APPOINTMENTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES**1. Summary of Decisions**

On 15 August 2017, Cabinet resolved under decision number 004096/2017 that the practice be continued of contacting each representative when their term of office is due to expire to ascertain whether they are willing to be re-appointed and that, unless indicated otherwise in the report to Cabinet, it will be understood that such representatives are not willing to be re-appointed.

2. Muntz Trust

The Aims & activities of the Muntz Trust is to make donations to assist with running costs of Birmingham based charitable organisations not primarily supported by the public rate, for medical, surgical or research purposes.

Four Nominative Trustees who may be, but need not be, Members of the City Council and are appointed for one year. The terms of office of Hon. Ald. Theresa Stewart (Lab), Mrs Marjorie Bartley (Lab) Mr Gordon Franks (Con) Mr Alistair Dow (Lib Dem) all expired on 1 December 2018.

Therefore, it is

RECOMMENDED

- i) That Cabinet agrees to the re-appointment of Hon. Ald. Theresa Stewart (Lab) from 11 December 2018 until 10 December 2019 as Nominative Trustee.
- ii) That Cabinet agrees to the re-appointment of Mrs Marjorie Bartley (Lab) from 11 December 2018 until 10 December 2018 as Nominative Trustee.
- iii) That Cabinet agrees to the re-appointment of Mr Gordon Franks (Con) from 11 December 2018 until 10 December 2019 as Nominative Trustee.
- iv) That Cabinet agrees to the re-appointment of Mr Alistair Dow (Lib Dem) from 11 December 2018 until 10 December 2019 as Nominative Trustee.

3. Birmingham Trees for Life

The aims are to plant and promote the planting of trees in the city. The organisation is part of Birmingham Civic Society. It receives a small amount of funding from BCC and much assistance from the Parks Department.

Subsequent to the appointment made at Cabinet on 26 June 2018, Councillor Keith Linnecor has decided to relinquish the position on Birmingham Trees for Life and Councillor Mohammed Azim has been nominated to take on that position for the remainder of the current annual term.
