

What action has the Council taken, and what further action does it plan to take, to prevent the spread of gardens and outbuildings beyond legal boundaries onto land on New Hall Country Park which has been raised several times with officers by residents and myself?

Answer:

Officers are very aware of a growing number of boundary issues where some residents adjacent to New Hall Valley Country Park have or are moving their garden fences. As each of those incidents potentially will result in the loss of public open space these incidents are treated as serious and are or will be investigated.

Each incident is addressed with the individual resident and where disputed is likely to require the further involvement of Legal Services Directorate to resolve.

I have asked that officers continue to investigate these specific incidents at New Hall Valley Country Park and to keep you advised.





Title: High Needs Funding Developments - 2020/21

Status: For Information

1. Background:

- 1.1 Birmingham's HNB allocation has been slightly above average for Metropolitan LAs nationally. Compared to LAs with similar levels of social disadvantage in 2018/19, it received more funding (per 2-18 resident population) than Liverpool, Sheffield and Sunderland but less than Manchester and Newcastle. However, like many LAs in England, it has experienced growing demands, mainly linked to increases in numbers of pupils with EHCPs, an increasing number of placements in specialist provision, and expectations of continuing specialist education from 19-25.
- 1.2 The Government has announced increases to Local Area HNB allocations for 2020/21. Birmingham is expected to receive an additional £26.6m. This will address previous and forecast overspends, as well as providing capacity for significant investment for the future. While increases are welcome, it is important that money is used strategically rather than reacting to existing pressures and demands. This paper sets out the following:
 - (i) Spending commitments already identified for 2020/21 that the new money will need to cover
 - (ii) Strategic principles that will be used to guide future investment, so that this is used proactively and to the best effect
 - (iii) Processes by which future investments will be decided, including arrangements for consultation with Schools Forum about spending proposals

2. Summary of Proposed Spending commitments to be set against the 2020/21 HNB increase

2.1 Appendix 1 sets out commitments required before new investment is considered. These are identified in rows 1 to 15 of the schedule and include repayment of the cumulative HNB deficit (spread across the next 3 years); the HN overspend predicted for the current financial year; funding to support further growth in spend (based on current trends), if required; increases in SEND administrative capacity (linked to

- significant workload increases arising from growth in numbers of EHCPs/statutory assessment requests); and increases in funding to support inclusion in Early Years settings (need already established).
- 2.2 Row 16 to 17 of Appendix 1 identifies funding of £10.4m which will be set aside, subject to further consideration, for developing rovision locally and meet any further increase in special school banded top up, resources base CRISP and Maintained Crisp rates.

3. Principles to guide future investment

A proactive/strategic approach

3.1 Increases in spending on High Needs over recent years have been reactive to a number of demands and pressures. A more proactive approach is needed. The Authority's developing strategy for SEND is focused on strengthening Birmingham's local offer, with reduced reliance on out of City placements (which tend to be higher cost). There is a desire for more children to be educated in their own local area, so that they don't have to travel long distances to have their needs met, and for a stronger/ more consistent universal/mainstream offer so that more pupils can be educated alongside their local peers.

Developing provision and services locally

3.2 Funding should be used to support these directions, through strengthening local capacity across both mainstream and specialist sectors. Birmingham is proposing to organise its HN funding and resources around four geographical Areas which align closely with existing secondary school networks and primary consortia. Opportunities will be taken to strengthen links between specialist provision and local area schools, so that these sectors can work more closely together.

Supporting collective responsibility

3.3 Traditionally, decisions about HN resourcing have tended to be taken centrally, at a distance from schools, families and children. Inevitably, there has been a heavy reliance on administration and paperwork, with some frustration that decisions are not timely or based on a full appreciation of children's individual needs. In moving to a more local model, The Authority wants to build on and strengthen school partnership working and provide a greater level of financial flexibility locally so that needs can be met in a more dynamic way.

Funding better matched to levels of need

3.4 The City has an established system of funding (CRISP) that aims to match funding to levels of individual need. However, as with other pupil-led funding approaches, there are risks that funding can become demand-led. The Authority wants to ensure that funding is used equitably and will seek to review existing and future spend to ensure that it is proportional and targeted at the greatest need.

Maximum impact and value for money

3.5 A very significant amount of money is spent on children with HN in Birmingham and it is important that this resource (and any additional money) is used as effectively as possible to provide the greatest opportunities for *all* our pupils. Funding will be targeted at developments that are likely to have the greatest impact on their progress and long-term outcomes

Developments that are financially sustainable and scaleable

3.6 Birmingham is keen to support and evaluate new approaches to supporting children with HN and is likely to do this initially on a pilot/project/action research basis. It is important that developments are funded at a level that can be sustained over time and generalised to other parts of the City if they are found to be successful. This implies a staged approach to investment rather than putting out all new money 'in one go'.

4. Priorities

- **4.1** Five investment priorities have been identified, as follows:
 - (i) Early Years
 - (ii) Post 16
 - (iii) Mainstream/cluster developments
 - (iv) Specialist provision
 - (v) SEN administration
- 4.2 A need has already been established to enhance the current budget for HN support in early years settings. This report proposes an increase in the Early Years Inclusion Fund (ISEY funding) to meet growth in needs Appendix 1 row 11).
- 4.3 Further investment is needed to enhance local pathways to adulthood, particularly for young people with complex and significant needs. This will be linked to a clearer and more ambitious 16-25 SEND strategy, aimed at achieving better outcomes (vs 'staying on') and differentiated to take account of varying levels of need. Birmingham is reviewing its current provision to ensure a stronger local offer to manage the increasing demand for extended placements in the independent/non-maintained school/college sector.
- 4.4 There are a range of possibilities which would help strengthen provision in the mainstream sector. The emphasis will be on cluster working, with greater opportunities for funding to be managed at this level. It is proposed that a school/officer working group is established to help develop a menu of options for local consideration.
- 4.5 There are a number of reasons to consider further investment in the specialist provision sector: firstly, although national arrangements are being made to address the impact of increased teacher costs, these are having to be paid for within existing budgets for non-teaching staff (which is a bigger issue for specialist providers).

Secondly, the Authority is keen to strengthen local capacity and reduce reliance on INM placements. This is likely to require a level of additional investment for some schools. Thirdly, special school Heads have argued that Birmingham provision is relatively underfunded compared to equivalent schools in other authorities. This is currently being evaluated through an independent benchmarking study.

4.6 Finally, although the Authority wants to prioritise investment in direct services to children and young people, recent growth in numbers of statutory assessments and EHCPs need to be matched by an increase in administrative capacity to address the backlog and improve the quality of the current services. Additional investment in this area is identified in Section 2 of this report.

5. Processes by which future investments will be decided

This section of the report outlines the process to be followed for the use of the £10.4m development funding.

Central vs local area decisions

5.1 Some decisions will need to be made at City-wide level, for example with regard to some of the commitments already identified in section 2 of this report. This will ensure that core strategic outcomes can be addressed and there is consistency in key areas of spending. However, other decisions will be devolved to local areas, to encourage local school participation and ownership. It is recommended that the City should set up a strategic 'Developing SEND Provision Locally' fund, with each of the four areas receiving an indicative share. New proposals can then be generated and considered at area level with a central overview to encourage the development of a range of initiatives across the City as a whole.

Informed commissioning

5.2 Each Area will be provided with a key dataset on current spend/usage of provision for children living in their locality, to help shape their agenda. This will include a reference to their 'expected share' of Birmingham's overall HNB allocation, as there will need to be a move towards greater equity in spend across the City over time. It is expected that mainstream Heads will play an increasing role in helping to shape the nature of local provision and services within the enhanced budget that is available.

Management of funding

5.3 Developments take time to establish and evaluate and funding needs to be retained to support roll-out of successful initiatives. It is therefore proposed that a proportion of the 'Developing Provision Locally' budget is held within DSG reserves (while clearly earmarked for this purpose). This will allow carry over to support developments that extend across financial years and help avoid using up all the resource immediately (with no capacity for generalisation when this is needed).


It is expected that there will be some opportunities for further investment in local developments as money becomes available from reductions in numbers of

placements in INM special schools. It is proposed that savings will be used to further enhance local capacity, either centrally or at local Area level.

6. Recommendations

6.1 The recommendations for Schools Forum arising from this report are:

- That School Forum support the proposed allocation of additional High Needs funding set out in this report.
- 2. That regular reports on progress will be brought to Schools Forum for information, with consultation on any City-wide decisions and on parameters for Area-based funding and initiatives. Schools Forum will also be consulted about any decisions to roll out Area-based initiatives City-wide.
- 3. A formal report will be brought to Schools Forum on an annual basis, summarising use of additional funding and implications for the new financial year.

Question:

Please provide the number of outstanding EHCP Annual Reviews and the detailed plan to resolve this including timescales.

Answer:

There are currently 6,511 EHCP Annual Reviews outstanding.

An action plan is in place to ensure that the backlog of outstanding reviews is cleared by the end of May 2020 and that all new reviews are carried out within timescales from 20 April 2020.

We are recruiting a team manager, a team of case workers and seconding an experienced Principal Officer to deliver this activity over the next three months. Five full time case workers have been appointed to date, and we will be finalising terms with an agency this week for a further 20 remote case workers to start over the next two weeks (using Egress to securely manage document transfer). A team manager was interviewed last week and will be available to start towards the end of this week, pending agreement on terms.

"Single Contractor Negotiations"

Question:

Please list all contracts that have been entered into under Single Contractor Negotiations since 2015, including for each: the title of the contract, the length of the contract; the value of the contract; the specific exemption from procurement regulations relied upon; the date negotiations commenced with the contractor; the date both the CFO and the City Solicitor provided written authorisation for those negotiations to commence; and the date the contract was signed.

Answer:

Prior to the new Constitution coming into effect in September 2019, the authorisation for approving the commencement of Single Contractor Negotiations was one of the following: Director of Commissioning & Procurement, or Strategic Director of Finance and Legal Services, or City Solicitor as stated in the Operation of the Council's Procurement Governance Arrangements.

These SCNs are shown in the Excel spreadsheet extract below. However, rather than provide the specific exemption which is either 'Unforeseen Priority' or 'Only one provider can do it', the reason for the exemption has been provided as this is perhaps more meaningful. Additionally, it has not been possible to provide contract length information for all SCNs in the time available.

Since the amendment to the Constitution in September 2019, which required SCNs to be approved by both the City Finance Officer and the City Solicitor, two SCNs have been approved and these are shown in the table below:



"Clean Air Zone Mitigations Application and Case Management System"

Question:

Before, during and after the 'soft market testing' carried out for the above procurement, which according to the Cabinet report involved talking to two existing suppliers before opting for Single Contractor Negotiations, what steps did the Council take to ensure compliance with Public Contracts Regulations 40 and 41 to ensure that the soft market testing did 'not distort competition' and was 'transparent and non-discriminatory'?

Answer:

Background

During early December 2019, Corporate Procurement Services (CPS) were made aware by the CAZ Programme, of the urgent need for a business solution to process mitigation applications in the short timescales required (delivery by April 2020). A project group was convened with members of CPS, IT and the CAZ programme to discuss procurement options. During this time Procurement were made aware that the full implementation of the CAZ needed to be in place by 1st July 2020; a deadline which was immovable and impacted on the delivery of other projects within the programme.

Due to time constraints limiting the procurement process: 4 months to deliver a business solution for mitigation applications, it was agreed by the group that it was appropriate for IT to undertake soft market engagement with two existing providers of IT services to the Council. Both providers were considered to be well established IT suppliers and leaders in the development of business solutions such as the type required by the CAZ Programme. The aim of the soft market engagement exercise was to discuss the draft service requirements including the feasibility of what the business solution was trying to achieve and the market's capacity to deliver the requirements by the April 2020 deadline. This determination was made in-line with Regulations 40 and 41 of The Public Contracts Regulations 2015 which permits market consultation and obtaining advice from market participants.

Soft Market Testing

The two providers: were selected on the basis that Council officers considered them to have the required technical ability and knowledge to deliver the business solution in the timescales available including:

 Company A confirmed that they were unable to explore options for delivering the solution in the timescales available due to their capacity working on prior commitments. Company A was the most likely supplier to raise a challenge given their existing position in the marketplace. The remaining Company already provides IT services to the Council in respect of an IT platform that the mitigation application solution would need to interface with. This Company indicated that they would be willing to explore options but would not commit to fully agreeing the service requirements and delivering the business solution until a meeting had taken place with the Council to give formal approval to proceed with negotiations.

Conclusion

It should be noted that the emphasis of the soft market engagement exercise did not focus on the merits of individual suppliers, it included no element of supplier selection or bid evaluation and involved no commitment on the side of the Council; therefore, it was in keeping with the requirements of "not distorting competition", transparency and non-discriminatory pursuant to Regulations 40 and 41. CPS submits that the Council attempted to gain a balanced view of the market rather than consider individual merit/ responses in accordance with Regulation 41.

Following the soft market engagement, it was acknowledged that a wider consultation could have been undertaken; however, given the short timescales for implementation of the mitigation applications solution by April 2020, the project group decided not to engage further than the two suppliers, and the following determinations were made:

- a full procurement exercise would not deliver the required solution in the 4 months available to procure the technology; and
- the reputational risk to the Council of not having the business solution in place by April 2020, prior to the overall implementation of the CAZ in summer 2020, carries a significant reputational risk for the Council and undermines stakeholder and public confidence in the ability of the Council to discharge the grant funding which has been awarded by government. This would also adversely impact on the Council's achievement of national air quality targets in the shortest possible time.

The risk of challenge around Regulation 40 (3) and the 'effect of distorting competition' was assessed by CPS, and it was considered to be low when compared to the risk of not having a business solution in place and the impact of reputational damage this may have on the Council not processing applications in April 2020. Namely, the CAZ programme's inability to process mitigation applications from citizens who would be eligible including taxi drivers, CAZ workers and local business. The inability to meet air quality performance targets could have potential for grant funding to be reclaimed by the government. Therefore, the best option that would deliver the business solution by the April 2020 deadline, was to follow single contractor negotiations with the remaining Company.

'Public Access of the Register of HMO's Declared'

Question:

At the last Council meeting the Cabinet Member indicated that the register of the HMO's declared before the Article 4 Direction comes into force in June "will be for internal use only." Why cannot the public see it and know which properties are being used as HMO's as they will following the introduction of the Article 4?

Answer:

In preparation for the implementation of Article 4, we are asking landlords of HMOs to provide documentary evidence of the current use of the property. The database of declared HMOs contains potentially sensitive commercial or personal information, which means we must adhere to the data protection regulations. The database is also a working document which Planning officers are using to establish with a degree of certainty whether a property is in use as an established HMO. Furthermore, the Declarations database does not provide a definitive record of HMOs across the city, as most of these HMOs have already been identified in advance of the Article 4 Direction coming into force, via previous planning approvals, HMO licensing published register and council tax records.

Given the level of personal data that will be recorded on the Declaration database, it will not be made available to the public. We are currently reviewing our processes to

- ensure consistency of data sharing in relation to HMO, between the various council departments
- The HMO published register is kept updated.

Bottom Ash is collected separately within the process of incineration.

Fly Ash is captured as a separate process and therefore the recycling performance figure does not include the weight of any fly ash.

The 'Collected Residual Waste' tonnages include all residual collections, not just wheelies bins and sacks. The 'Kerbside Co-mingled' tonnages are the amounts actually collected and includes the element of waste that is rejected at the Materials Recycling Centre.


Question:

Would a yearly Bulky Waste Collection make more financial sense?

Answer:

The issue of re-introducing a free bulky waste service has been looked into. When free bulky waste collections were provided, the level of fly tipping in the city was very similar to what it is now. There would be a significant cost to bringing back a free waste collection and in the face of continuing pressure on local authority funding, it is not affordable.

Fly tipping is a criminal activity and the city council will prosecute when it has sufficient evidence. We propose to increase enforcement in the coming year to tackle those criminals who abandon waste on our city's streets and thank those citizens who help us secure evidence that has led to a number of successful prosecutions.

Question:
