Reasons for Lateness

The Director wanted to ensure that the report was fully reviewed once all feedback had been considered following the end of the related consultation period at mid-night on 27th January 2020 and that particular consideration was given to the proposed review of the use of catchment areas for the relevant Council schools as reflected in the report.

Reasons for Urgency

All admission authorities, of which Birmingham City Council is one, are required to set ('determine') admission arrangements annually by 28 February. The arrangements so determined will apply to the next-but-one academic year (i.e. arrangements determined on 28 February 2020 will apply to the academic year 2021/22). The Local Authority is also required to determine on an annual basis a Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme which is to apply to the next-but-one academic year and to inform the Secretary of State that such a scheme has been adopted by no later than 28 February each year.

Cabinet is required to have approved the above two schemes on behalf of the Council by 28th February to ensure the Council has met its statutory obligations as outlined in the School Admissions Code (2014).
