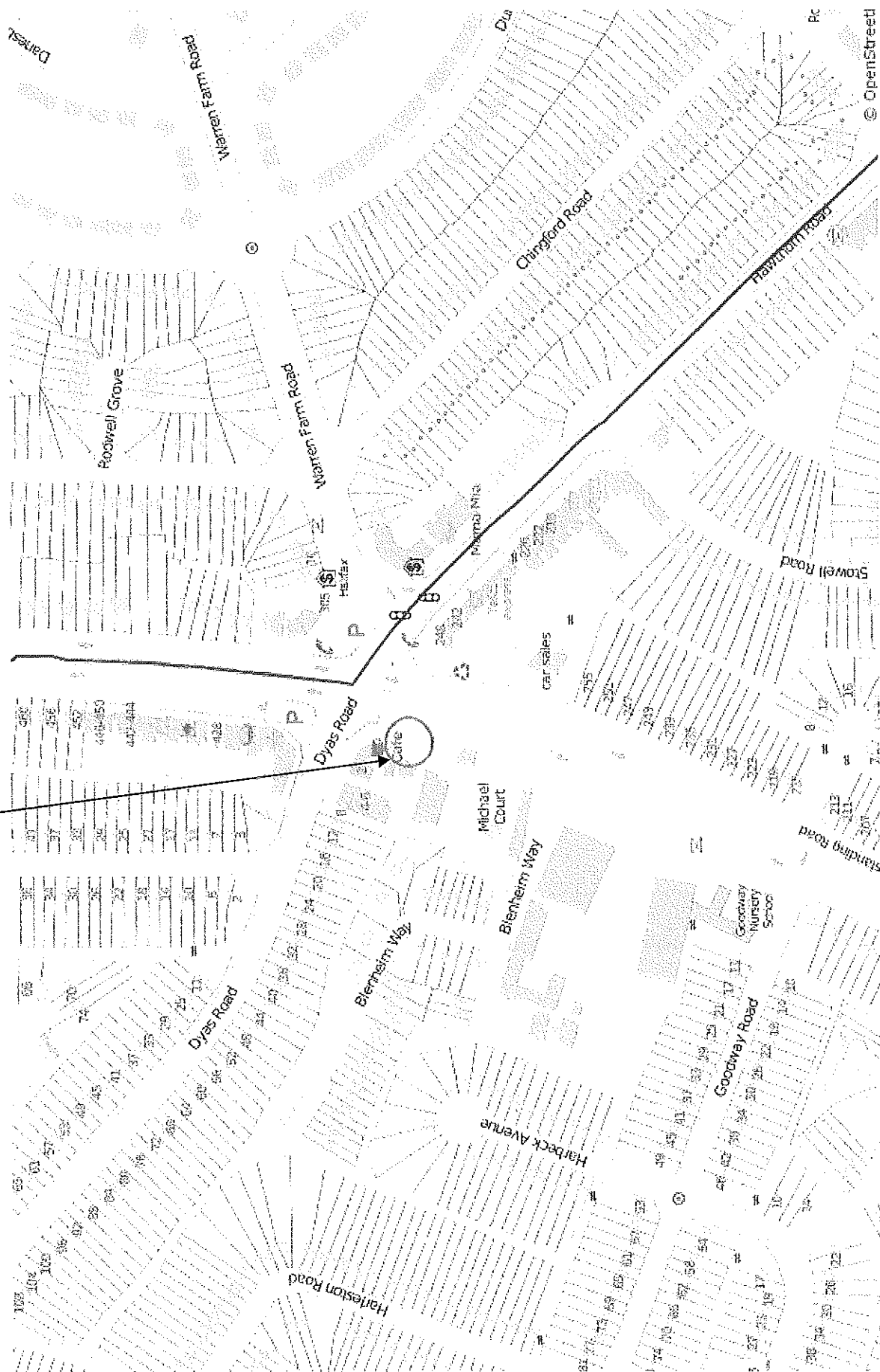

My name is Adam Mroczkowski and I am a Police Licensing Officer based at Birmingham Central Police Station. This is a statement detailing my involvement with Stanleys Snooker Club, 400 Kingstanding Road, Kingstanding, Birmingham.

On Monday 10th October 2016 I received an email from PC 9303 Southall detailing a job he was sent to at Stanleys Snooker Club in Kingstanding (Police log 83 09/10/2016 refers). Police log 83 09/10/2016 was a 999 call made by a local resident after hearing a female screaming outside the location and the caller believed this was linked to a party at Stanleys Snooker Club.

In PC 9303 Southall's email he describes various issues at the premises which included nitrous oxide canisters and empty balloons the floor, possible underage drinking, evidence of smoking inside the premises and the premises having a DJ even though their licence does not allow regulated entertainment. I have exhibited this email at AM/1.

I was also aware of bodycam footage from Log 83 09/10/2016 which was filmed by PC 9303 Southall.

I immediately called the premises and arranged a meeting at Birmingham Central Police Station on the 13th October 2016. This meeting was attended by *Michelle G...* who identified herself as Vice Chairman and Secretary of the club, and *...* who identified himself as a bar person.

In the meeting a went through all the issues that had been brought to my attention and I explained consequences and enforcement action I could take.

I was told that the club does has a committee and that a male called *...* was the chairman but he was unable to attend the meeting. *...* said the club was struggling and wanted to hold similar events to increase the money coming into the club. I explained that future events involving regulated entertainment would need to be licensed via a temporary event notice as their current club licence was insufficient to hold these events. I also said that I would like to see a risk assessment for these events to ensure they have addressed the issues on the 09th October 2016. After the meeting I offered my assistance and gave them my contact details so they could go through any future events with me prior to any TEN's being applied for.

This was the last and only contact I had with the premises.

Hi,

Can I bring to your attention OASIS log reference 83 of 09.10.2016 which refers to Stanley Snooker Hall, 400 Kingstanding Road. Myself and PC 7556 Burgess attended due to a noise complaint from neighbours (female screaming) and on arrival it was identified that the snooker hall was having a 'house' event in the rear bar area.

We spoke with a male who identified himself as bar supervisor (██████████) and a female who said she was the club secretary (██████████) - contact details as per the log. Concerns were raised at this time as there were no door staff on at the venue and numbers were estimated around 60-70. ██████████ stated that as they were a private members club there was no requirement in their license with the council to provide any doorstaff at the venue. They stated that the night was ending at 02:00hrs and they would do what they could to limit the noise. At this time there was no requirement to go inside the premises as both ██████████ were spoken to outside and appeared to be 'on-board' and happy to work with us and assured that they would make contact with licensing as they wanted the event to become a regular night.

Officers returned at 02:40hrs to ensure that everyone had left the location, however, the event was still ongoing and there was no sign of it ending. We spoke again with ██████████ who stated that they would end the event there and then, which they did and with all fairness the people inside left without fuss or remonstration.

However, when we went into the club it was evident that they were allowing smoking to take place inside the club, the consumption of gas canisters (which were scattered on the floor) and gasballons were all over the place. It was also clear that there were underage people drinking in the club and even ██████████ admitted that one person in particular (who was pointed out on the first attendance) and was inside the venue was only 17yrs old and he knew him.

It is evident from speaking with the staff that they are planning on holding future events similar as stated that this was hoping to be a monthly event.

We spoke with a few people outside who stated that they had paid to get into the event and paid money to ██████████ but he denied that he had been taken money on the door for entry, although the DJ stated that he was paid £250 for 2 hrs work so that had to be found from somewhere!

Both myself and PC 7556 Burgess did obtain bodyworn video evidence from inside the venue once the lights were on and people had left which shows the metal canisters and balloons over the floor etc. This has been saved for 6yrs as evidential if required.

We did request that the OASIS log be deferred for your attention but sent this message just in case it hasn't been as from a response point of view if there is a 'house' event emerging in Kingstanding it will attract a large following and therefore potential for disorder (especially with no door staff - poor lighting conditions outside - no checks made on door).





I am Police Sergeant 9727 Andrew Edward Holder of the West Midlands Police stationed at Handsworth Police station. I have been a Police Officer for over twenty one years and during my time I have dealt with numerous persons for smoking cannabis and I am fully aware of the smell of cannabis being smoked. On Friday 30th December 2016 at 20:41 Hours I attended a premises called Stanley Snooker club, 400 Kingstanding Road, Birmingham, West Midlands. I was aware the premises are licensed for the sale and consumption of alcohol between the hours of 1200 Hours and 0130 Hours seven days a week. I was also aware of incident on the 26th December 2016 where it was reported there had been a disorder and persons under eighteen years of age consuming alcohol on the premises so I attended to carry out a check of the premises to ensure the club was complying with its licensed activities. Upon arrival at the club I made my way inside with other officers and as I walked through the main entrance I smelt the stale smell of smoked cannabis. Upon entering the premises I saw there were six adults playing poker and a male, I now know to be [REDACTED] stood by the bar who identified himself as running the bar tonight. I requested to see the membership book but [REDACTED] stated he did not know where the membership book was and that they have too many members to maintain the register. I asked the six people who were playing poker if they were members and they stated they were but could not produce membership cards. I explained to [REDACTED] that how can we ensure that the membership is being complied with unless the register is on the premises. He stated he would take it up with the committee. I was then invited behind the bar where I saw a piece of paper with "Committee" typed on and the following persons listed Chair Women [REDACTED] Vice Chairman: [REDACTED] Secretary: [REDACTED] Treasurer: [REDACTED] and Sub Committee leader: [REDACTED] I took a photograph of the committee list, which I produce as Exhibit (Police Reference AEH/1), there were no committee members names on the Licence. As I left the premises I saw a self sealing plastic bag, which I associate with drugs which I photographed in situ and produce in Evidence AEH/2). I had no further dealings.

A [REDACTED] claimed to be responsible for the bar and stated he still hadn't been able to locate the membership book. He was told he needs to locate the book. He admitted that the club was struggling and they weren't opening often during the week. They have advertised on Facebook to no avail.

Club was also visited on 12/01/17 at 2100 hours when it was closed.

The task can be found on the Oscott map on the Corvus LP profile.

It would be useful if you could call me regarding this at your convenience to discuss as licensing is a new field of Policing for me.

Are you aware of this log and if so has any intervention work taken place or planned for after the Christmas period?

I have watched the bodycam footage from the response officers and have serious concerns regarding this premises. It takes 7 minutes for anyone to open the doors to the premises even after numerous bangs on the doors with officers shouting "Police". The premises is still open at 6am with their Club Licence only allowing them to operate till 2am. One male drinking alcohol states he is 17yrs old and a large amount of the customers are extremely anti-police.

The female on the footage who presents herself as running the premises is either drunk or on something as she is very agitated.

I have had dealings with this premises in the past and had them in for a meeting on the 9th October 2016 to discuss very similar issues re log 83 09/10/2016.

Abs, Ben, Vicki FYI incase of review proceedings being the option of attack!

Log 412 of 26/12/16 refers to a report of a stabbing at Stanleys Snooker Club, 400 Kingstanding Rd.

On arrival there were males leaving the location very quickly although no IP was found for the stabbing.

Officers were outside for some 15 minutes before the door was opened by the licence holder a [REDACTED]
[REDACTED]

Officers attended the club and people were inside still drinking and alcohol was still being served. I spoke to the licensee who told me that he had been in trouble before about opening the premises too late.

There was one male which I spoke to who stated that he was 17 years old and he had a pint of lager in his hand which was taken off him.

The incident was captured on bodycam and has been saved.

The licensee did manage to eventually remove all of the people inside however when they were leaving there was potential for trouble and all were very loud.

Just for you info and I will submit an IMS.
