There is an elderly group who in the last twenty years started with having a base in Crown Building on Washwood Heath Road and then moved to Saltley Methodist Church when Crown Building was sold. This group of elderly people need a base where they can get together to socialise and spend their leisurely time. Last year they had to move from the Saltley Methodist Church and they are looking for premises locally where they can meet each other. We have two local Secondary Schools, a couple of Mosques a few local voluntary organisations who are willing to explore some ideas, how they can engage, expand their services and contribute in tackling some of the local issues. We are exploring to apply for Alum Rock BID, Business Improvement District and Saltley Business Association has got a new management structure and they would be looking for an office. To put in the nutshell, though the building needs substantial investment but with the combination of all these partnerships and a few others like the police and HS2, Heritage Lottery Fund, I don't think it's a huge task to get this building back into use. Its not costing anything to the Council at the moment. So its worth trying to make an attempt to bring this building back into use and we the elected members will be at the forefront to ensure it works. For some reason if it does not
