The main road serving the school is Hollybank Rd and Chamberlain Rd and can be accessed from Wheelers Lane and Roads*

Haunch Lane the speed limits on these roads vary from 20 mph to 30 mph. All these roads are residential roads, with Hollybank Road serving as main route through the residential estate that surrounds the school.

The school has good walking routes, the pavements are in good condition and are well lit.

There are no direct off road cycle routes that serve the school so pupils will need to ride quiet residential roads that surround the school. The school offers Bikeability training to its pupils to enable them to ride safely if they wish to use a

bike to travel to school.
