- Alteration of the lower age limit of the school from 11 years to 9 years so as to offer primary (Key Stage 2 provision Year 5 to Year 11) with effect from 1st January 2018. The current age range is 11 -16 years. The proposed age range is 9 16 years.
- A phased increase in the number of pupils from 113 to 138 with effect from 1st January 2018.

Lindsworth School is a community special school at Monyhall Hall Road, Kings Norton, Birmingham B30 3QA. The School caters for children who have a statement of special educational need or an Education, Health and Care Plan for Social, Emotional and Mental Health needs (SEMH).
