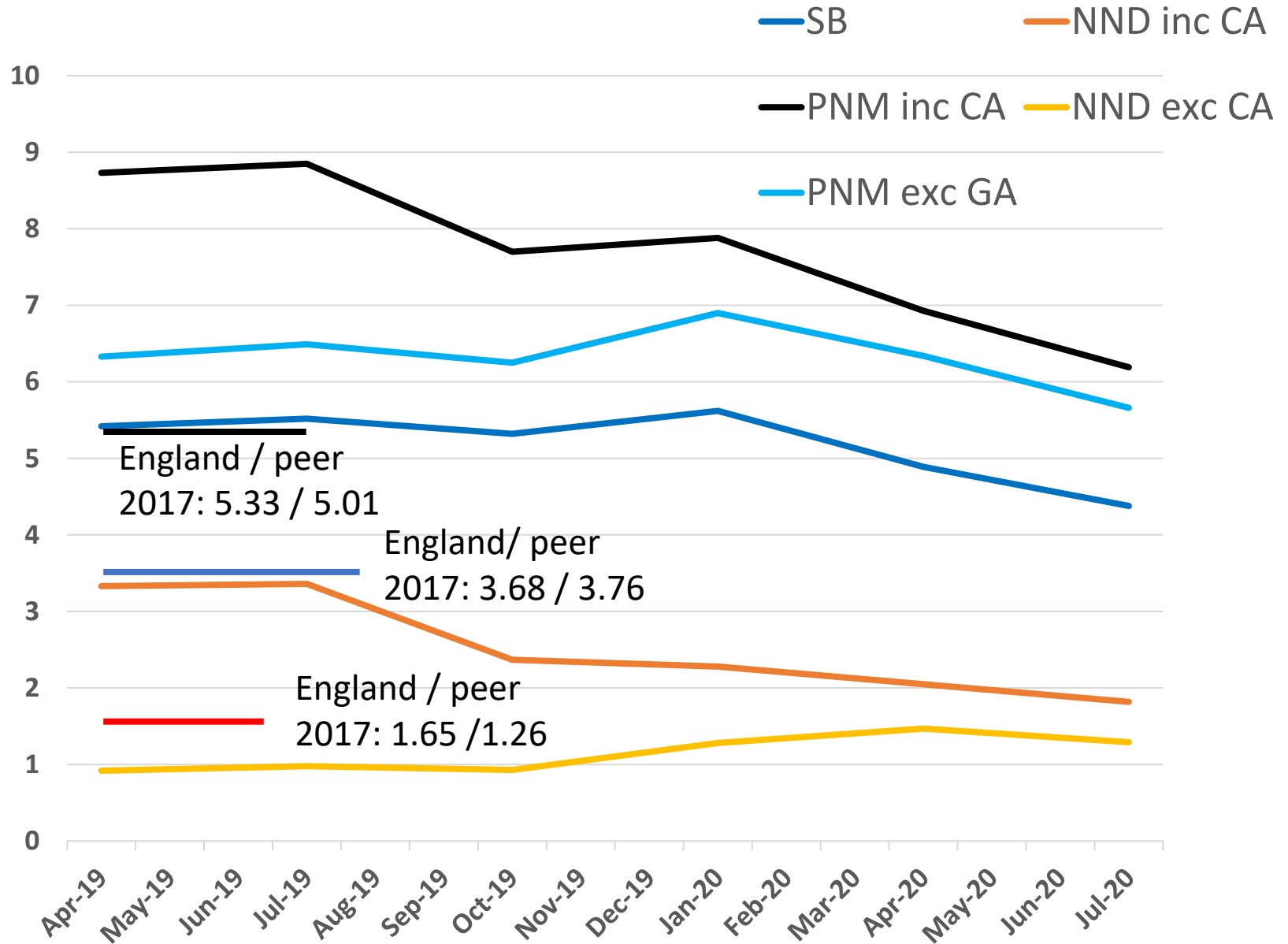

Perinatal mortality BSoL LMS – 12 month rolling average



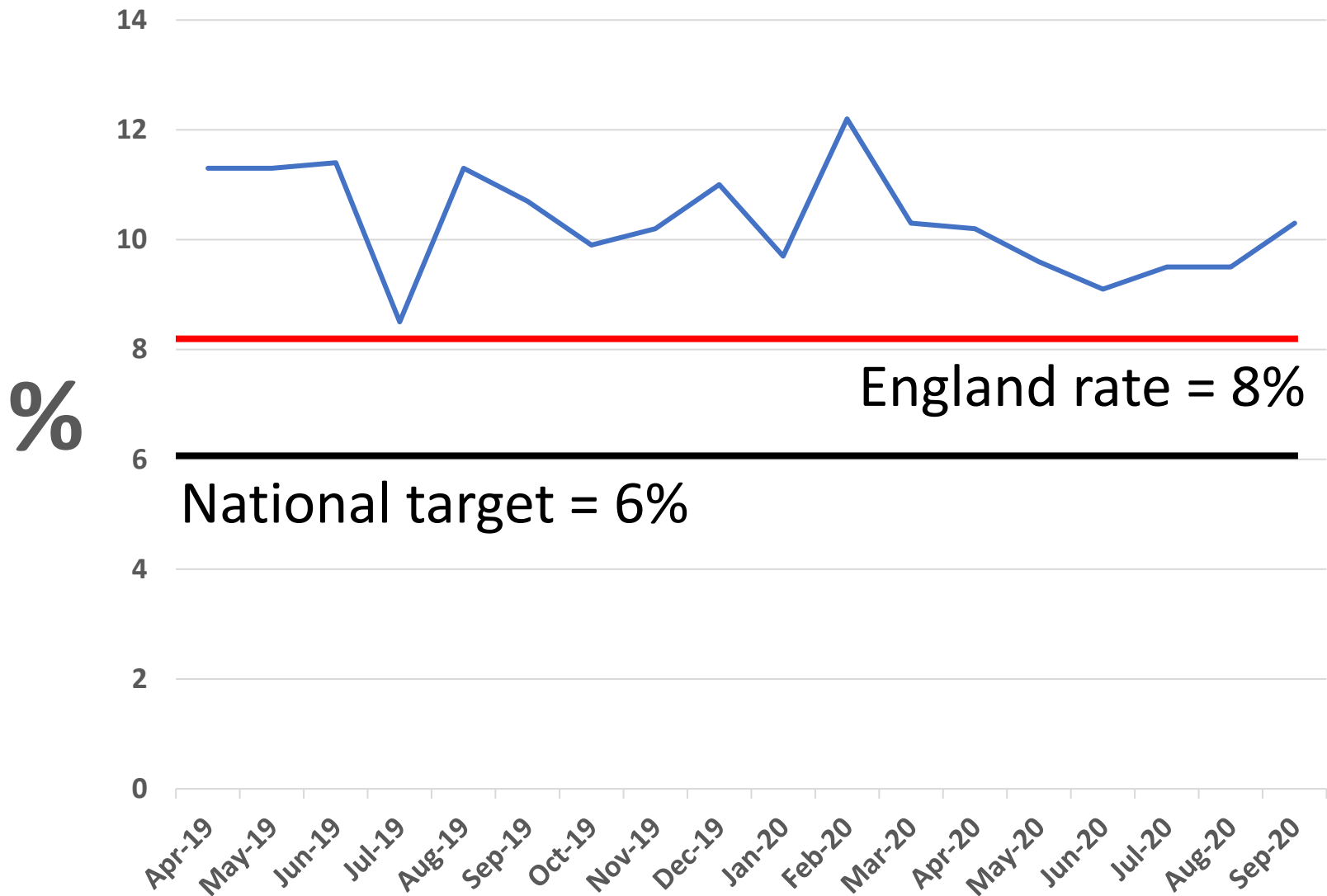

Preterm birth

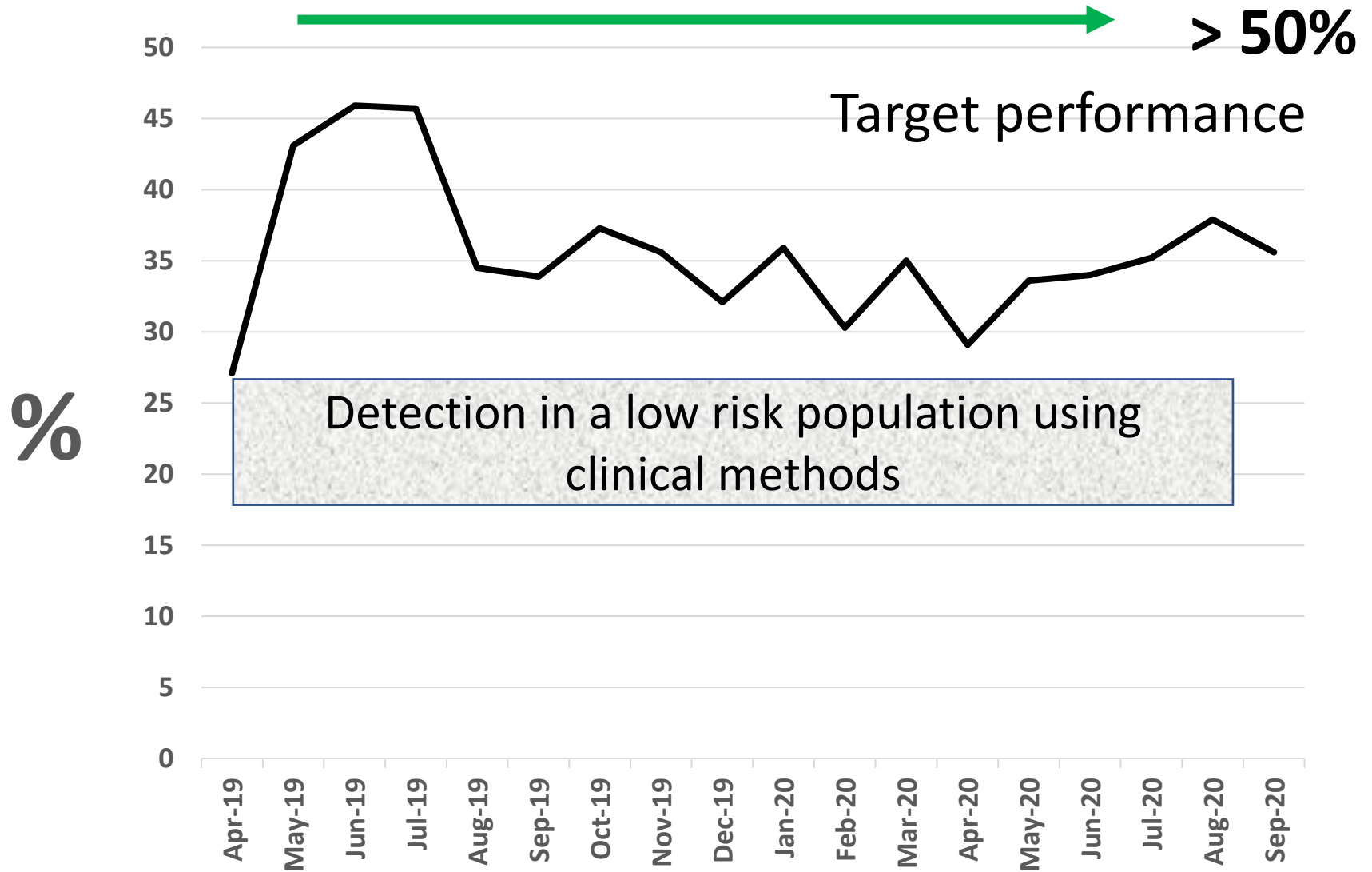
Fetal growth restriction detection

Smoking

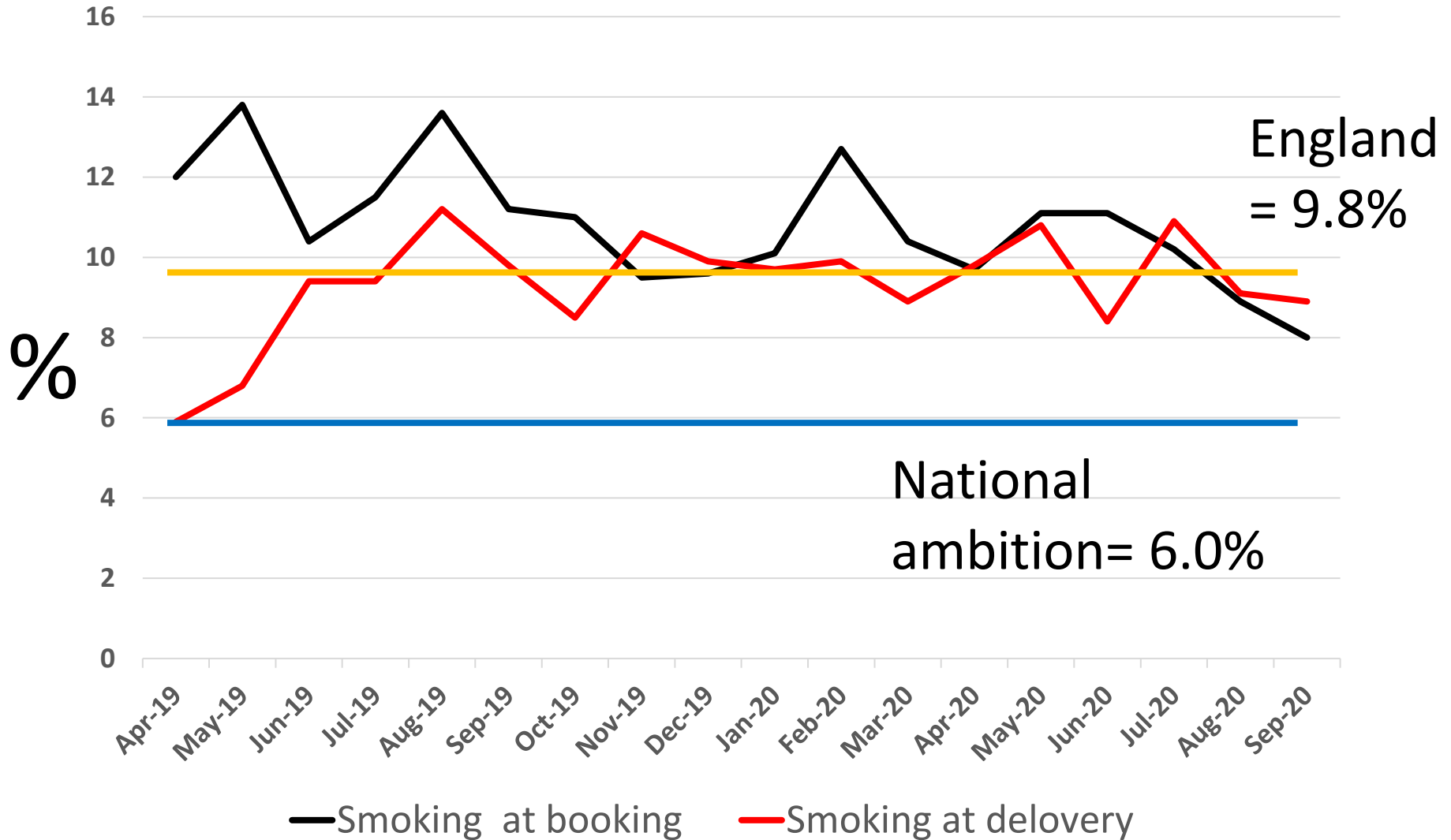
BSoL LMS Preterm birth rate



Small for gestational (FGR) detection rate

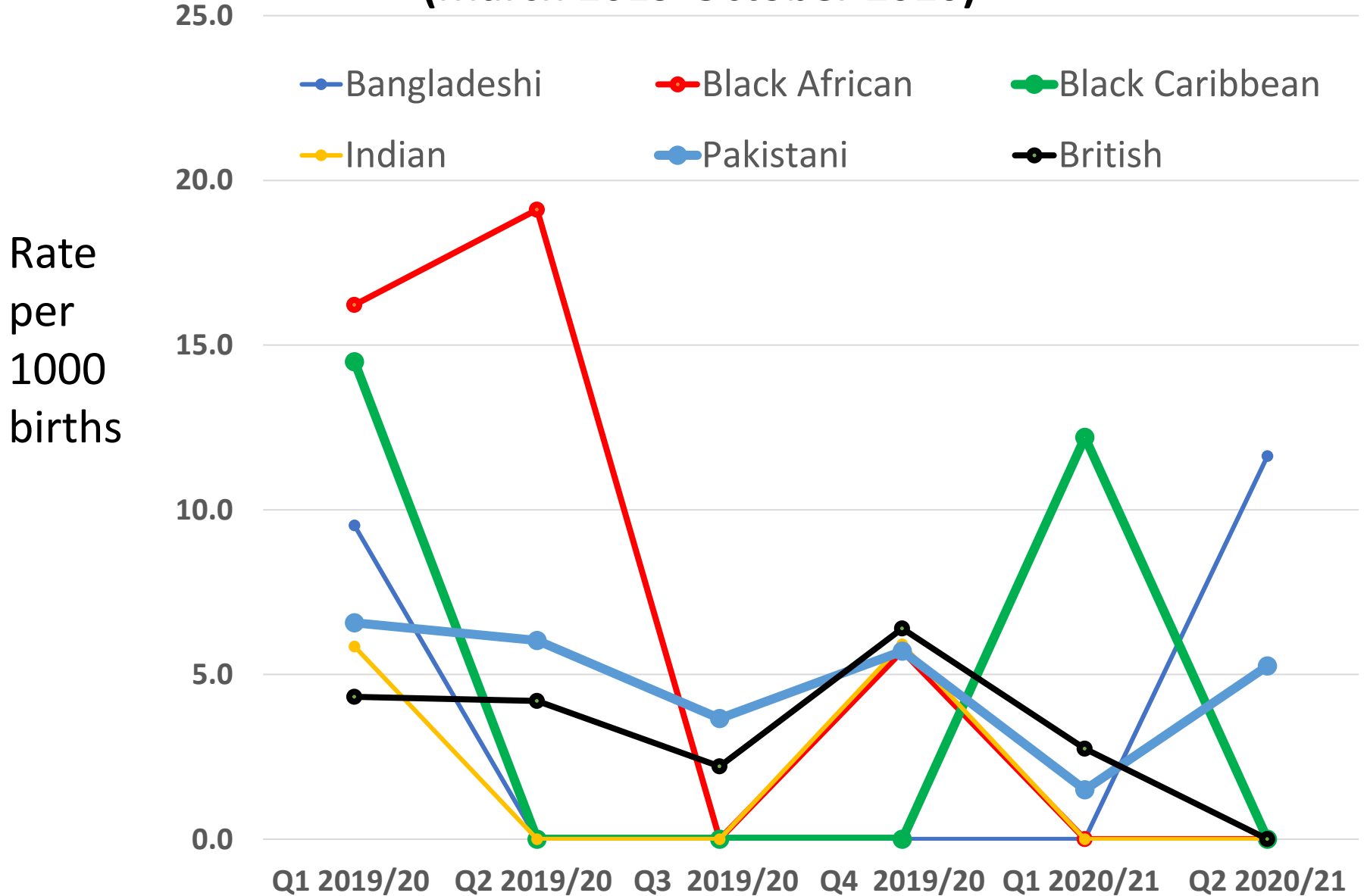


Smoking in pregnancy



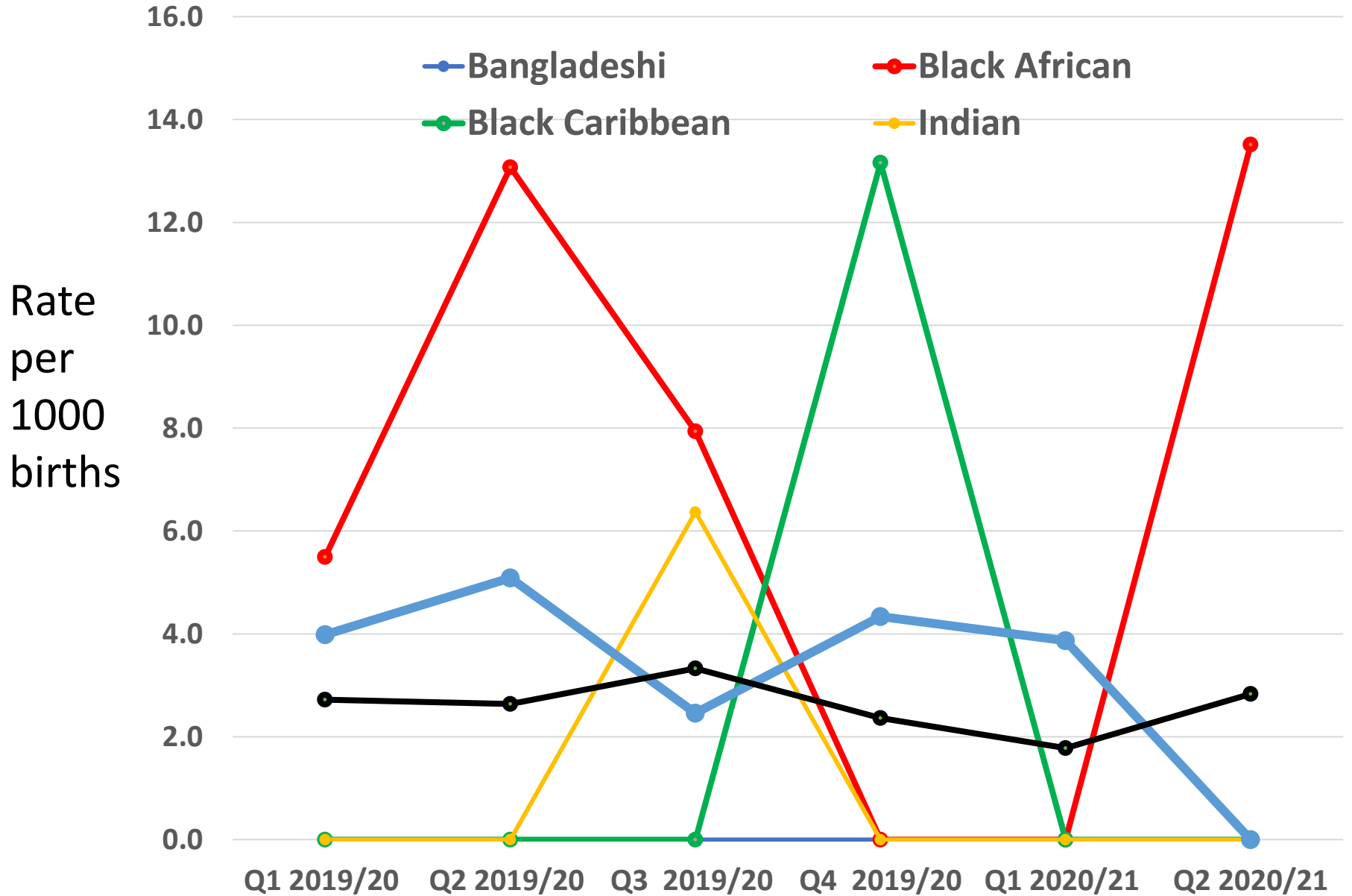
BSoL LMS -Stillbirths by Ethnicity

(March 2019-October 2020)



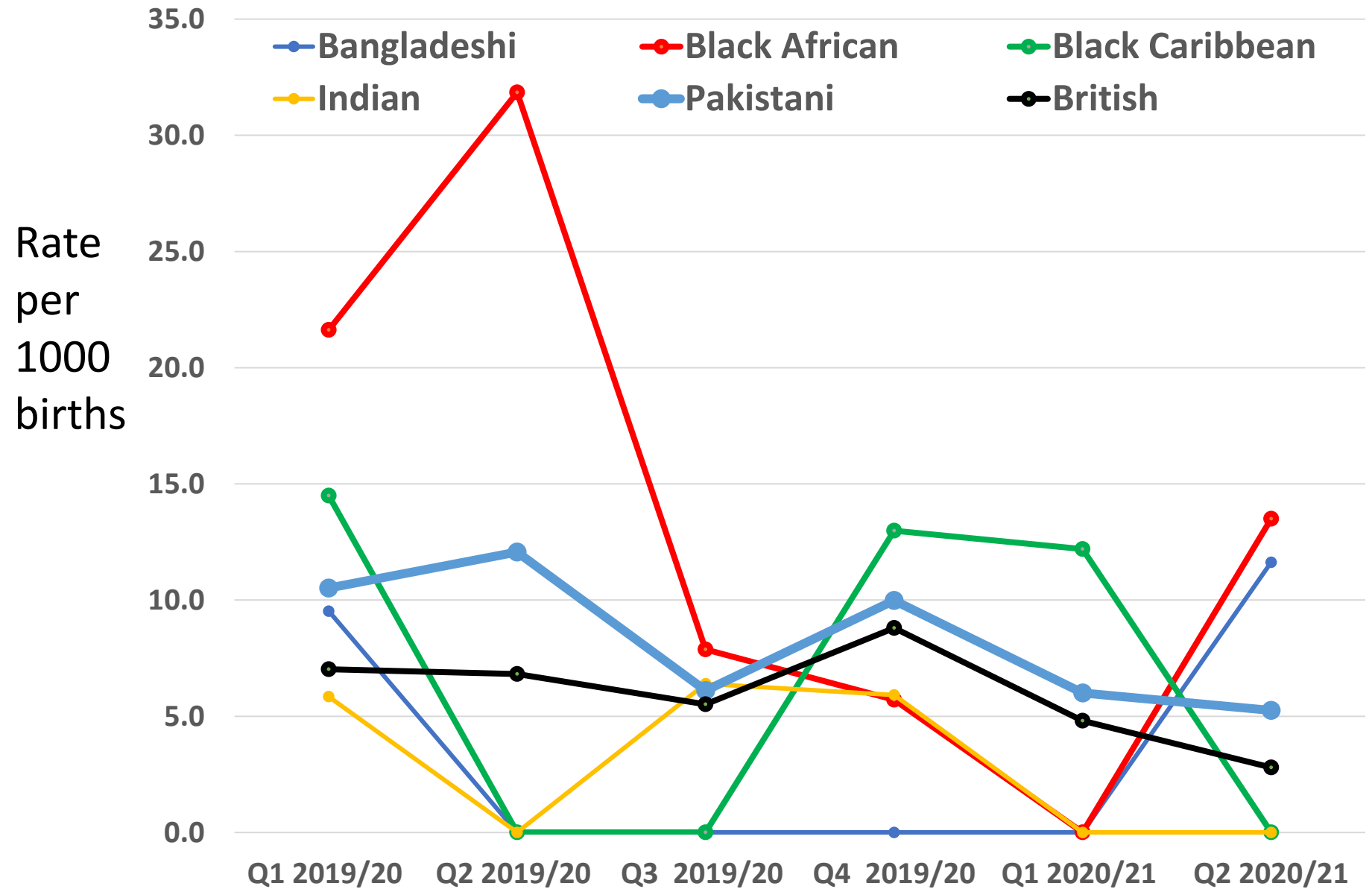
BSoL LMS Neonatal Death by Ethnicity

March 2019 – October 2020

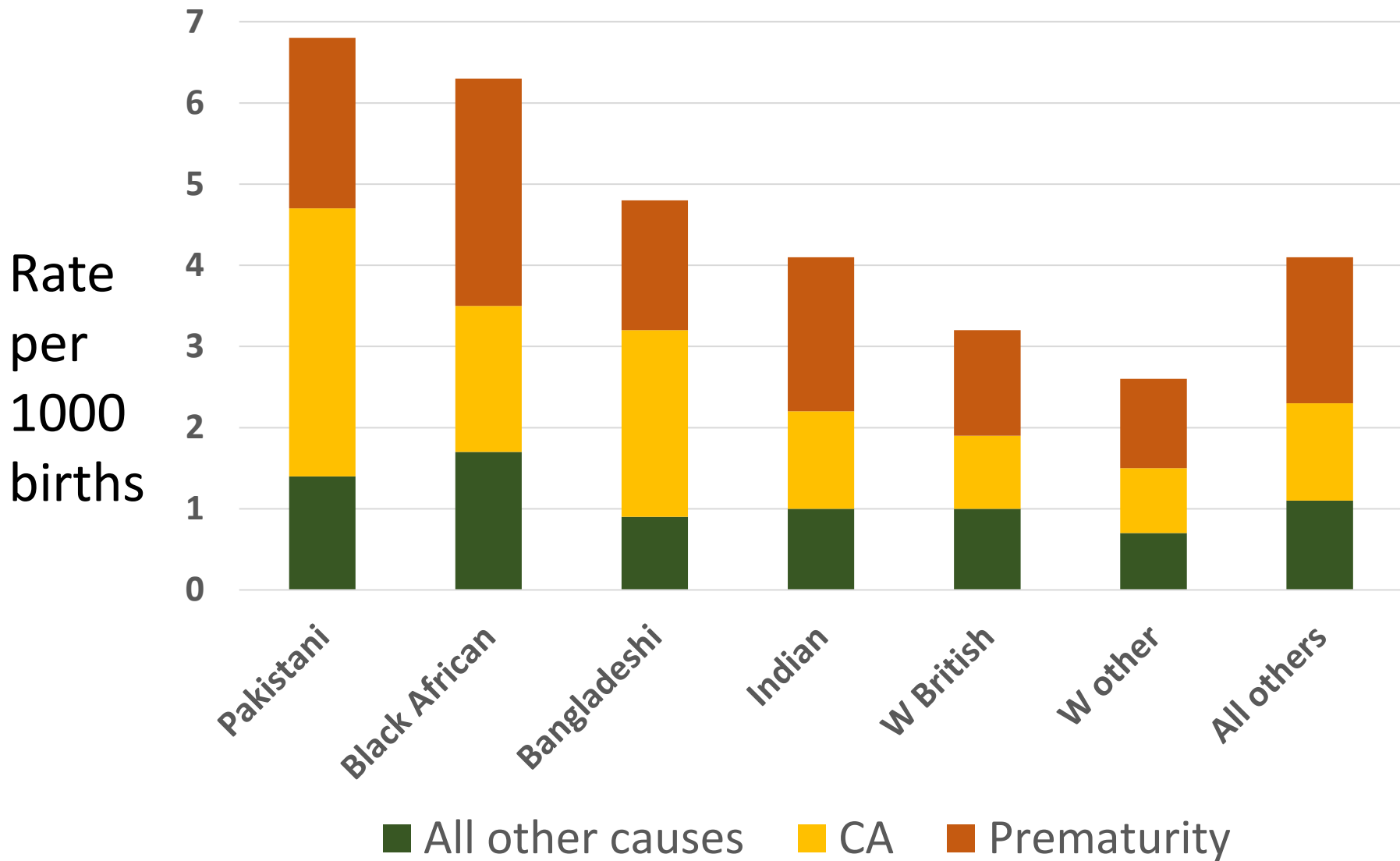


BSoL LMS – Perinatal mortality by Ethnicity

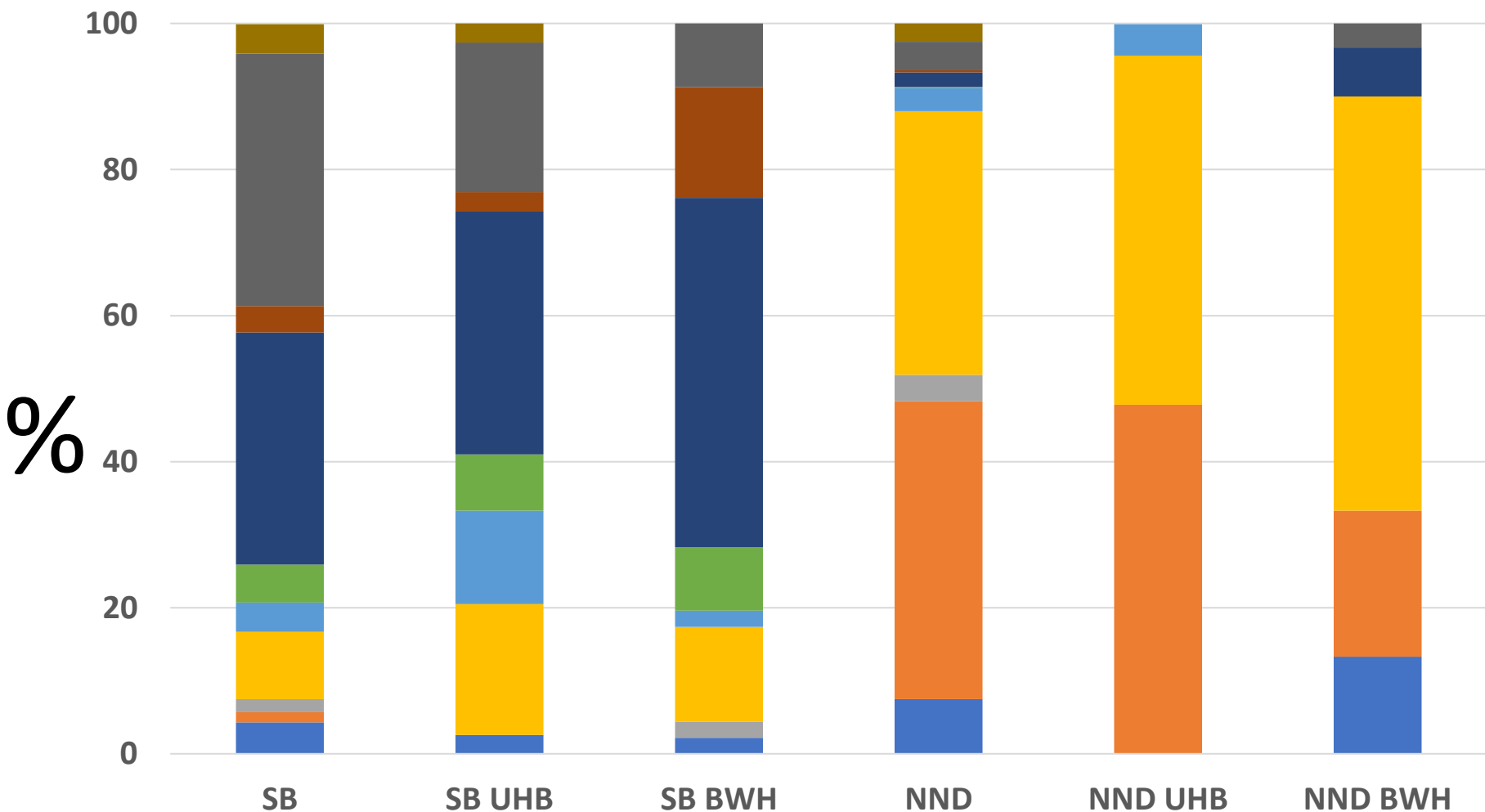

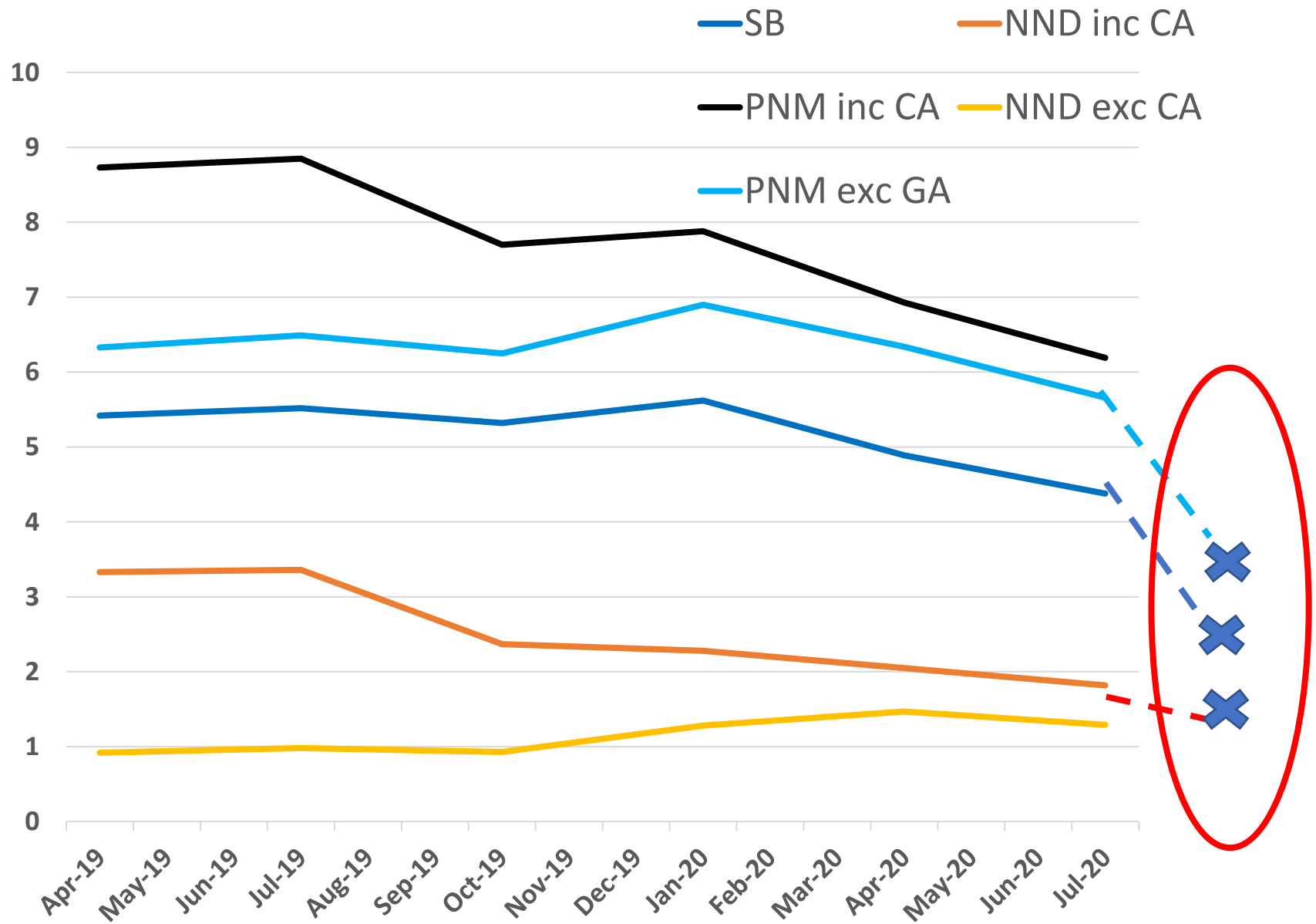
Neonatal deaths by cause and ethnicity
