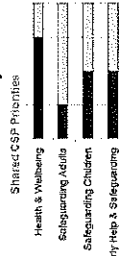

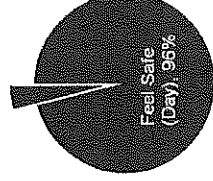
Developing Partner Links

Three of four BCSP priorities are shared with the four main linked boards in the city.



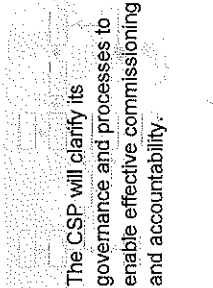
Horizon Scanning & Tension Monitoring

The CSP will monitor issues and tensions. It will prepare itself for the future.



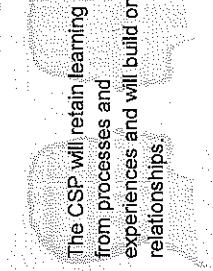
CSP Governance Consolidation

The CSP will clarify its governance and processes to enable effective commissioning and accountability.



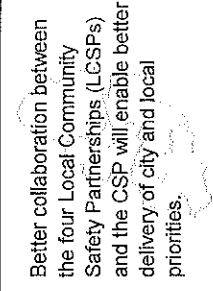
Developing Corporate Memory

The CSP will retain learning from processes and experiences and will build on relationships.



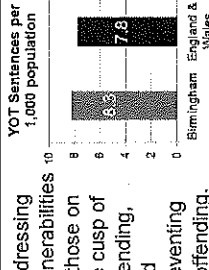
City to Local Links

Better collaboration between the four Local Community Safety Partnerships (LCSPs) and the CSP will enable better delivery of city and local priorities.



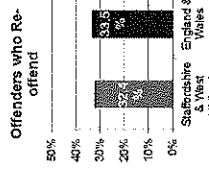
Reducing Youth Offending

Addressing vulnerabilities of those on the cusp of offending, and preventing reoffending.



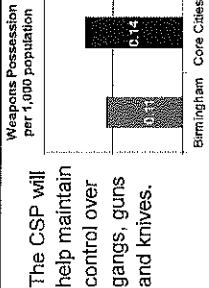
Supporting Integrated Offender Management (IOM)

The CSP will support local IOM delivery.



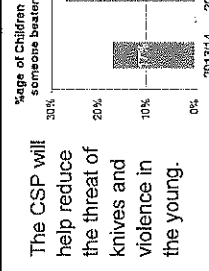
Reducing Gang Violence

The CSP will help maintain control over gangs, guns and knives.



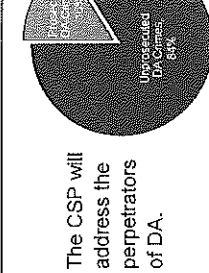
Protecting Young People from Violence

The CSP will address the perpetrators of DA.



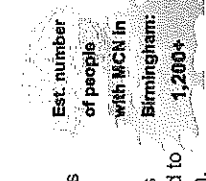
Cohesive Multi-Cultural Birmingham

Cultural differences in the causes and effects of crime. A focus on Racial and Religious Hate Crime.



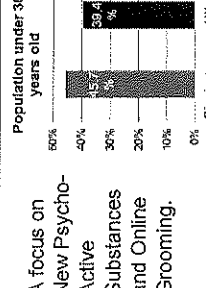
Multiple and Complex Needs (MCN)

Collaboration with subject matter experts to better help people with MCN. A focus on ASB linked to Mental Health.



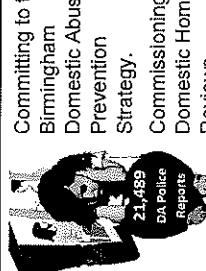
Vulnerabilities in Young People

The CSP will help tackle EA and MS.



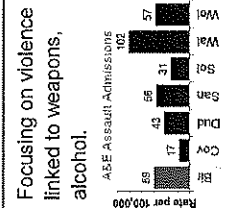
