- The Poolway Shopping Centre is now all demolished
- Kier Living Ltd are continuing to build the 136 new homes at the Meadway, 50% for sale and 50% for Council Rent



- 17 Council homes have been completed and tenants have moved in. A further 51 are at different stages of the build programme. The aim is to complete all properties by the end of May 2020.
- The properties that have been built to sell on the open market are popular and have sold quickly. Kier have completed 56 and the remaining will be completed before the end of May 2020.
- The new park is currently being installed and is due for completion at the end of December 2019. The park
 will be a substantial improvement with new planting, trees, seating, play equipment for different age
 ranges, multi-use games area and gym
 equipment
