1. Purpose of report:

To consider relevant representations that have been made in respect of an application for a Premises Licence which seeks to permit the Sale of Alcohol (for consumption off the premises) to operate from 6:00am until 9:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

Premises to remain open to the public from 6:00am until 9:00pm (Monday to Sunday).

3. Brief Summary of Report:

An application for a Premises Licence was received on 18th November 2016 in respect of SD News, 23 Quinton Road West, Quinton, Birmingham, B32 2QA.

5. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

Satinder Singh Athwal applied on 18th November 2016 for the grant of a Premises Licence for SD News, 23 Quinton Road West, Quinton, Birmingham, B32 2QA.

A representation in support of the application, in the form of a petition, has been received from the applicant's representative. See Appendix 2.

If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.

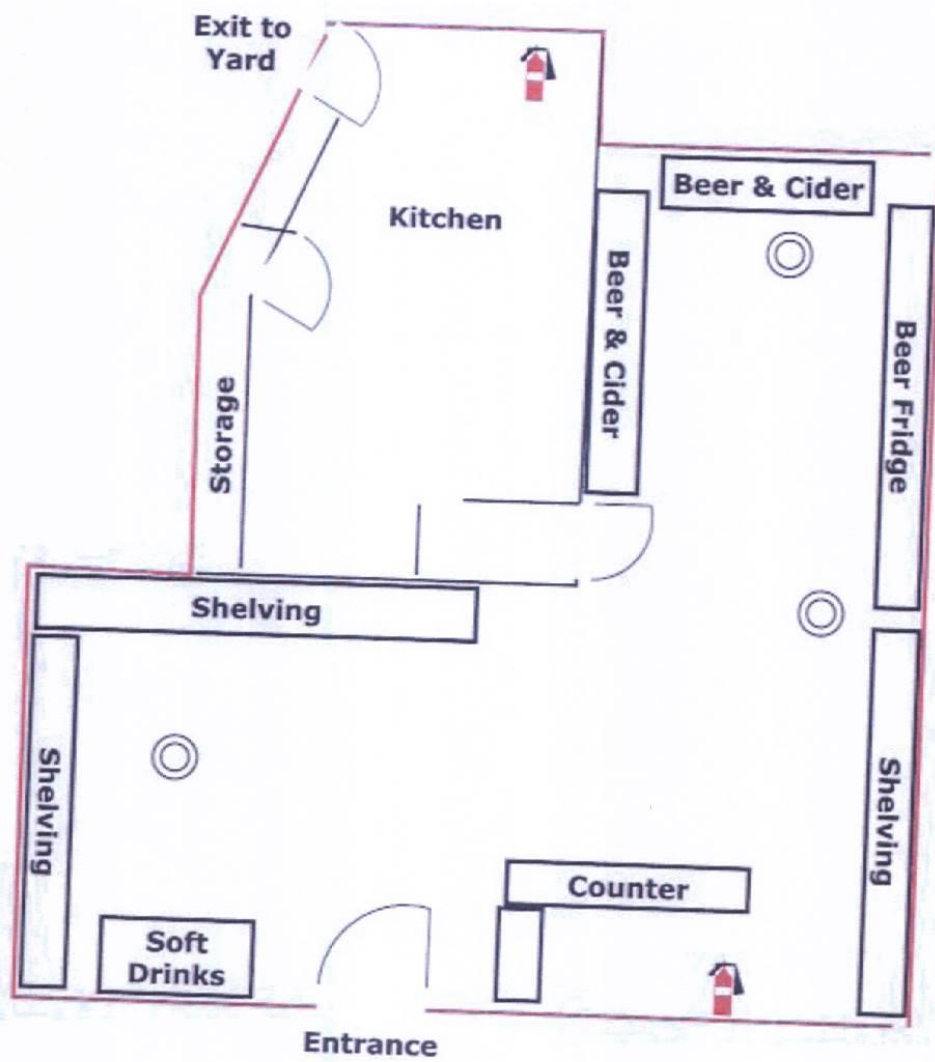

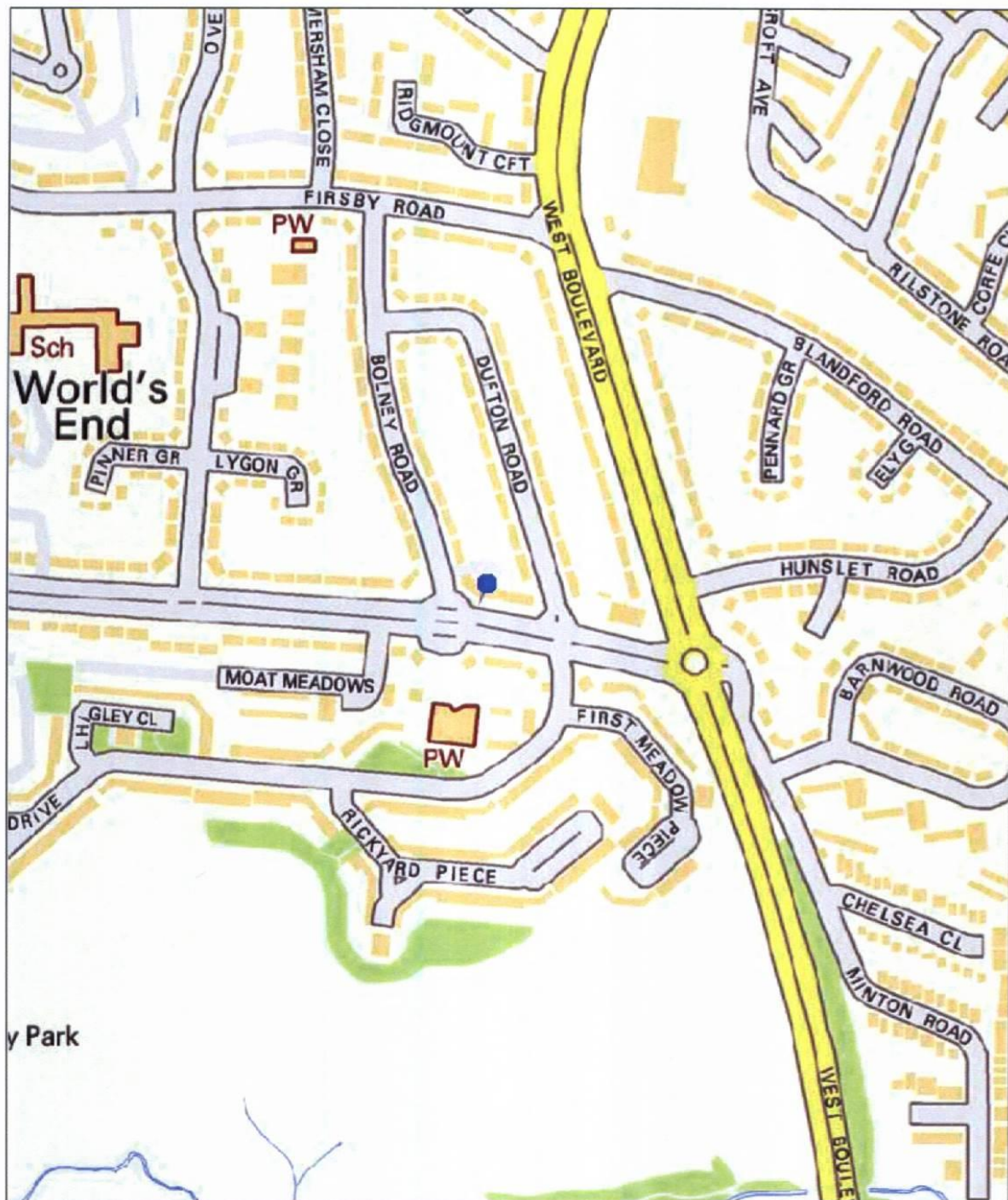

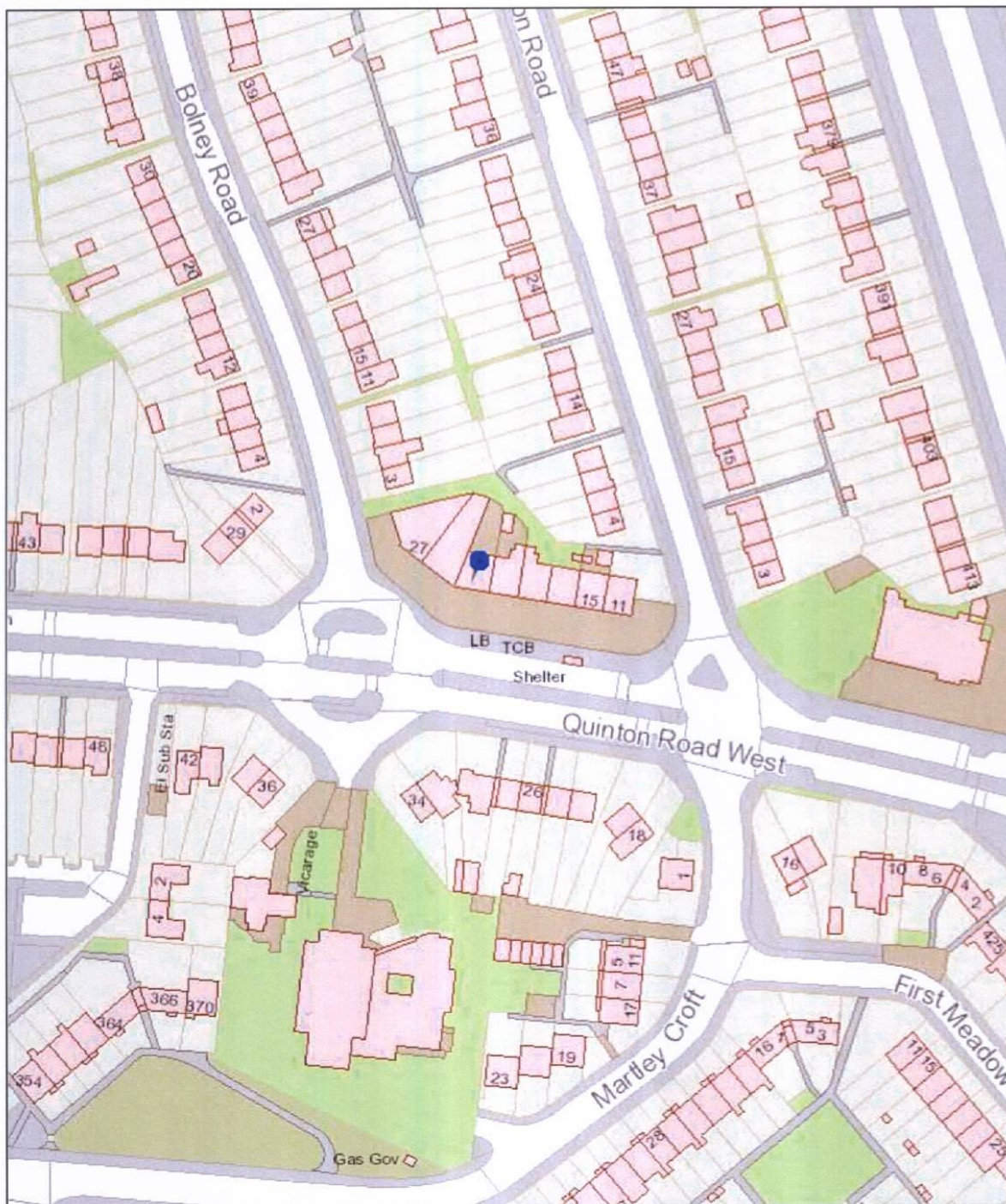
