NOTICE is given in accordance with Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and regulation 6 of the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Birmingham City Council proposes to make a prescribed alteration to Baskerville School at Fellows Lane, Harborne, Birmingham B17 9TS. Baskerville School is a community special school, rated "good" by Ofsted, which can offer up to 118 places for pupils aged between 11-19 who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

The prescribed alteration is to increase the number of pupil places being offer from 118 to 187. Birmingham City Council is considering whether to approve building works at the School on 7 June 2022 which would facilitate the increase in pupil number. Completion of those works is conditional upon a decision being made about this proposal.
