Vaccine roll out

- All 16 and 17-year-olds in England are being offered their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and can find their nearest centre through the 'grab a jab' NHS online walk-in finder: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/find-a-walk-in-coronavirus-covid-19-vaccination-site/
- Vaccine is being offered to children aged 12 to 15 with severe neurological disorders, Down's syndrome, immunosuppression, multiple
 or severe learning disabilities and young people aged 12 to 17 who live with an immunosuppressed person. It has also been extended
 to the 12-15 year old with other at-risk conditions: haematological malignancy, sickle cell disease, type 1 diabetes, congenital heart
 disease, chronic respiratory disease, chronic conditions of kidney/liver/digestive system, chronic neurological disease, endocrine
 disorders, immunosuppression, splenic dysfunction, some serious genetic abnormalities.
- The first dose of the Pfizer vaccine is now also being rolled out to other 12–15-year-olds, (other those with at-risk-conditions). Parents will get a letter with information when the vaccine will be offered.
- COVID-19 vaccine boosters is now being offered across the country to the over-50s, younger adults with health conditions, care home residents, frontline health and care workers, adult household contacts of immunosuppressed individuals, 16-49 year olds with underlying conditions that put them at higher risk of severe COVID-19 and adult carers.
- Figures from the <u>GOV.UK</u> website indicate that 85.2% of England people aged 12* years and over have had their 1st vaccine dose, and 78.3% their 2nd dose. This compares to 62.5% and 55.3% in Birmingham. The vaccination roll-out in the 12-15 age group would likely impact the overall uptake figures, compared to uptake at age 16+.
- Data on the booster and 12-15 year olds vaccine uptake at local authority level will be incorporated into future releases as soon as they are made available nationally.

















Demographics of uptake: Relationship between Deprivation, BME Population & first dose uptake (extracted 12/10/2021)





