Glossary of Health Definitions

Infant Mortality

Number of deaths of infants aged less than one year excluding stillbirths.

Neonatal mortality

Number of deaths of infants at ages under 28 days. Neonatal mortality can be divided into early neonatal mortality and late neonatal mortality (see below).

Perinatal mortality

Perinatal mortality includes stillbirths (after 24 weeks gestation) and deaths of early neonates (aged less than seven complete days).

Health monitor more than only infant deaths:

Late fetal loss

Baby delivered between 22 weeks +0 days and 23 weeks +6 days gestational age showing no signs of life.

Stillbirth

A baby delivered at or after 24 weeks of gestational age showing no signs of life, irrespective of when the death occurred.

Early Neonatal Death

Deaths up to six days after live birth.

Late Neonatal Death

Deaths from seven days but under 28 days after live birth.

Infant Death

Baby dying between 28 days - 1 year.
