Definition of an Urban Street Gang

A relatively durable, predominantly street-based group of young people who:

See themselves (and are seen by others) as a discernible group, **AND** engage in a range of criminal activity and violence.


They also have at least one of the following features:

- Identify with or lay claim over territory
- Have some form of identifying structural feature
- Are in conflict with other, similar, gangs.

Local Issues Related to Urban Street Gangs

- Drug dealing
- Violence, sometimes involving serious injury
- Weapons, including guns and knives
- Active recruitment Male and female
- ASB
- Glorification and the use of social media



What have West Midlands Police done so far and what do they intend to do?



1. <u>Understanding (on going)</u>

- Identifying and 'Mapping' those involved.
- Looking for those gang members not obvious to Police systems.
- Looking for those at risk of becoming future members siblings, relatives, friends etc.
- Subject Profiles
- Multi Agency Approach
- Intelligence development Source referrals, speaking with members of public and families of gang members, flow of intel from other agencies, prisoner debriefs, covert enquiries,




2. Early Positive Action - Disruption

- Warrant resulting in the recovery of a firearm, ammunition, cash, class A and B drugs and stolen motorbike – Prominent member of '61' Gang arrested and charged.
- Multiple warrants and arrests of five prominent members of the Frankley Killers for Conspiracy to Commit GBH – Content of 'No Lack' Youtube Video.
- Execution of Sec 8 PACE warrant Recovery of mobile phone containing video footage of a firearms discharge and a wealth of gang related intelligence.
- NPT plans, including 'spring clean' operation.
