## Children's Trust officers response -

They said that running a children's home is by no means easy , that they are hard to make a profit from with owners going into the process because they want to make a difference , they fall under the Ofsted inspection regime who have a wide range of powers, including a suspension on the spot; The actually process of opening a children's home can take upwards of 12 months and all potential homes will have completed a community impact assessment.
