How does the Council use PRS for temporary accommodation? What are the planning and licensing regulations? What can we learn from people's experiences and best practice in other parts of the country?
3. What timescale do we propose to do this in?:	The work will be undertaken by the Committee in evidence gathering sessions from September to January and a discussion report will be presented to City Council in April 2019
