



Offering enhanced and physical and digital services has been shown to increase the take up of the service from ethnic minority communities. The full year report of Quit with Bella (July 2020- June 2021) showed that of the 19,865 individuals that downloaded the App approximately 45% were BAME. Of those that went onto set a quit date 31% were BAME.
