Proposal to Make a Prescribed Alteration to Two Community Schools Boldmere Infant and Nursery School and Boldmere Junior School

NOTICE is given in accordance with Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Birmingham City Council intend to make a prescribed alteration to two community schools, Boldmere Infant and Nursery School and Boldmere Junior School, Cofield Road, Sutton Coldfield, West Midlands B73 5SD, namely for the establishment of Special Educational Needs (SEN) provision to be provided in a resource base from 1st September 2018;

The Local Authority's Special Education Needs Assessment and Review (SENAR) Department supports the proposal to establish SEN provision in a resource base which;

- Makes provision for up to 24 Key Stage 1 and Key stage 2 pupils with a diagnosed Autistic Spectrum Condition (ASC) and who have a statement of special educational needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan, admitted on a phased basis as places are commissioned by SENAR.
- Is registered at both Boldmere Infant School and Nursery and Boldmere Junior School so that the schools can share the facilities.

Remodelling work is proposed on the existing accommodation at the schools for the provision of the resource base.
