3. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

- 3.1 At its meeting on the 7 May 2019 Committee agreed that, in order to accommodate the reporting of changes to the CTS scheme to City Council, to move the January 2020 meeting from the 14th to the 7th. As the CTS scheme is not being reported to City Council until the new municipal year, it is recommended that the January date should revert to the 14th.
- 3.3 At the same meeting the Committee agreed that the deadline for written questions would be moved to the 19 December. It is recommended that, in light of the above change, the deadline for Written Questions move to the 7 January 2020.
