the company and it was someone called Lucy. Although her name has been mentioned a couple of times, I have never spoken to her or met her or given the impression that she was the owner of the premises, this has always been Jordan Patel.

I am giving this statement in full knowledge that it is going to be used for licensing purposes by West Midlands Police as they have started a licensing review against Arthouse. I have also provided to Pc Rohomon numerous emails which shown the interaction with Jordan Patel and are happy for these to be disclosed.

This statement has been emailed to me, and I have had the opportunity to amend, add, alter any part of it prior to me signing it, the email trail will show this
