### 1. Purpose of report:

To consider the objection notices to the Temporary Event Notice (TEN), which seeks to permit the sale of alcohol (for consumption on the premises), the provision of regulated entertainment and the provision of late night refreshment, to operate from 07:00pm until 02:00am on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023 - 1 July 2023

### 2. Recommendation:

To consider the objection notices that have been made and to determine the TEN, having regard to:

- The submissions made by all parties
- The Statement of Licensing Policy
- The Public Sector Equality Duty
- The s182 Guidance

# 3. Brief Summary of Report:

A Temporary Event Notice was submitted by Kerryn Seale and received on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in respect of CJ More, 145 Hockley Hill, Newtown, Birmingham, B18 5AN.

Objection notices have been received from West Midlands Police and Environmental Health.

### 4. Compliance Issues:

When carrying out its licensing functions, a licensing authority must have regard to the guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.

# 4.1 Consistency with relevant Council Policies, Plans or Strategies:

The report complies with the City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Council's Corporate Plan to improve the standard of all licensed persons, premises and vehicles in the City.

# 5. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

A Temporary Event Notice was submitted on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023 by Kerryn Seale, in respect of CJ More, 145 Hockley Hill, Newtown, Birmingham, B18 5AN, which was served on the responsible authorities on the 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

The Temporary Event Notice is attached at Appendix 1.

Objection notices have been received from West Midlands Police, including supporting documents, and Environmental Health, which are attached at Appendices 2 and 3 respectively.

Site location plans are attached at Appendix 4.

Under the licensing system of TENs, no actual permission is required to carry out a licensable activity on a temporary basis. An applicant must merely give notice of his intentions to operate a licensable activity to the licensing authority.

However, the police or local authority exercising environmental health functions may intervene to prevent such an event taking place or agree a modification of the proposed arrangements, and their intervention may in some cases result in the licensing authority imposing conditions on a TEN.

Where a TEN is submitted, the licensing authority must consider the objection(s) at a hearing before a counter notice, or a notice including a statement of conditions can be issued.

Conditions may only be applied if the TEN is in connection with licensable activities at licensed premises. It must be noted a Premises Licence is not currently in force for CJ More, 145 Hockley Hill, Newtown, Birmingham, B18 5AN.

When giving a TEN, consideration should be given to the following four licensing objectives:

- 1. The prevention of crime and disorder
- 2. Public safety
- 3. The prevention of public nuisance; and
- 4. The protection of children from harm



I am responding to this application for a TEN on behalf of Environmental Health as a responsible authority and I formally object to this application on the basis that this will not support the promotion of the licensing objective relating to the prevention of public nuisance.

The application from Kerynn Seale is seeking a TEN for the provision of Regulated entertainment, Late Night refreshment and Sale of alcohol on the premises at C J More, 145 Hockley Hill Birmingham between the hours of 07.00 on 30 June 2023 until 02.00 on 1 July 2023 at a premises described as a function venue for a birthday party for 150 people.

The site is located in a mixed-use area however there is nearby residential use within 150 metres. The premises appear to be a single storey building associated with church use and lacks effective noise mitigation design. The application lacks any significant information about the form of entertainment and the reason for the extended hours and provides no mitigation or management measures to reduce noise impact.

Based on the information provided I am concerned that there will be a significant noise impact from building breakout, potential for patrons using external areas and noise from patrons exiting and entering the premises and therefore object to this TEN.
