

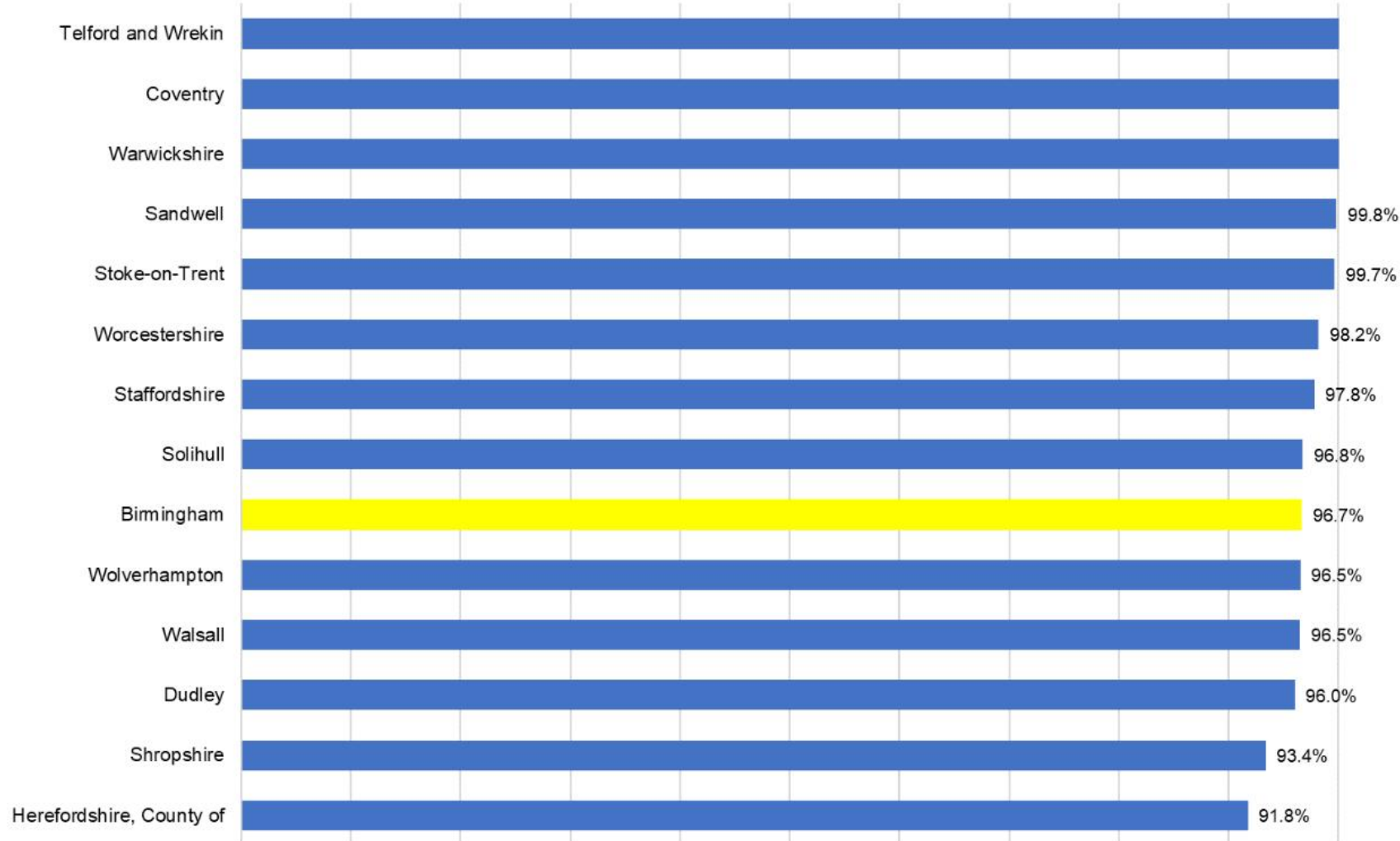

% 1st Dose Uptake in Population Aged 50+ by West Midlands LA as of 30/05/21



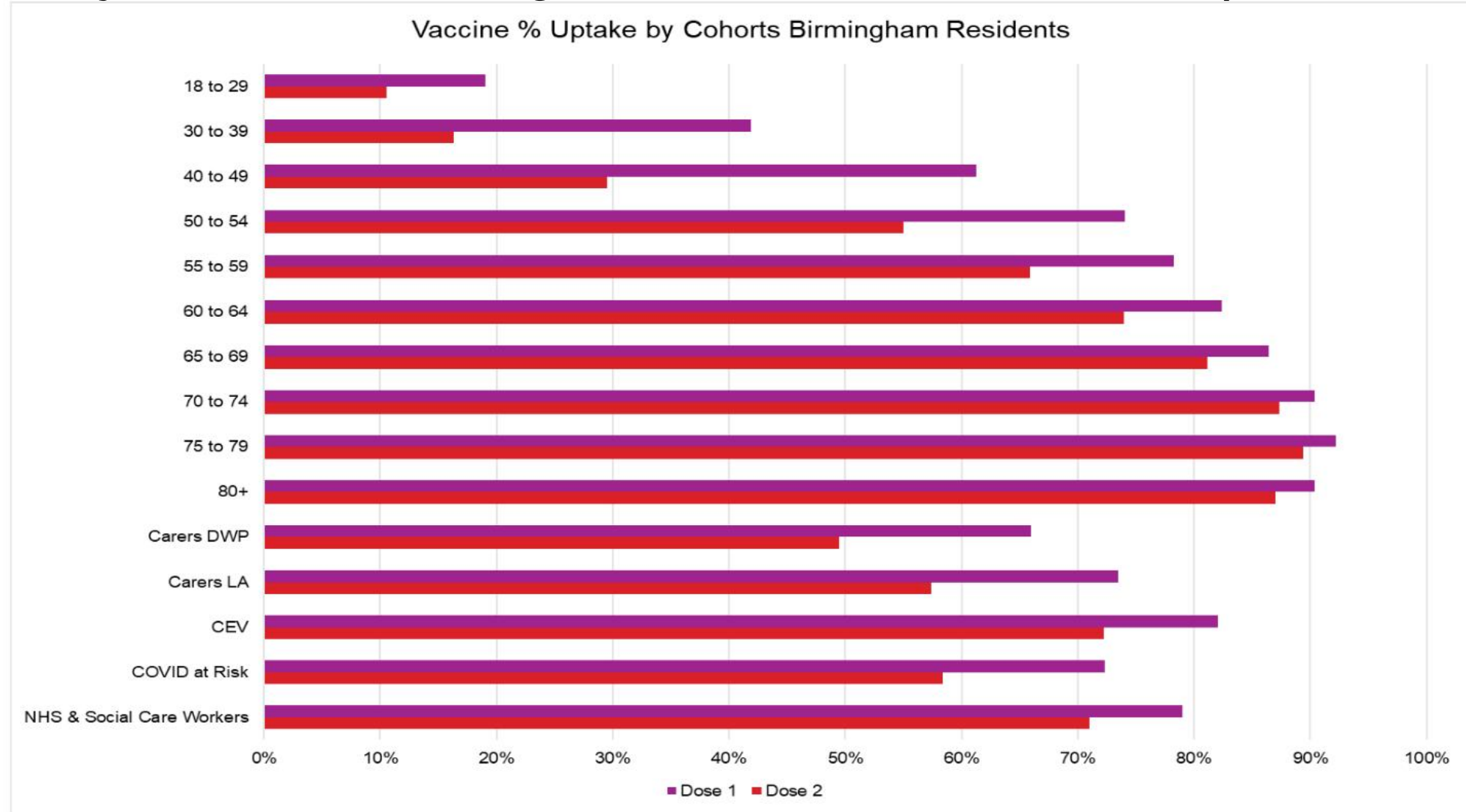

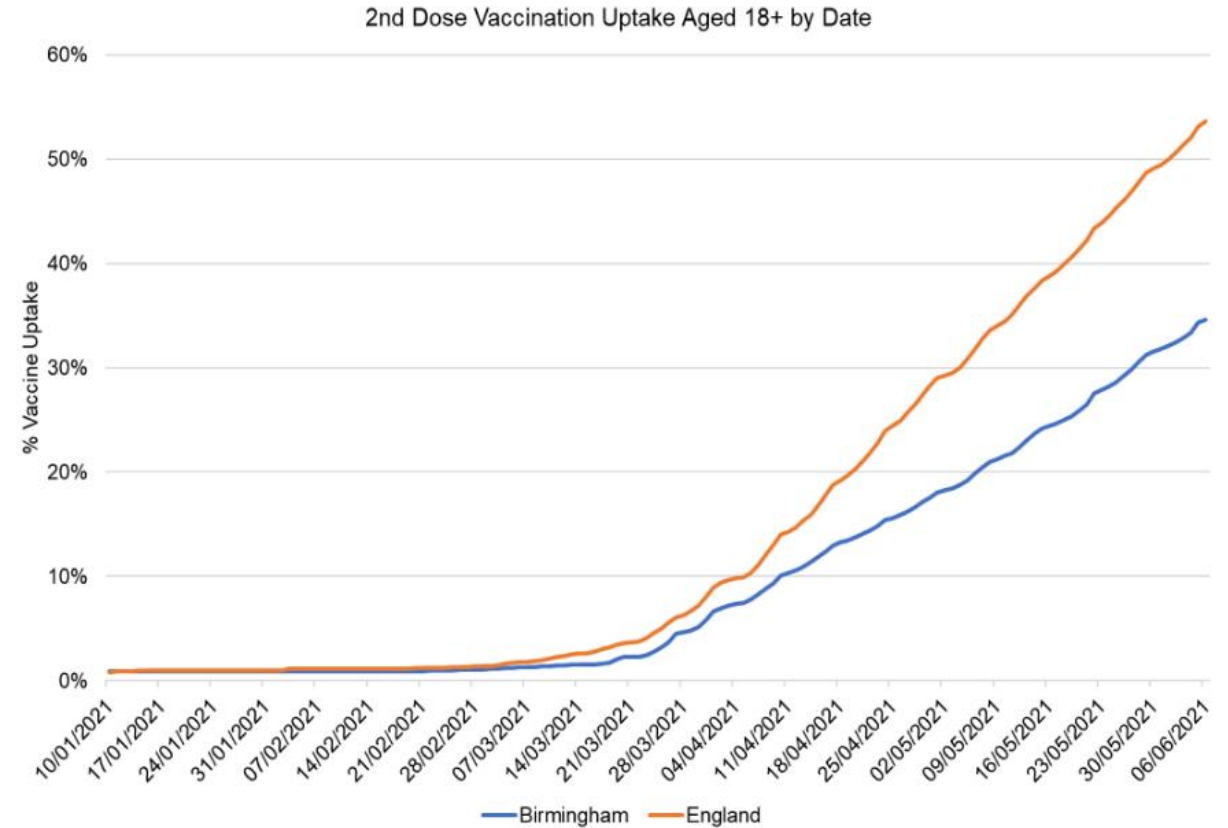
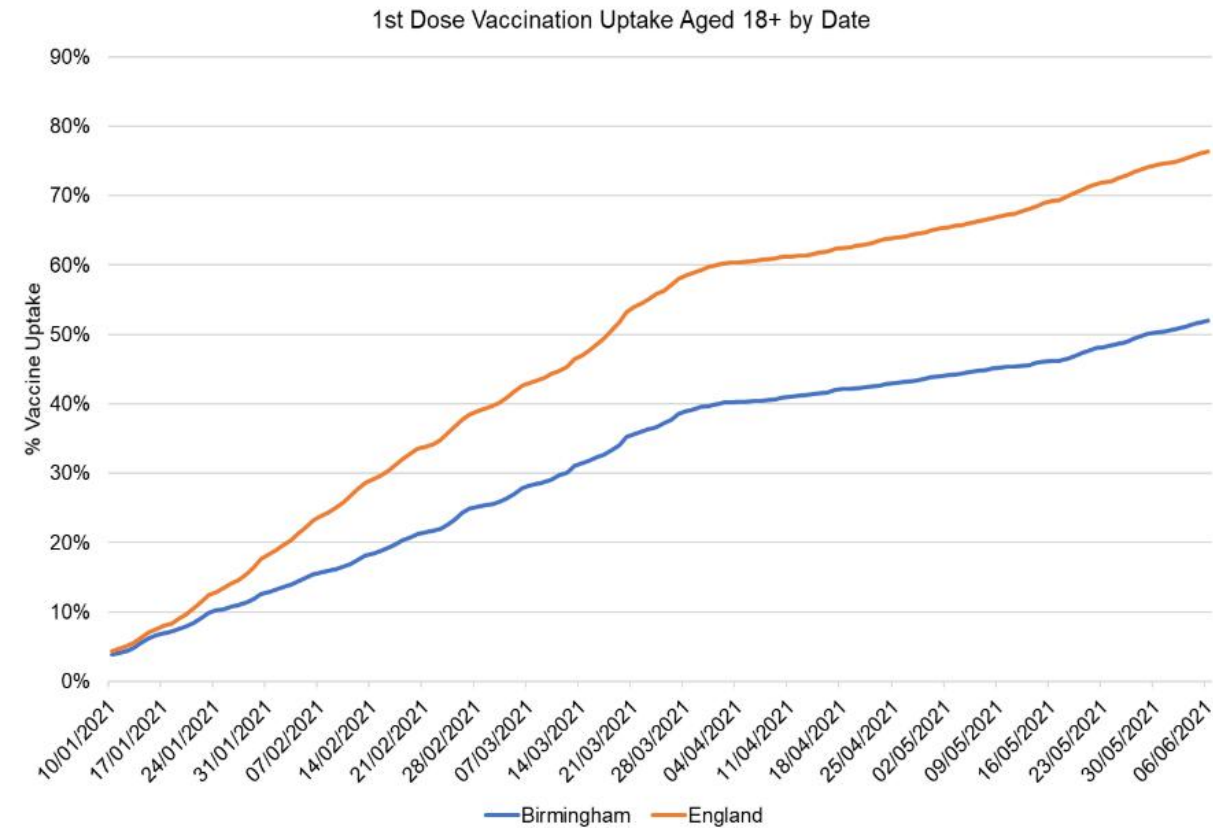

Uptake of 1st dose has slowed since mid March whilst uptake of 2nd dose has accelerated. The rate of uptake in Birmingham is behind the national average for 1st and 2nd doses.

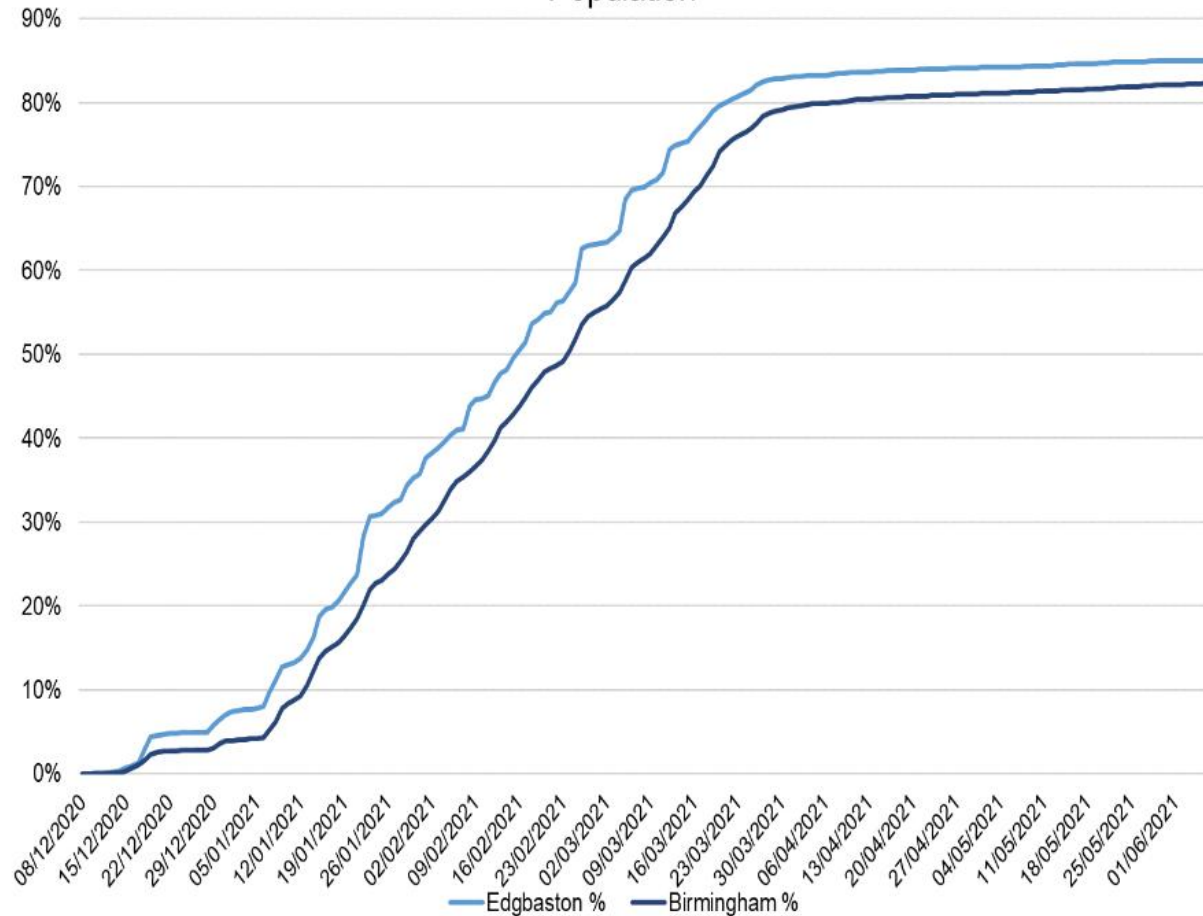

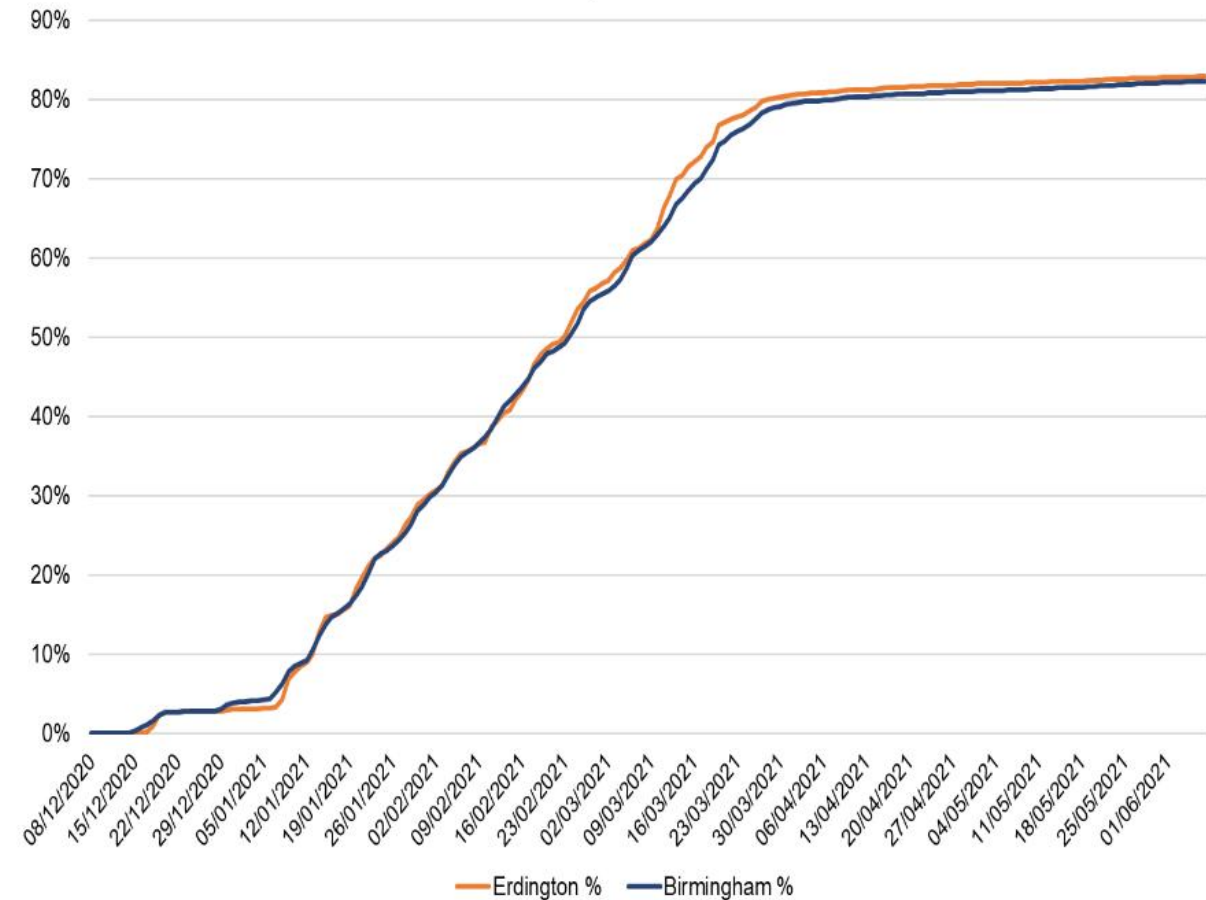

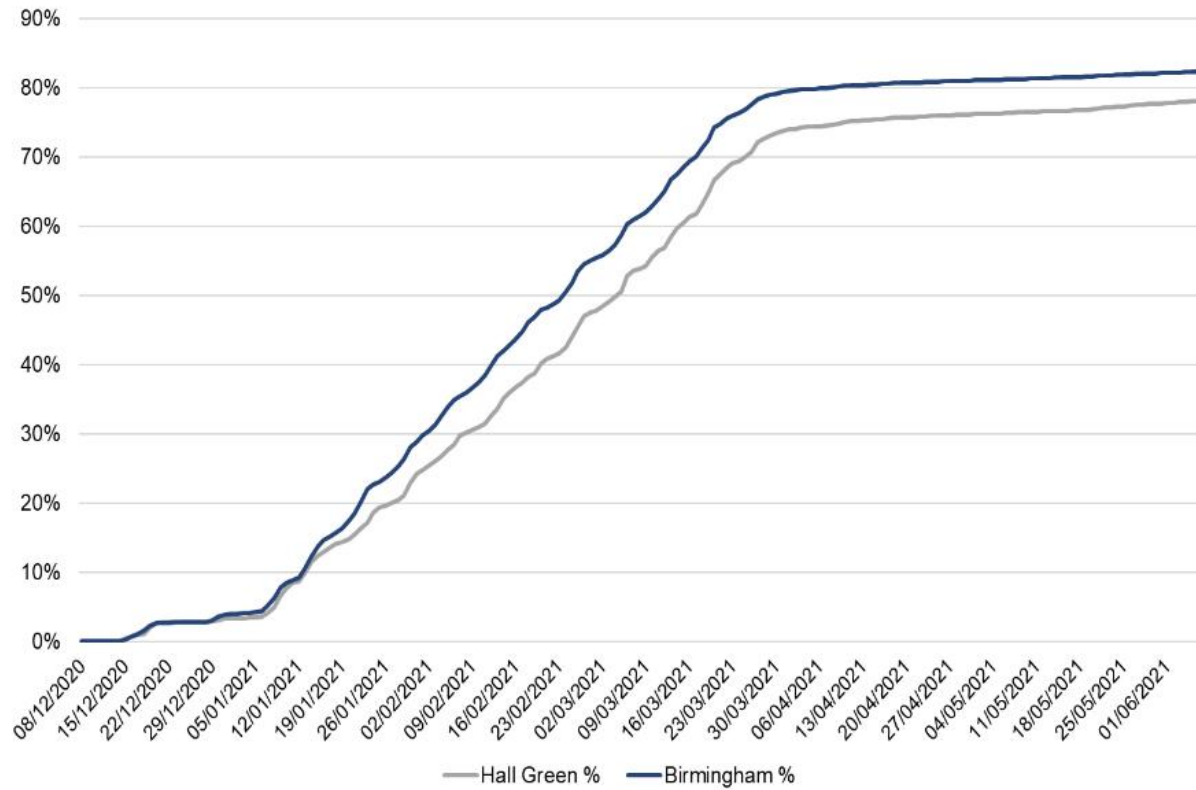


Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+ Population

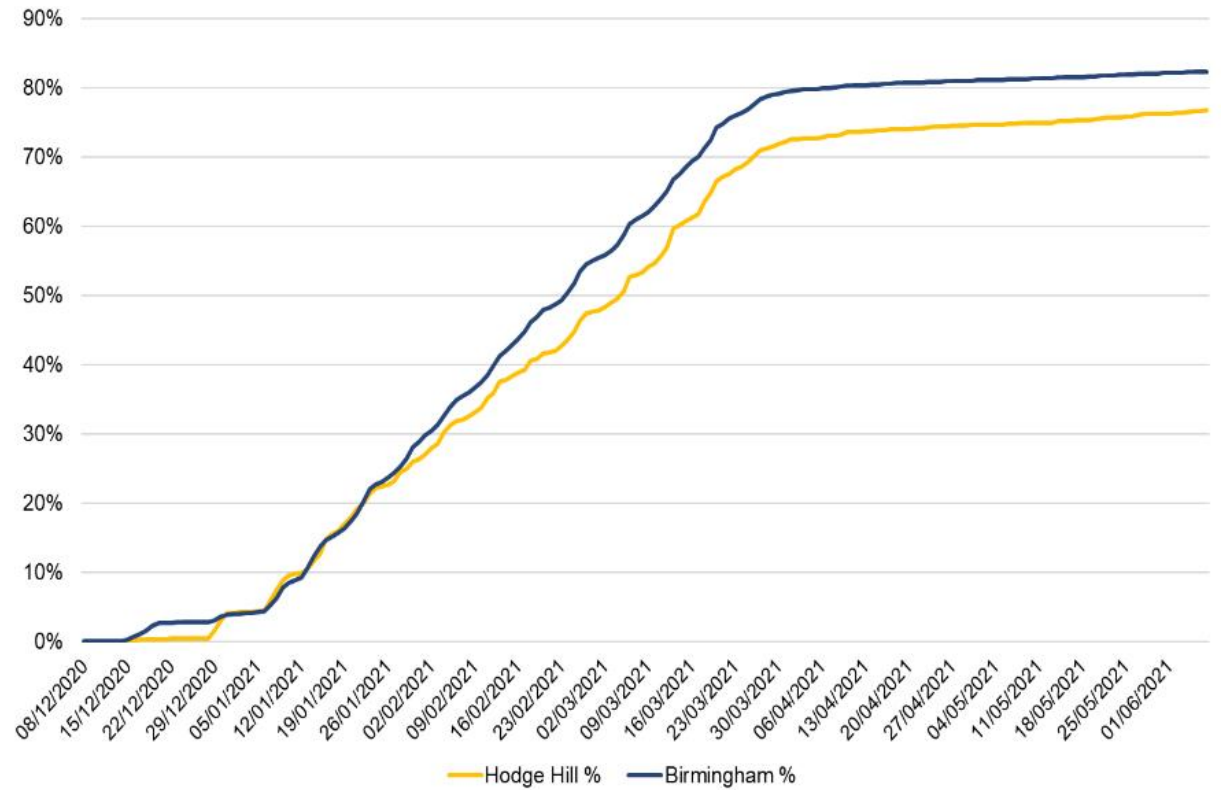

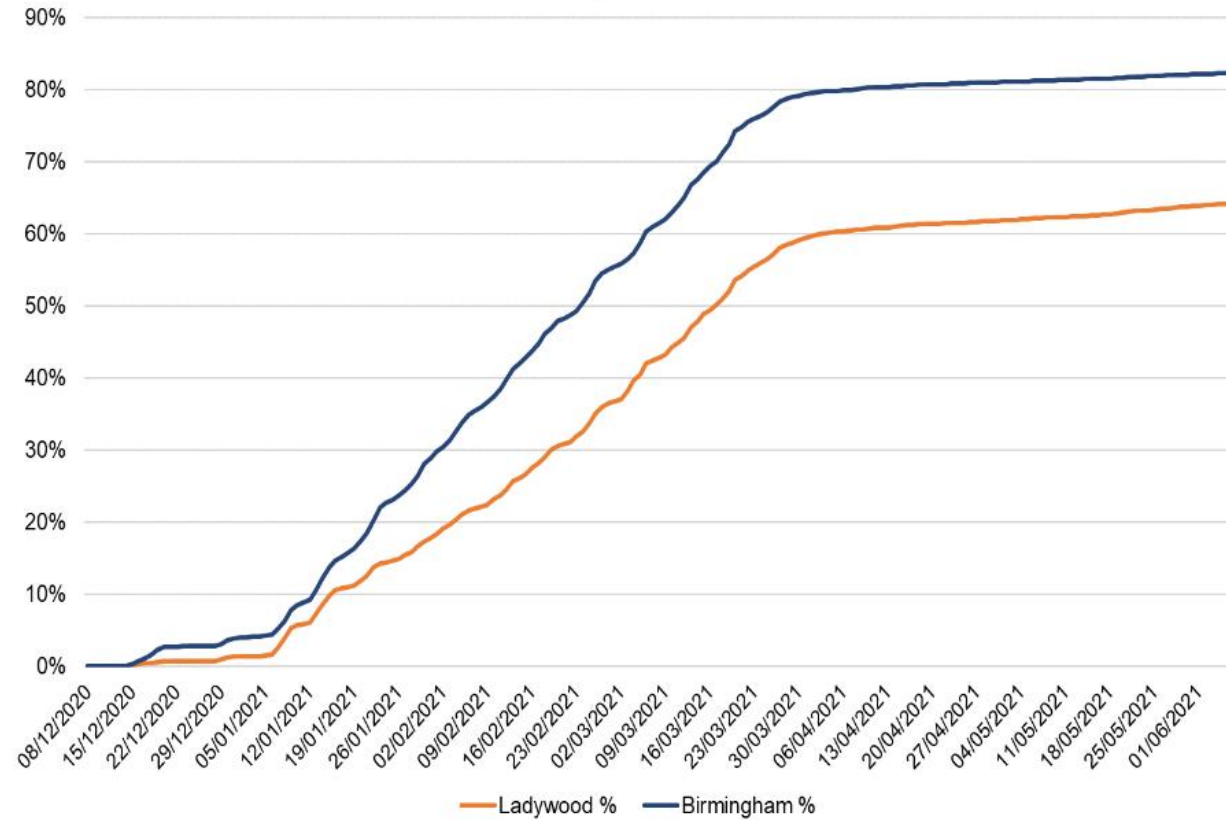


Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+ Population

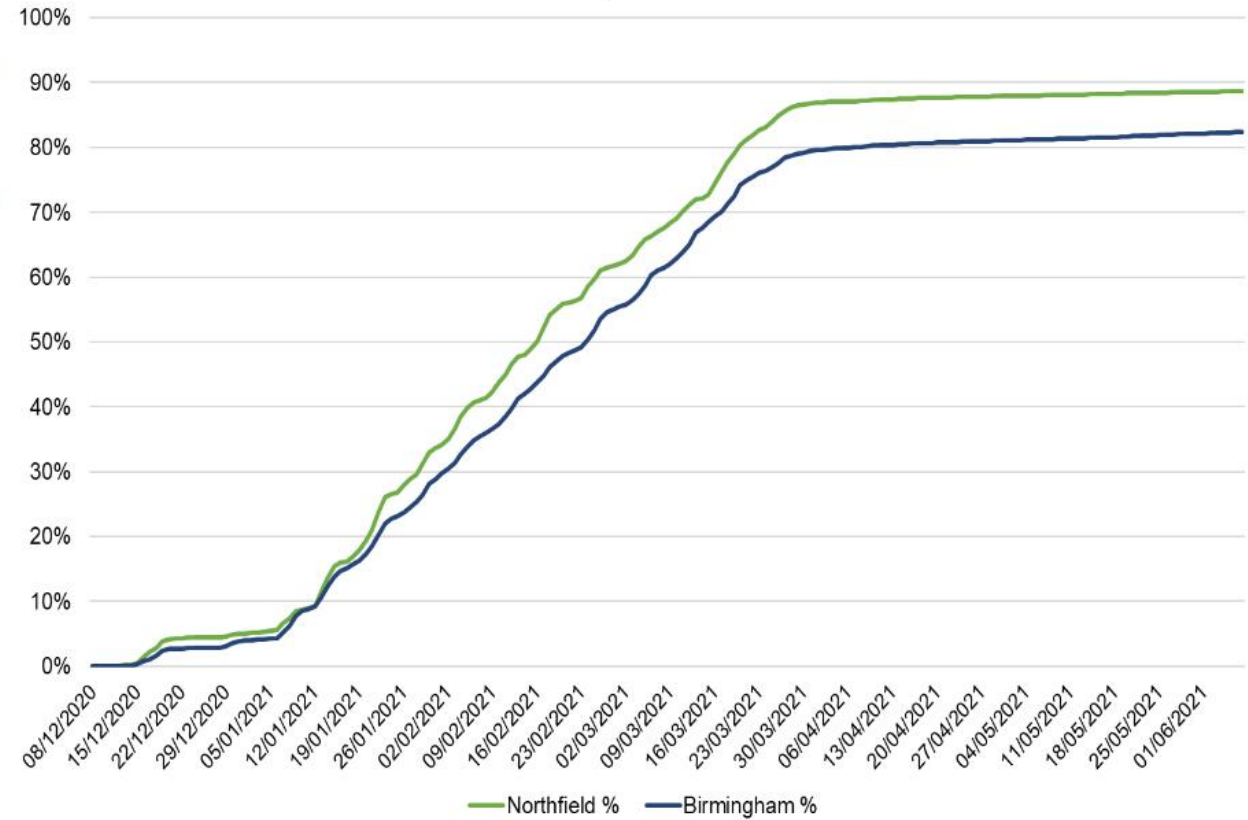

Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+ Population

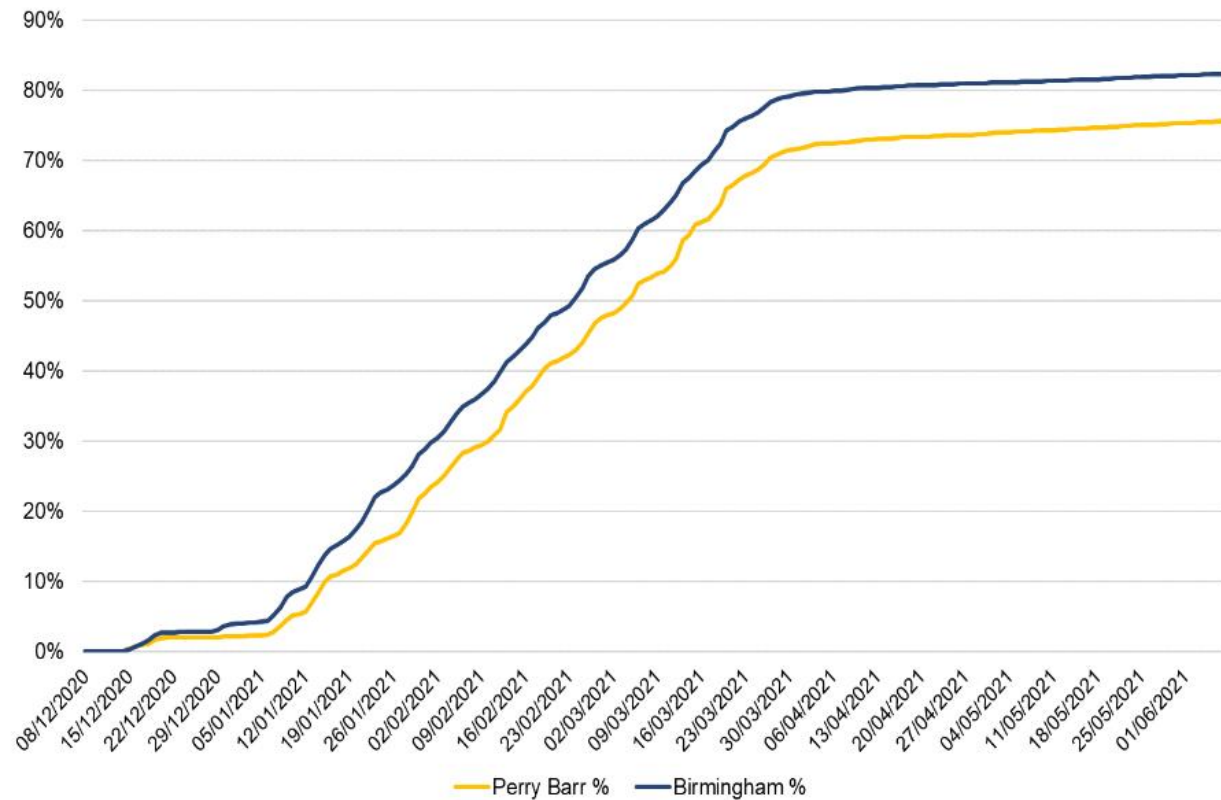


Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+ Population

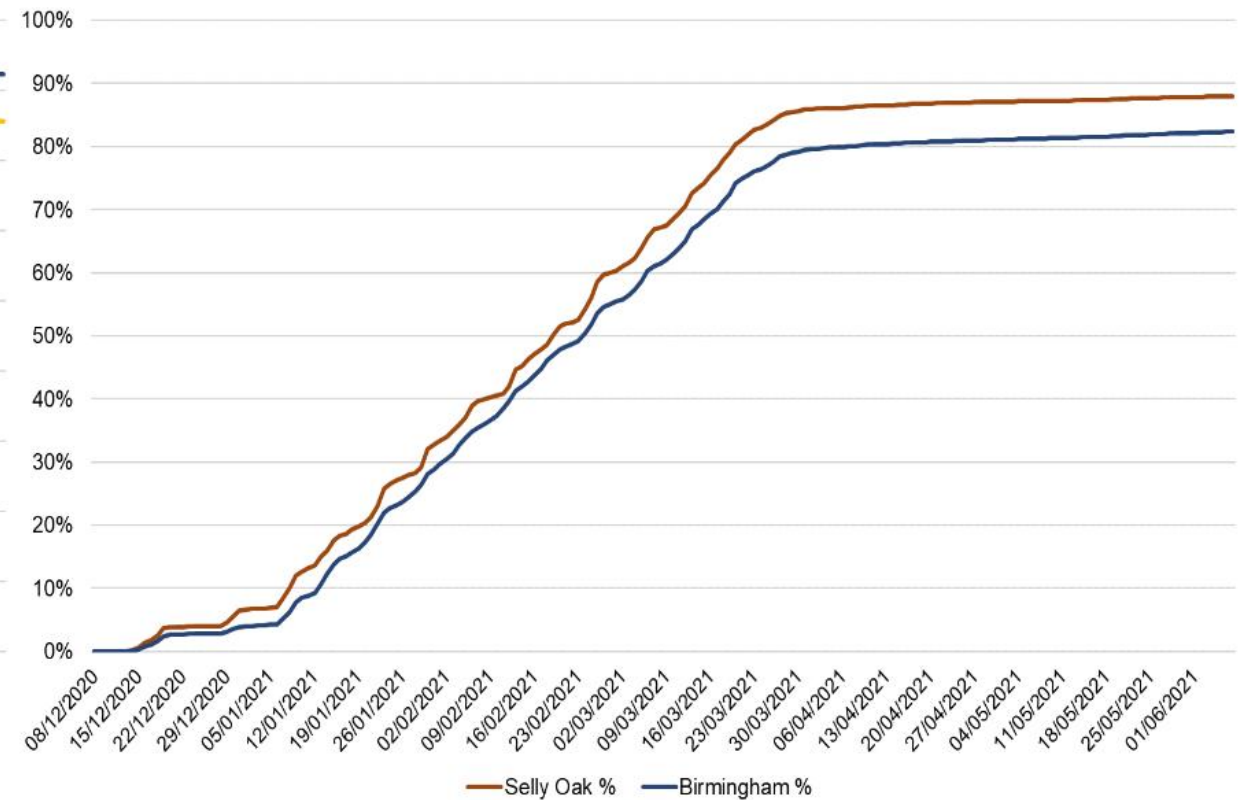

Covid Vaccination % 1st Dose Uptake by Constituency in Age 50+ Population

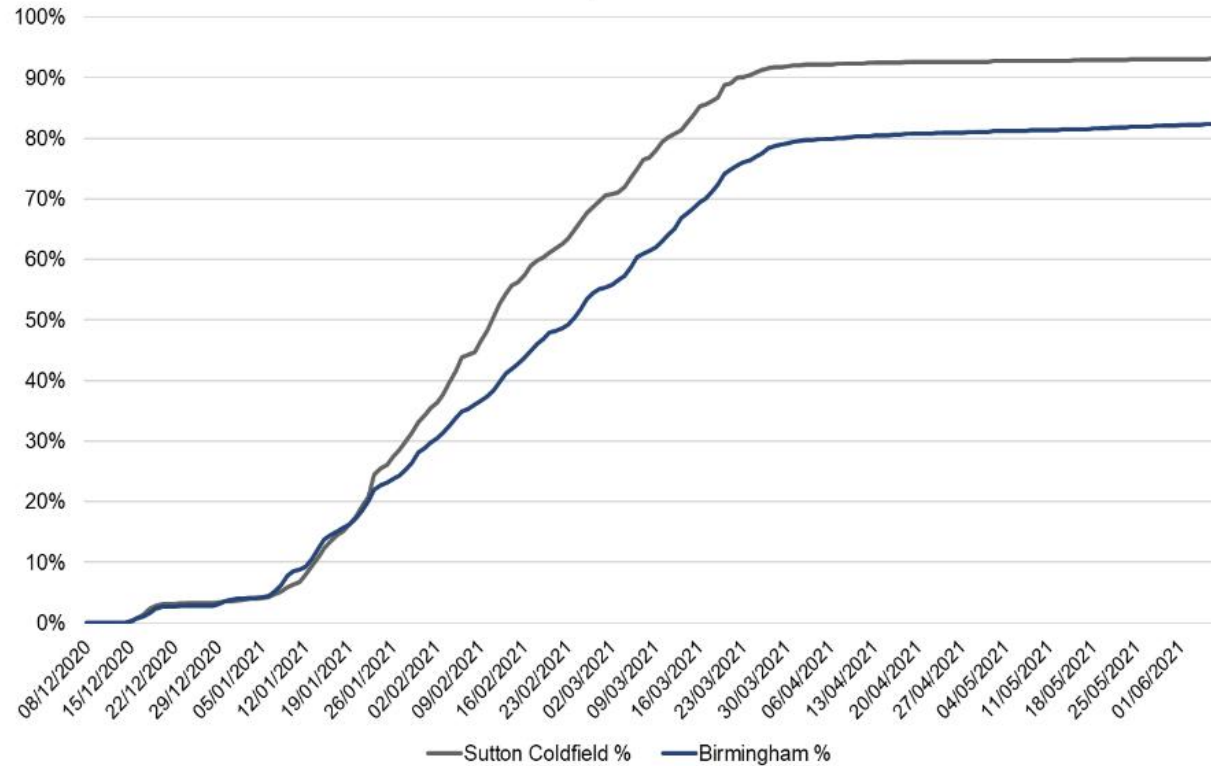

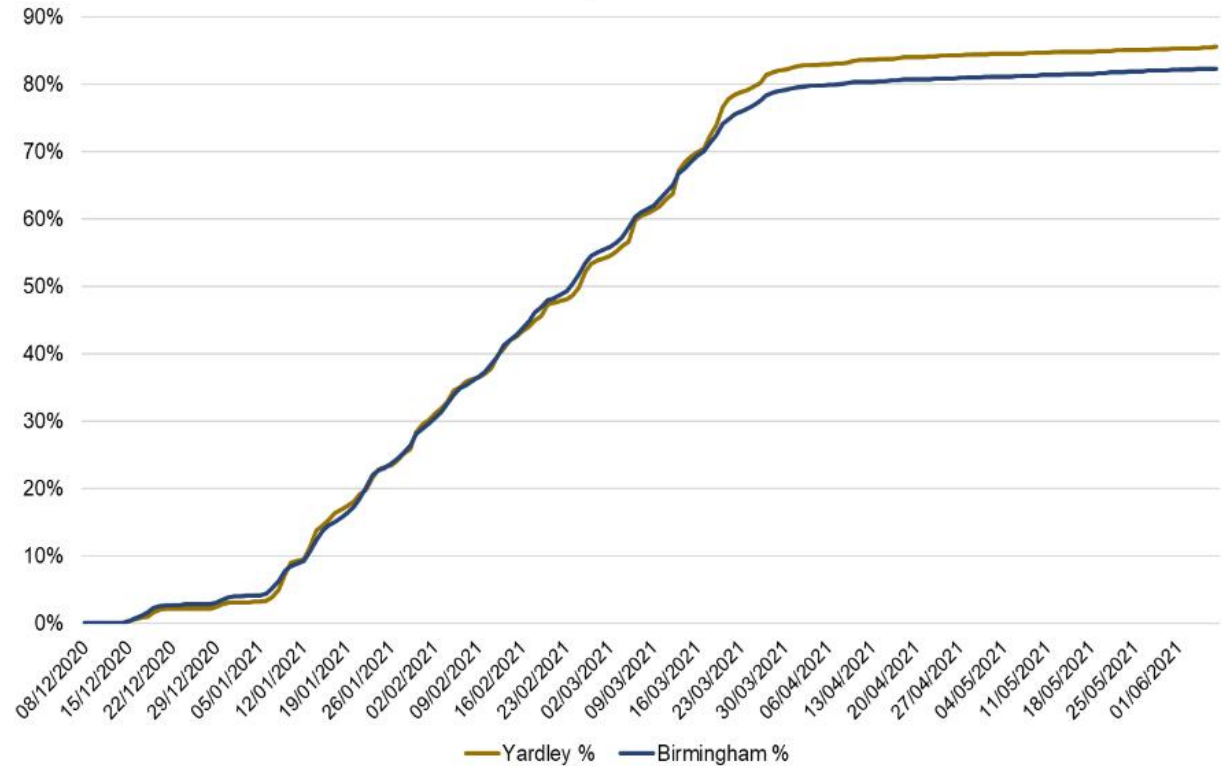

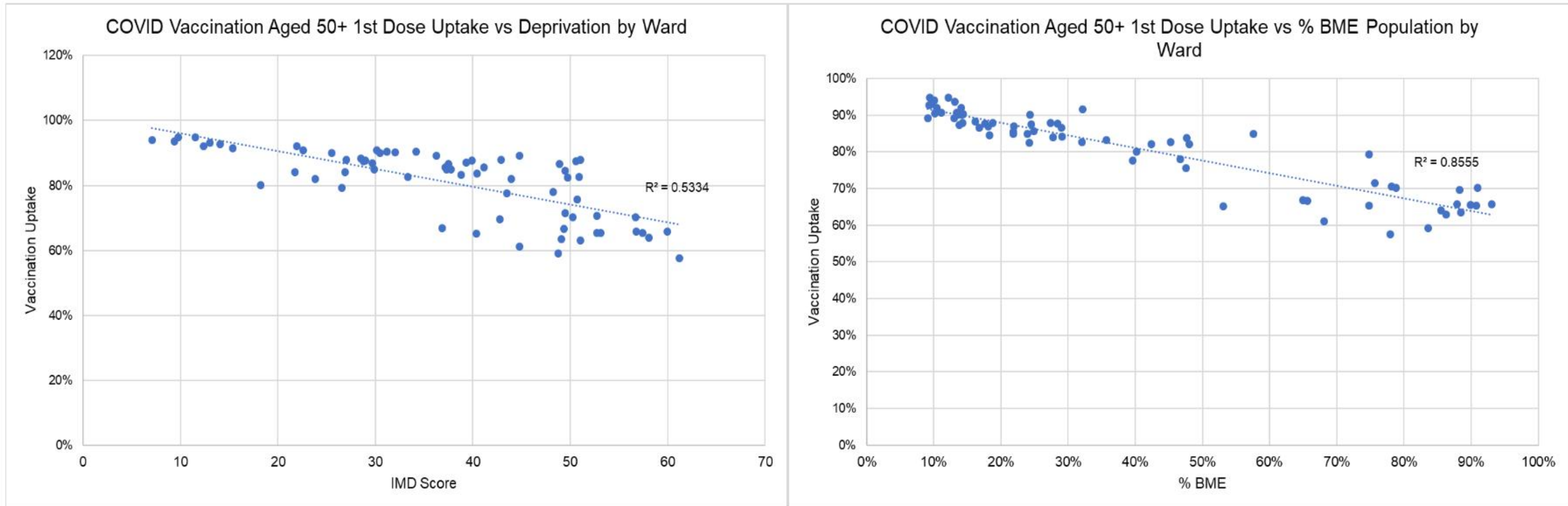
Demographics of Uptake: Ethnicity (extract 08/06)

Across the priority groups, uptake of vaccine is lower in African, Caribbean and Black communities and then Pakistani and Bangladeshi communities. It is worth noting that there is a significant difference in the size of different ethnic groups in different priority groups. For example, the total eligible population of >80yrs from a Pakistani ethnic group is 3,526 compared to 396 from African ethnic groups.

A strong relationship between % BME population vs 1st dose uptake and a moderate relationship between deprivation vs 1st dose uptake are observed.

Local Action

- **Local response has included the following:**
 - Pop-up walk in clinics focussed on areas with high COVID incidence
 - PCN led vaccinations (including intergenerational household vaccination pilot)
 - Mass vaccination sites – Millennium Point, Edgbaston Cricket Ground, Aston Villa Football Ground
 - Four local vaccination vans focussed on areas with greatest need
 - Health Inequalities group focussed on hard to reach groups including more deprived communities
 - Local comms focussed on improving uptake and tackling hesitancy

- **Planned response includes the following:**
 - Focussed surge testing in wards with lowest testing, highest incidence and low vacc rates
 - Exploring potential for walk-in vaccination slots in June in Millennium Stadium, Edgbaston and Aston Villa Stadium dependent on vaccine supply
 - Targeted pop-up walk-in working through focused wards.
 - Intergenerational household pilot extended across PCNs.

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
