1. Purpose of report:

Premises to remain open to the public from 08:30am until 11:30pm (Monday to Sunday).

An application for a Premises Licence was received on 5th November 2018, in respect of Chase Farm Shop & Café, Weeford Road, Roughley, Sutton Coldfield, B75 5RL.


