On Saturday 6th August 2016 between 14:00 – 22:00hrs I was attached to Policing this event in company of PC 20113 Horton, along with several other officers assigned to policing the event.

I was assigned to supporting the event at the front security entrance area where there were large queues waiting to enter the premises throughout the day. Whilst standing opposite the front gates I observed measures being taken by the security staff on the front entrance gate. I would assess that there were clearly not enough security staff present at this location to deal with the numbers of people entering the event. As part of the licence for the event we were informed that there was to be no alcohol aloud into the event area and only alcohol purchased within the event tents would be consumed in those areas. Throughout the day there I could clearly see numerous people drinking from alcohol from glass bottles within the event grounds and walking out from the entrance with alcohol in their hands.

Although security were making attempts to stop people entering with alcohol it was not adequate enough to stop the majority of people entering with alcohol. On numerous occasions I could clearly see either people walking through the entrance with alcohol hidden by holding it by the side of their legs, with it in their hands, or placed into their pockets. I even witnessed one security officer having a quiet word with one person entering to tell him to hide his open glass bottle of beer in his trouser pocket and walk through. I feel that the way the security operation ran was poorly planned as the numbers of people in the event were supposed to be counted, however this was clearly not the case as the number counts were nowhere near accurate. There was one member of security with a counter to count people entering, he clearly was unable to monitor and count the numbers within the event as it was to unorganised as he was trying to monitor one entrance while others were letting people pass through a second entrance aisle. There were also large numbers of people coming out of a barrier area next to the entrance aisles, these numbers were not being taken into account and were not being counted to give an accurate account of numbers present within the event.

I also witnessed people entering the event through a closed off barrier being manned by security next to the entrance aisles. It was clear that security new these people and appeared to be family and friends that the security were letting through the barriers, these people were not also being taken into account in regards to monitoring the numbers who were entering.

There were some members of the security team on the entrance gates which looked disinterested in the task at hand. Upon one security officer being given the counting device to monitor numbers of people entering, he was just holding the device taking no interest in numbers entering and just appeared to be letting people pass him without monitoring them for the count or for alcohol or wrist bands.

There were numerous people entering with wrist bands which had clearly been ripped in half and produced holding it in their hands rather than the wrist bands being attached to their wrists. There

were numerous people passing there wrist bands to others through fences so they could gain access to the event. I also saw people jumping over fences to get into the event with no security present to stop them.

Later that day I then approached the security supervisor to warn him that there were numerous people entering the event in breach of the licence conditions agreed to before the event in regards to people entering with alcohol, bits of wrist bands and numbers not being monitored effectively. At first he denied there were people entering with alcohol, however at this time a PCSO next to me pointed at someone who had just entered with alcohol. This person could clearly be seen with a glass bottle of alcohol in his hand. At this point the security supervisor stated that there were not adequate numbers of security from the start and it was unmanageable to begin with.

At this point security did try and improve things and try to confront more people entering with alcohol, it was too little too late as there was already too many people inside the event with alcohol, and no real accurate figures for the amount of people inside the event. If anything the security challenging more people entering with alcohol just hindered the flow of people entering the event and creating longer queues. At this point there were people in the queues arguing and shouting at security staff about not being allowed in with alcohol but nowhere near enough numbers to effectively deal with these situations, eventually some being allowed to pass due to not enough security to stop them. At times I felt that there was the potential for disorder to erupt due to the issues of challenging people entering with alcohol, my concern was that were nowhere near enough security to deal with any major issues.

There were also some security on the entrance without any ID security badges and could not clearly be identified as part of the security detail. I feel that this event was poorly planned and had the potential to go extremely wrong if arguments escalated and the security officers did not back down.

Sir/Maam,

As requested I have recorded any observations made in relation to anything of note during the Jamaican Independence Day festival taking place on Saturday 6th August 2016 at the location of Handsworth Park.

I policed the even between 13:00hrs to 15:45hrs in company with PC 2114 Westwood on foot patrol both in and around the venue providing high visibility reassurance.

Whilst taking part in this operation I noted the following

I noted a stall selling bottles of what appeared to be sparkling wine from a bucket with ice, the group organiser quickly advised the stall that they could not sell the alcohol in the presence of police. The alcohol was then hidden from display and not sold. The stall owner was not aware that they were not able to sell alcohol at the location prior to the event taking place.

Within the park on several occasions vehicles were travelling on the park walkways during busy peak times obstructing pedestrians. The vehicles appeared to belong to stall owners of the festival whom were parking at the bridge entrance of the festival grounds.

The Holly road entrance to the park was heavily congested and this was also the emergency entrance/exit for St Johns Ambulance. If an emergency had taken place traffic management tactics would have been required, of which there was no on site festival staff assigned to do this. In addition cars continually tried to turn into the entrance at Holly road (which during the day encountered the heaviest footfall due to being located next to the main entrance to the festival.) Vehicles trying to enter this entrance were becoming stuck with nowhere to go due to pedestrians and other vehicles which in turn caused congestion and blocking further along Holly road and other main arterial routes around the park.

I was aware that the festival was going to deploy 2 x bar tents with a capacity of 49 people in each, however this was not the case. There was a single gazebo which served as an open air bar/stall.

On several occasions cannabis was smelt whilst walking through the festival, it was impossible to pinpoint any particular individuals smoking due to the number of people attending.

Jamaican Independence Celebrations at Handsworth Park 6th August 2016

I was one of the Police Officers who worked the Jamaican Independence day celebrations in Handsworth Park on the 6th of August 2016. I was posted in Handsworth Park at the junction of Thornhill Road and Holly Road. There was about 7 security staff who were working this entrance into the event.

Around 4 – 5 other members of staff were taking money, and attaching wrist bands to members of the public who were entering the event.

Throughout standing at the entrance there was a large queue of people at all times. There was a constant flow into the Park.

I could see these 7 Security Guards were trying to manage a large queue entering the park. Persons who had already paid re-entering the Park, and people who wished to leave the park. Every now and again vehicles from inside the Park would leave the Park through a temporary 'fence type' barrier. This was also controlled by Security Staff.

Some people were attempting to avoid the queue into the Park, and walk through the exit. Security would challenge these individuals and they were being directed to the back of the queue.

Security Guards did not appear to have the numbers of staff to cope.

I spoke with a security guard who had a 'hand held' people counting device at 4pm who stated 943 people had entered the Park. This seemed to be a very low number due to the constant flow of people entering the Park.

Some people were refused entry into the Park by Security Guards who found alcohol.

At 4.30pm I checked again and he stated 1200 people had entered the Park. This figure did not match the amount of people I saw entering the park.

I watched the Security Guard who was holding the people counter. When he spoke with the public or directed people he was not counting people entering the Park. The hand held counter was being passed around to different staff.

I saw people entering the park with bottles of alcohol. Sometimes carried in their back pockets of their jeans.

Security stopped a male who was carrying alcohol attempting to enter the Park. He stood by the barriers. When security were distracted by another person trying to walk in the exit gate. I saw this man with the alcohol jump the barriers and walk in unchallenged.

..... I am Police Sergeant 5351 WOOD of West Midlands Police currently based at Digbeth Police Station.

On Saturday 6th August 2016, together with other officers, I was requested to attend Handsworth Park,

Handsworth to assist with the policing of an organised party to celebrate Jamaica Independence Day.

On arrival at about 18.30 hours, I was briefed about the event by PS SIMPSON and asked to police the two main entrance gates and monitor any possible infringements or issues. I was advised that it was busy with a mixed crowd of families but also large groups of adult males. I was further advised that it appeared that the security teams on the entrances appeared to have lost control of the event. I deployed my staff around the outer perimeter whilst I patrolled the area near to the main entrance on Holly Road, Handsworth.

When I first approached the security on the main entrance their first comment was "you're a bit late, you needed to be here earlier". I asked if there had been trouble and one of the three staff on the gate said "it doesn't matter, it's done with now". When I asked how many people were inside the event, I was told that they had stopped counting and had no idea how many were inside. I then remained at the gate for several minutes. At this time I saw a male I recognised and who I know is supposedly linked to armed and organised criminality. This male appeared to be directing other males to enter the main gate. On one occasion two males walked past security. The security officer called them back to check wrist bands (which are issued to those who had paid to attend the party in the park and the wearing of which was a condition of entry) were being worn. One male showed his band. The other made no attempt to do so but turned towards the security officer, said something I could not hear and carried on walking. I formed the impression that this male had not paid to enter the party, had no permission to enter but had intimidated the security officer into allowing him entry, though the officer made no complaint to me. There were only three security officers on the main gate which appeared insufficient to deal with any potential conflict.

I moved away from the gate and patrolled the area outside the fencing which had been erected for the party. This area was very busy with families who appeared happy and were all very engaging. I did not see anything in this area to give me concern but at numerous times I could clearly smell cannabis. This smell was

strong and very close to the large numbers of children who were playing in the area.

I returned to the main gate entrance and again spoke with security officers. They all seemed to be frustrated and angry at the lack of control of the event and with the lack of any support given to them by the organiser of the event. One of the officers confirmed that the security team were contracted to work until 20.30 hours and that they had all had enough and intended to be off site by this time. I asked if Police Officers had been into the actual event and was told that it was best Police stayed away because there were some in the crowd who would "kick off". With regards to my earlier observations, I suspected that this security officer was probably correct in his view.

A short while later I was stood down from the policing of the Park and had no further involvement.

I had patrolled the area for just over an hour, from about 18.30 – 20.00 hours. From my observations and interaction with the public, it was clear that a large part of the community had attended and had enjoyed the event. Though most of the people I spoke with had been on the outside of the event, it was clear that they had attended because of it. Looking ahead, these people need to be remembered when considering public safety etc. In the small area I patrolled (between the main gate and the Leisure Centre) I would guestimate there were somewhere approaching 700-800 people and saw many more in areas patrolled by other officers. Though I did not enter the Party area it was obvious that the security provision was inadequate. There were known gang nominal stood by the main gate, seemingly directing other males into the event whilst at the same time the security team appeared understaffed, intimidated and underprepared to deal with groups or individuals who posed a challenge.
