To consider the following Motions of which notice has been given in accordance with Standing Order 4(1)

A. Councillors Deirdre Alden and Gary Sambrook have given notice of the following Notice of Motion:-

"The Council believes that the Leader's handling of the industrial dispute with Unite over waste collections has badly let down staff, senior officers, fellow Cabinet Members, non-executive Councillors and most importantly the residents of Birmingham.

This Council calls on the Leader to now urgently ensure the clearing up of the City of waste and litter, and ensure the return of weekly refuse collections permanently."

B. Councillors Paul Tilsley and Jon Hunt have given notice of the following Notice of Motion:-
