# Key Points

- New Delta variant is now the dominant strain and spreading quite fast across the city.
- NHS data suggests steady increase in hospital and ITU admissions but also a significantly increased burden in primary care.
- Vaccine uptake continues and national target is 70% of all adults vaccinated by next step of the road map. Currently 26/69 wards have achieved 70% or more with the 1<sup>st</sup> vaccine and 2/69 have achieved 70% or more with the second vaccine.




# Vaccine roll out

- Vaccine roll–out extended on June 18.
- Everyone over the age of 18 in England can now book their Covid-19 vaccine.
- This comes as part of the government's drive to give every adult in England a first dose of the vaccine by July 19.
- The new target brought forward from July 31 will coincide with the easing of the final stage of lockdown.






















Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+


